The diversion works should be completed and reported to the Division of Water Resources by December 31, 2017. Enclosed is a form for this purpose, along with other information for reference.

A condition of this order is that an acceptable flow meter must be properly installed on the diversion works authorized under the referenced file number in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12. This water flow meter shall be used to provide information required on the annual water use report.

This order shall become final if a request for a hearing is not filed with the Chief Engineer within 15 days of the date of service of this order. The date of service is the date listed on the enclosed Certificate of Service.



This Summary Order is issued under authority of K.S.A. 82a-708b, as amended, and K.A.R. 5-14-3 and other applicable provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Law, K.S.A. 82a-701 et. seq., and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, K.A.R. 5-1-1 et.seq. With the exception of those conditions expressly contained herein, this Summary Order does not change the terms, conditions and limitations of File No. ME 3 A change application was received on December 27, 2016 A change application was received on <u>December 27, 2016</u> requesting that the place of use and / or point of diversion authorized under the above-referenced file number be changed as described in the application. The point of diversion authorized by this summary order shall be located within a 300 foot radius of the authorized point(s) of diversion. 3. 




