David Clawson on behalf of High Plains Ponderosa Dairy, LLC, filed applications for approval to change the place of use authorized for stockwatering use. The applications for change were received in the Office of the Chief Engineer on June 26, 2017. It was determined toward the end of the processing a portion of the proposed stockwatering place of use is authorized for irrigation. The owners decided to change the irrigated place of use and applications for change were received on February 20, 2018. The change to the irrigated place of use will be summarized separately, but all of the applications will be worked as a package.

The rights comply with K.S.A. 82a-718. The stockwatering place of use is utilized for a dairy cattle operation which has expanded onto unauthorized land. There was an error on the application for File No. 12,332 showing it as a change in point of diversion, but this was from an old request and a change in place of use is shown on the map. The WRIS database needs to be updated to show a change in place of use for File No. 12,332. The applications are in compliance with K.A.R 5-5-2a and appear to comply with K.S.A. 82a-1906, without any sent notifications as there are no well owners within one-half mile of the wells authorized under these rights other than the owners of the referenced rights.

The expansion of the dairy is to the North and East proposing the stockwatering place of use to be the West Half (W ½) and the Southeast Quarter (SE ¼) of Section 18, Township 33 Range 30 West, Meade County.

File No. 12,332 authorizes 93.5 million gallons (287 acre-feet) at 725 gallons per minute with the File No. 45,387, authorized to divert 130 million gallons (400 acre-feet) per year at 500 gallons per minute. Both rights have a standby well. An extension to perfect has been approved thru 2021 for File No. 45,387, which has its wells in separate counties. The place of use authorized under these rights has been described as being located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 18, Township 33 South, Range 30 West, Meade County. The aerial of the proposed place of use would appear to have a pivot in the Northwest Quarter, but a review found no irrigation rights in this area. It also showed a half pivot in the North half of the Southeast Quarter (N½ SE¼) is authorized under twenty-one files that have a combined total of 3,300 acres. Applications to change the irrigated place of use have been filed to relocate these acres and remove any overlap with irrigated acres.

The applications will increase the place of use but should not result in an increase in consumptive use as required by K.A.R. 5-5-3, *Consumptive use* as stockwatering is considered 100% consumptive. A review of their water use found only the dairy routinely uses 55% of the total authorized.

In a letter dated July 17, 2017, copies of the applications were sent to Mark Rude, Manager of Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3 (GMD 3) along with a request to make a recommendation. In a letter dated August 8, 2017, Jason Norquest, Assistant Manager of GMD 3, indicated the proposal is not in conflict with their management plan and recommended approval of the applications.

Mike Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office, indicated that he is not opposed to approval of the applications, per his email dated April 26, 2018. Water flowmeters are required. Check valves are required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

RE: File Nos. 12,332 & 45,387

A condition of the approvals will be the requirement of flow meters pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-706c. A check valve will be required if there will be any chemigation, but would be prudent for this type of stockwatering facility that will water dairy cattle.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, consumptive use will not increase, impairment of existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the referenced applications for change be approved.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of David Clawson, High Plains Ponderosa Dairy LLC, 2042 V Road, Plains, Kansas 67869, received in this office on June 26, 2017, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of application, issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for benifical use, as modified and amended by the Findings and Order of the Chief Engineer dated November 17, 2000, to reduce the authorized place of use, and by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated June 12, 2001, approving the application to change the place of use and use made of water, and by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated December 26, 2001, approving the application to change the point of diversion, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the place of use shall be:

a dairy located in the West Half (W½) and the Southeast Quarter (SE¼) of Section 18, in Township 33 South, Range 30 West, Meade County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the place of use.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on each of the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 12,332, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 6, 1983, remains as authorized and amended by the aforementioned orders.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.



Reference is made to your applications for approval of the Chief Engineer to change the place of use authorized for stockwatering use under the referenced files received in our office on June 26, 2017. Upon review of the applications, it is found that they cannot be approved as proposed.

Our records indicate a portion of the proposed stockwatering use place of use is acreage authorized for irrigation use under File Nos. 22,306; 26,247; 40,445; 41,192; 41,578; 41,579; 41,580; 41,581; 42,084; 42,110; 42,708; 43,082; 43,105; 43,220; 43,333; 43,635; 43,880; 44,248; 44,945; 44,946 and 45,295. We have identified approximately 61.0 acres of land located in the South half of the Southeast Quarter (S½ SE¼) of Section 18, Township 33 South, Range 30 West, Mead County that is currently authorized for irrigation use. Enclosed please find a copy of a map for the referenced applications detailing the 61 acres.

Rules and Regulations of the Water Appropriation Act in Part (www)(2) of K.A.R. 5-1-1, *Definitions*, define stockwatering to not include the irrigation of feed grains or other crops. The proposed or existing use of water in the South half of the Southeast Quarter (S½ SE¼) of Section 18, Township 33 South, Range 30 West, Mead County will need to be modified.

The identified 61 irrigated acres will either need to be reallocated to other contiguous land which can be irrigated, or permanently reduced from the water rights listed in paragraph No. 2.

Should all owners determine that the 61 acres will be permanently removed from the irrigated place of use, the total irrigated acres will be reduced from 3,300 to 3,239 acres. A reduction in the overall place of use may result in a reduction of the overall quantity of water that may be authorized by the listed rights authorized for irrigation use as required by K.A.R. 5-3-23. Maximum reasonable annual quantity approvable for irrigation use for an application for change in place of use and a request to reduce a water right.

Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.


