WAIVER OF REGULATION K.A.R. 5-21-5 Battery of Wells

RE: Water Right, File No. 13,484-D1

- 1. That the regulation K.A.R. 5-21-5 (c) &(d) adopted by Groundwater Management District No. 1, allows a change in point of diversion to a battery of wells provided the annual maximum rate and quantity not exceed an average of the actual use in the three previous years and the application for change meet the criteria for approval of a new application.
- 2. That the application to change the point of diversion has been requested to preserve the maximum annual water use at a swine facility. The January 26, 2016, application for change under the referenced file request that the existing primary well and four(4) standby wells be authorized as a battery of two (2) wells and two(2) standby wells with a waiver of regulation for the proposed battery.
- 3. That the wells which will comprise the battery are located 50 feet apart and meet the definition of a battery; the right is authorized a maximum rate of 133 gallons per minute for the diversion of 20 million gallons (61.38 acre-feet) per year for stockwatering use.
- 4. The Board of Groundwater Management District No. 1, has recommended approval of the application for change and supports the requested waiver of regulation.
- 5. That because no new wells will be drilled, there will be no increase in the authorized rate or quantity, the change to a battery of two (2) wells will not impair existing water rights nor adversely affect the public interest, and a waiver of regulation is allowed per K.A.R. 5-10-4.

MEMORANDUM

Stephen Summerlin, VP Live Production for Seaboard Foods LLC, owner of the referenced file, authorized for stockwatering use, has filed an application for approval to change the point of diversion. The application was received in the office of the Chief Engineer on January 25, 2016, proposed to change the existing wells from one(1) primary and four(4) standby wells to two(2) primary wells with one being an additional well and three (3) standby wells. After a review of the proposal it was determined that the wells and their operations would be more accurately represented as a battery of two(2) wells and three(3) standby wells. The owner accepted the modification to the proposed change on August 8, 2016.

The referenced water right appears to comply with K.S.A. 82a-732, *Annual water use report required: penalty for violation*. The change in point of diversion from the authorized to the proposed application for change appears to comply with part (e)(1) of K.A.R. 5-5-1, *Filing an application for change* and is also in compliance with K.A.R. 5-5-2a, *Complete change application*.

The stockwatering well is authorized a maximum rate of 133 gallons per minute(gpm) for the diversion of 20 million gallons (61.7 acre-feet) for use at a swine facility located in the East Half of the Northwest Quarter (E½ NW¼) of Section 28, Township 20 Range 32 West, Scott County. It is located within the boundaries of the Western Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 1. The points of diversion overlap with a primary and standby wells authorized under File No. 13,484-D2. The wells authorized under File No. 13,484-D2, serve a different place of use and are held by a different entity of Seaboard Foods LLC.

The owner indicated the reason for the operation change was the want to preserve the rights and the ability to meet peak stockwatering demands. There does not appear to be an expansion of the facility or operations, but they might have had times when the weather causes extreme heat and additional cooling might be needed.

The location of some of the wells was determined by a Compliance Investigation completed by DWR staff in September 2016. The actual change in point of diversion to the geographic center of the battery of two (2) wells will be a move less than 300 feet from the completed existing wells. The location of the geographic center authorized for stockwatering use will be in the SW¼ SE¼ SW¼ approximately 218 feet North and 3,729 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 28, Township 20 South, Range 32 West, Scott County. A Findings and Order has been completed to update the overlapping well locations of File No. 13,484-D2.

As there is no real change in the wells, so the source of supply will not change.

The application was initially proposed to add the existing well as an additional well, per K.A.R. 5-5-16, *Additional well*. It was determined the proposed existing wells would appear to be more like a battery of wells, then a proposed additional well. The physical attributes of the wells authorized by the referenced file has complied with K.A.R. 5-1-1, Definitions, (n) *Battery of wells* since the changes in use made of water approved in 1999 and 2009. It has been recommended and requested to authorized the existing wells as a battery of two(2) wells with parts (c) & (d) of K.A.R. 5-21-5, *Battery of wells, waived*. The quantity and rate reported for the last three years appears to be at reduced to levels and reducing to these levels would negate the needed change. The Groundwater Management District No. 1 area is closed, and the proposed geographic center does not appear to meet a safe yield analysis.

