## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION FOR BENEFICIAL USE OF WATER

APPLICATION No. 4673  
PRIORITY October 7, 1955

WHEREAS, It has been determined by the undersigned that construction of the appropriation diversion works has been completed, that water has been used for beneficial purposes and that the appropriation right has been perfected, all in conformity with the conditions of approval of the above-numbered application and in conformity with the laws of the State of Kansas,

Now, THEREFORE, Be It Known that I, R. V. SMRHA, the duly appointed, qualified and acting Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources of the Kansas State Board of Agriculture, by authority of the laws of the State of Kansas, and particularly K. S. A. 82a-714, do hereby certify that, subject to vested rights and prior appropriation rights, the appropriator is entitled to make use of surface water to be diverted from White Rock Creek at a point in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 18, Township 2 South, Range 6 West, Jewell County, Kansas, at a maximum rate of 635 cubic feet per second direct diversion and in an amount not to exceed 19,700 acre-feet per year for direct irrigation use on the following property:


Those lands in the Kansas Bostwick Irrigation District served by the Courtland Canal downstream from canal mile 38.0 below Lovewell Reservoir in Jewell and Republic Counties, Kansas.

The natural flows of White Rock Creek in excess of that needed for direct diversion and use may be accumulated in Lovewell Reservoir to a maximum extent of 41,690 acre-feet for subsequent irrigation use by the Kansas Bostwick Irrigation District on the lands described herein.






