





On August 15, 2016, Brad George, City of luka, Water Right, File No. 39786 contacted the Stafford Field Office about the nearby notification letter he recently received. Brad was unable to view the application online and requested a copy be sent to him. I explained the recent law change and noted this was to change the place of use. The well would not be moving and they would not be drilling additional wells or changing the rate or quantity, they were simply changing where they could apply the water.

After further discussion Brad determined he did not need a copy of the application and he has no issues with the proposed change. His contact # is (620) 546-2530.

On August 16, 2016 we received the letter addressed to Lorence Briggeman back with the letter showing, "vacant, unable to forward". I called Larry Briggeman to tell him of the delay and he gave me a different mailing address for his aunt's house. I resent the nearby notification letter to Lorence Briggeman on August 19, 2016.


