The gauge at 15.1 is incorrect. We shut the CC down to 25 cfs on the 15th after Lovewell went over the deviation elevation. We dropped the radial gates in Nebraska and have been holding the 25 cfs in Nebraska. The flows stopped at 15.1 during the night on the 15th. We have been doing some hurry up maintenance on some gates between 15.1 and Lovewell which we finished yesterday. Today we started 75 cfs back in the canal at Guide Rock and will start filling and flushing canals below 15.1 later this week or first of next. We will cut the 75 back to the point of not running into Lovewell if possible. Our intent will be to flush and prepare rides with river flow and to attempt to maintain Lovewell at or near 1584.20. If the River continues to flow decent, we could have some bypass at Guide Rock. Hope this is helpful.
