

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

A public informational session will be conducted at 10:00 a.m. with a public hearing to follow at 11:00 a.m., Oct. 4, 2016, in the Hutchinson Kansas Department of Transportation conference room, 1220 W. 4th Ave., Hutchinson, Kan., to review the McPherson Intensive Groundwater Use Control Area (IGUCA).

Pursuant to K.A.R. 5-20-2, the Chief Engineer of the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Division of Water Resources, is reviewing the designation of the McPherson Intensive Groundwater Use Control Area. All interested parties may submit written comments prior to the hearing to the Chief Engineer, 1320 Research Park Dr., Manhattan, KS 66502, or comments can be submitted by e-mail to David.Engelhaupt@ks.gov. All interested parties will be given a reasonable opportunity to present their views orally on the IGUCA review during the informational session and subsequent hearing. In order to give all parties an opportunity to present their views, it may be necessary to request that each participant limit any oral presentation to 5 minutes.

Any individual with a disability may request accommodation in order to participate in the public hearing and may request the proposed regulations and impact statements in an accessible format.