The requested move of 54 feet to create the geographic center precludes the change from complying with well to well spacing per part (c) of K.A.R. 5-23-3. *Minimum well spacing requirements: high plains aquifer* and a waiver of spacing doesn't appear to be needed for the establishment of the geographic center by the change in point of diversion.

There are only the standby and primary wells of File No. 13,484-D2 located within one-half (½) mile of the proposed geographic center of the battery. These wells are also owned by an entity of the applicant. There doesn't appear to be any domestic wells in the area. No comment or notification letters were sent.

Western Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 1 was sent a request for recommendation on the proposed change. In a letter dated November 16, 2016, Kyle Spencer, District Manager, indicated the Board recommended approval of the prosed change with a waiver of K.A.R. 5-21-5.

Mike Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office was notified of the proposed change and has reviewed the summary memo and waiver. He indicated by E-mail on November 30, 2016, that he has no objection to the approval of the proposed change in point of diversion.

A water flow meter will be required, as it appears the wells are metered. A check valve is required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected through the diversion works. A water level measurement tube condition will be in the approval as in previous approvals. A copy of a WWC-5 will not be required. Approval of the change in point of diversion will not result in an abandoned well, so the no need to include the well plugging per KDHE requirements information or paragraph in the transmittal letter.

Based on the above discussion, that a waiver of K.A.R. 5-21-5 is approved and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, that there are no pending applications within the vicinity of this proposed change request that may be affected by this approval, is recommended that the referenced application be approved.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Stephen Summerlin, VP Live Production on behalf of Seaboard Foods LLC, and is division Maple Creek Farms, 9000 W 67th Street, Suite 200, Shawnee Mission, Kansas 66202, received in this office on January 26, 2016, for approval of a change in the location of the points of diversion under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Orders of the Chief Engineer dated March 6, 2000 and August 3, 2009, approving the applications to change the authorized points of diversion and use made of water, and by the Findings and Order of the Chief Engineer dated August 4, 2009, which administratively divided Water Right, File No. 13,484, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the point of diversion authorized for stockwatering shall be:

a battery of two (2) **primary wells** with a geographic center located in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW½ SE½ SE½) of Section 28, more particularly described as being near a point 237 feet North and 3,832 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, at a diversion rate not in excess of 113 gallons per minute (0.25 c.f.s) and in a quantity not to exceed 20.00 million gallons (61 acre-feet) of water per calendar year, and

one (1) **standby well** located in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW½ SW½ SW½) of Section 28, more particularly described as being near a point 582 feet North and 5,078 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, and

one (1) **standby well** located in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW¼ SW¼ SW¼) of Section 28, more particularly described as being near a point 632 feet North and 5078 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section.

all in Township 20 South, Range 32 West, Scott County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the points of diversion.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The well described herein as the standby well shall be used exclusively at such time well described herein as the primary well is inoperable due to mechanical, maintenance or power failure. That the primary and standby well shall not be operated at the same time, unless one of the wells is being operated for maintenance, testing, fire protection, or a similar reason. Use of the standby well under these limiting conditions does not allow the authorized quantity of water or rate of diversion under this file to be exceeded.

That the battery of wells authorized herein shall be located within a three hundred (300) foot radius circle and be in the same local source of supply.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2017 or within any authorized extension of time. The applicant shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application. File No. 13.484, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated March 19, 1981, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

This Order shall become a final agency action, as defined by K.S.A. 77-607(b), without further notice to the parties, if a request for hearing or a petition for administrative review is not filed as set forth below.

Request for Hearing. According to K.A.R. 5-14-3(c), any party who desires a hearing must submit a request within 15 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order. Filing a request for a hearing will give you the opportunity to submit additional facts for consideration, contest any findings made by the Chief Engineer or present any other information you believe should be considered in this matter. A timely-filed request for hearing will stay the deadline for requesting administrative review of this Order pending the outcome of the hearing.

