Subject: Update On Harlan County Lake Projected Irrigation Supply

Kenny and Mike,

The end of March projected irrigation supply from Harlan County Lake is 32,500 acre-feet. The water split for the projected supply is as follows:

Bostwick in Nebraska: 20,000 Acre-feet
Kansas Bostwick: 12,500 Acre-feet

This supply is based on an estimated lake level of approximately 1932.60 feet at the end of May. If current inflows into Harlan County Lake continue we can expect an additional gain in the irrigation supply.
