Matt Long, tenant, along with Lewis Todd Long, Trustee and Diana K. Long, Trustee of the Long Living Trust, the new owner of the referenced water right have filed an application requesting that a change in the authorized irrigated place of use which was received in the office of the Chief Engineer on April 10, 2017.

A review of the reported water use finds that the water right is in compliance with K.S.A. 82a-732 and the application complies with K.A.R. 5-5-2(a).

The referenced file currently is authorized to irrigate 80 acres in Wichita County with 160 acre-feet of water at a maximum rate of 1,055 gallons per minute. The right has no overlaps in point of diversion or place of use and is not in a special use area, but is in Western Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 1, (GMD1). The right has been determined to have 80 base acres. It is authorized to irrigate the East half of the Southeast Quarter (E½ SE¼) of Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 35 West, Wichita County, but appears to have been irrigating the Southeast Quarter (SE ¼) under a full pivot.

The application is needed to authorized the pivot so the change in place of use will be processed according to K.A.R. 5-5-11(b)(3); **Necessity to install a more efficient irrigation system; limited quantity,** which will allow an increase under a five(5) year allocation. The requested change is in conjunction with enrolling the right into the Wichita County Water Conservation Area, (WCWCA).

- The Western Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 1 (GMD) will assume monitoring responsibility, as per the memorandum of understanding between the Division of Water Resources and the GMD. The owners have worked with the GMD and completed an agreement of monitoring dated April 7, 2017.
- The "base acres" were determined by the Garden City Field Office to be 80 acres. The applicant has proposed an increase of 80 acres above the "base acres" to 160 acres.
- As there is no recent history of overpumping it (it does appear the 160 acre-feet maximum
 was exceeded in 2009-10 under a previous owner). As the application is to authorize land
 that has been historically irrigated without a permit, a Kansas Water Office water
 conservation plan was not requested.
- Limitations: The annual authorized 160 acre-feet will be allowed, but the five year total authorized quantity will be limited to a fixed 565 acre-feet (AF).

• The right will be restricted to 565 AF over the five year period and use in excess of this quantity shall result in a two-year suspension of all water use under the referenced right and subsequent restriction of the authorized place of use to the base acres which have been indicated on the map and irrigation acreage table. The owners have requested the 80 base acres be the acres in the East half of the Southeast Quarter (E½ SE¼) of Section 17. Township 17 South, Range 35 West, Wichita County.

The five year allocated quantity will provide an average annual quantity of 113 AF. The irrigation of 160 acres will provide 0.706 acre-feet per acre. It would appear however, that the irritation will be mainly under the pivot. A standard pivot radius of 1,320 feet would result in the irrigation of 126 acres, providing an irrigation ratio of approximately 0.90 AF of water per acre. This irrigation ratio is still less than the net irrigation requirement at the 50 percent chance of rain of 1.20 AF per acre, it would appear the owners have been operating the pivot for some time and are familiar with their cropping needs. Both trustees have signed the summary agreement that details the conditions of the approval.

Additionally, they have signed the Application for the WCWCA. This details the agreement and based on the 2009 to 2015 water use.

The required notice to nearby well owners was sent to Simons Farms, Inc., on May 16, 2017. On May 17, 2017, the Office of the Chief Engineer received a letter from John Simons on behalf of Simons Farms Inc., stating that they support the approval of the proposed change.

A Compliance Investigation completed on June 9, 2015, by Mitch French, DWR Staff, Garden City Field Office determined by GPS protocol the feet distances that were missing for the authorized point of diversion to be 2,681 feet North and 1,378 feet West of the Southeast corner of 17-17S-35W. The Compliance Investigation did not appear to list the correct section so the data may not be accurate for an update of the location of the well.

Pursuant to the Rules and Regulations of the Western Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 1 effective on September 22, 2000, the district's rules and regulations have been met. A recommendation supporting the allocation was received from Kyle Spencer, District Manager of GMD No. 1 on April 21, 2017.

The Water Commissioner, Michael Meyer, has reviewed the proposed change, and in an email dated May 22, 2017, he recommended approval of the proposed allocation.

A water flowmeter will be required as per K.A.R. 5-5-11(e) and a check valve will be required if chemigating. A water level measurement tube and WWC-5 will not be conditions of the approval as no new wells have been authorized.

Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, that impairment of existing water rights is unlikely, that no change in the local source of supply will occur, that the local groundwater management district will continue monitoring responsibilities for the allocation, the change is recommended for approval

Enclosed is the order executed by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, approving the application for change under the referenced file.

Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, and limitations specified in the approval for change. A condition of the approval is that an acceptable water flowmeter must be installed on the diversion works authorized. Please return the required notification of installation of the meter as soon as this action is completed.