Petition for Review. Any person aggrieved by this Summary Order may petition for administrative review, pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-708b(a) and K.S.A. 82a-1901(a). The petition must be filed within 30 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order and must set forth the basis for the review, unless stayed by the timely filing of a request for hearing.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 - 6777.



I am writing to request a waiver of K.A.R. 5-21-5 in regard to the two water wells at our Maple Creek Farm Number 644 (Wassinger) in Scott County. The water right file number is referenced above.

Seaboard Foods does not anticipate a dramatic increase in water usage after conversion of the two wells to a battery of wells, but we would like to preserve our maximum annual water use of 20 million gallons per year ("mgy"). This will allow flexibility for emergency circumstances and assure sufficient water for our animals to drink under such circumstances. In addition, our livestock operation's normal water demands fluctuate significantly from year to year. The historical data shows our usage has been under 10 mgy the last few years, but it also shows use as high as 17 mgy within the last ten years.

A shortage of water would be hazardous to our daily operations and the health of our animals. Thus, we request a variance to allow for maintaining a maximum of 20 mgy.

We would appreciate your representation of this request in front of the Ground Water Management District 1 Board.

We have reviewed the proposed change for File No. 13,484-D1, which is requesting to add an additional well, but wanting to maintain the currently authorized rate instead of the tested rate allocated between the two existing wells. It appears the requested operation may work better if the proposed change were considered as changing the wells to a battery of two wells. This would afford the retention of all of the certified rate and operation of either well during peak conditions. It appears that the currently authorized wells meet the definition of a battery and may have historically been operated as a battery. This modification of the application for change would not be without a waiver, as the GMD does not have a specific regulation to allow this type of change and the right is complete and certified so a waiver of K.A.R. 5-2-3, Battery of wells, would be needed. The current proposal would request a waiver of KA.R. 5-5-16, Additional well.

This modification would negate the request for an additional well as the geographic center of the battery would be assigned the certified rate and quantity allowing the operation of either well at 113 gallons per minute not to exceed 113 gallons per minute when operating simultaneously for the diversion of 61.38 acre-feet (20 Million gallons) per year. The additional standby wells would remain authorized as standby wells.

An application for approval of the Chief Engineer to change the following condition or conditions of the file number referred to above has been received:

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...
A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.

Applications for Additional Points of Diversion, Water Rights 10408, 13484, and 11170 Re:

Dear Mr. Meyer:

Enclosed are three applications requesting the conversion of existing standby wells to primary use. All wells were flow tested by Department staff during the last quarter of 2015. Included with each application are the following wavier requests:

- Water rights 10408, 13484, and 11170
 - \circ K.A.R. 5-5-16(\cancel{A})(d) requires that each point of diversion authorized by approval of an application for change for an additional well shall have a specific assignment of a maximum instantaneous rate of diversion and a maximum annual quantity of water. Due to the reduced flow rate that results with these change applications, paired with existing infrastructure for water distribution, Seaboard requests that a combined rate be issued for the two points of diversion. See question #17 of the change applications for specifics. This will allow for greater flexibility and management of water in the event that one of the points cannot be temporarily used. Never will the appropriated quantity be exceeded.
- Water rights 13484 and 11170
 - K.A.R. 5-5-16(3) requires that the total maximum rate of diversion that may be authorized for the original well or the additional well or wells shall not be greater than the total maximum rate of diversion that could have been diverted from the original well or wells if they were currently being replaced by new wells at substantially the originally authorized location or locations in the same local source of supply. The recent flow tests for these two water rights yield less than 100 gpm. During periods of high temperature it is necessary for the facilities to have at least 100 gpm in order to cool the animals and prevent death loss. Allowing a waiver for the facilities to exceed this flow rate during critical periods will provide the cooling necessary to maximize animal health. This rate will not be continuous and likely less than 6 months of the calendar year. Water right 11170 will be further restricted to 75 gpm (the original maximum diversion rate). Never will the appropriated quantity be exceeded.


