The water supply available from Harlan County Lake as of the end of May is as follows:

Total Supply of 74,807 acre-feet

Bostwick in Nebraska: 36,328 acre-feet

Kansas Bostwick: 38,479 acre-feet

And more to come! The uncontrolled spill at Medicine Creek Dam from recent flooding is over 400 cfs this morning, picked up 7,000 acre-feet of storage in the lake. Will take several days for this to bleed down. Republican at McCook is also at 400 cfs this morning and increasing, may see the effects of this runoff through the weekend.

We will be sending out a letter on the available water supply as soon as we receive the COE final reservoir operations report, should be early next week.