Please be reminded that reports of water usage must be submitted to this office annually. Records indicating the amount of water used should be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of the previous calendar year so that the continued use of water becomes a matter of record in this office. The owner, or his or her legally designated agent, is held responsible for submitting annual water use reports. Failure to file an accurate water use report is a violation of law which makes you subject to civil penalties.

Approval of the application does not allow the diversion of water in excess of the authorized quantity per calendar year or rate of diversion.

Please be advised that K.S.A. 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act states in pertinent part:

... it shall be unlawful... for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

Your attention should be drawn to the fact that the approval has been issued solely for the purpose of allowing the operation of a more efficient irrigation system on the irrigated land within the authorized place of use, limited to a fixed allocation of water, 565 acre-feet in this case, over a five (5) year period. Non-compliance with the terms of the approval will result in substantial penalties.

I have sent your paperwork for the consent agreement to participate in the Wichita County Water Conservation Area to Michael Meyer, Water Commissioner, of the Garden City Field Office for the necessary processing.

Long, Trustee, of the Long Living Trust, 501 W L Street, Leoti, Kansas, 67861-9415, received in the office of the Chief Engineer on April 10, 2017, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the place of use shall be:

- 2. That the quantity of water authorized under Water Right, File No. 16,666, shall not exceed 160 acre-feet per calendar year, provided that 565 acre-feet per five (5)-year period is not exceeded.
- 3. That the use of water in excess of 565 acre-feet per five (5) year period shall result in a two (2) year suspension of all water use under this water right, effective the next two (2) calendar years, and a subsequent reduction of the authorized place of use to the following described property.

That if the Western Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 1 and/or the Division of Water Resources terminate their Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) pertaining to K.A.R. 5-5-11(b), (3), (4), and (5), by which the District assumes monitoring responsibility, then the place of use authorized by this change approval, which was issued by the Division pursuant to the MOU shall revert to the property described in paragraph No. 3, above, starting the calendar year following the year of termination.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on each of the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

A seal shall be placed on the water flowmeter by the Division of Water Resources in such a manner as to render the meter non-removable from the measuring chamber without breaking the seal. If the seal is broken without the written permission of the Chief Engineer, this shall create a rebuttable presumption that the point of diversion had been unlawfully operated in violation of the order of the chief engineer and that the water right holder had been acting in violation of the conditions of his or her water right.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 16,666, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated August 7, 1974.

This Order shall become a final agency action, as defined by K.S.A. 77-607(b), without further notice to the parties, if a request for hearing or a petition for administrative review is not filed as set forth below.

Request for Hearing. According to K.A.R. 5-14-3(c), any party who desires a hearing must submit a request within 15 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order. Filing a request for a hearing will give you the opportunity to submit additional facts for consideration, contest any findings made by the Chief Engineer or present any other information you believe should be considered in this matter. A timely-filed request for hearing will stay the deadline for requesting administrative review of this Order pending the outcome of the hearing.

Petition for Review. Any person aggrieved by this Summary Order may petition for administrative review, pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-708b(a) and K.S.A. 82a-1901(a). The petition must be filed within 30 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order and must set forth the basis for the review, unless stayed by the timely filing of a request for hearing.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 – 6777.



The items listed below have been reviewed with me by the Western Kansas Groundwater Management District No.1 pertaining to the approval of my application to change the place of use authorized under my water right.

1) Flow Meter Requirement. I understand that flow meters will have to be installed and maintained on each well covered by this application and that I will have to report these meter readings annually to the DWR on the water use report forms.

- 2) Monitoring requirements. The District, under the monitoring requirement with the Division of Water Resources, will make three visits annually to this farm. Reports of verification of compliance and status reports will be completed by the District and submitted to the Division.
- 3) Water requirements. The District has reviewed the amount of water required to irrigate the acreage proposed under this change application with me. The five-year allocation, if required, has been reviewed with me and I understand the amount of water to which I am limited is

 567 acre-feet per five-year period.
- 4) Base acres. The proposed increase in authorized acres for a crop rotation shall be limited to not exceed ______ acres. Under this condition, I understand that I am limited to the approved or certified annual quantity of water under my water right and that the number of acres irrigated any one calendar year, cannot be more than my base acres.
- 5) Understanding. Pursuant to K.A.R. 5-5-11 section 3 (D) ii and 4 (D) ii, the approval of the above stated application shall be conditioned so that the use of water in excess of the five year allocation, or, on more than the maximum number of acres authorized to be irrigated in any one calendar year, shall result in a two-year suspension of all water use under this water right, and a subsequent restriction of the authorized place of use to the base acreage at the following location.

Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.
