MEMORANDUM

Christina G. Staufenberger represented as Trustee of the Henry C. Hitch Ranch Trust and Jason Hitch, CEO, on behalf of Hitch Enterprises Inc., submitted applications on August 1, 2018, to change the irrigated place of use. The applications were completed on filed office approvable forms, but request to overlap 2,120 acres of irrigated land in Seward County. The applications were submitted by the water use correspondent, Clawson Land Partnership.

The referenced water rights appear to be in compliance with K.S.A. 82a-732 and the additional requested signature and submitted maps indicate the owners are requesting a complete overlap in the place of use without any modifications so it would appear the applications comply with K.A.R. 5-5-2a.

The referenced files are authorized to irrigate 2,120 acres from a total of 13 wells authorized a combined total of 3,250 acre-feet at an average rate of 867 gallons per minute. The acres are located in Sections 23, 24, 25, 26, 35 & 36 of Township 32 Range 34 West, Seward County. The rights are not located within a special use area but are within the boundaries of Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3. The proposed changes are to make a complete overlap of the authorized acres without any modifications to the irrigated acres. The applications will be processed by Part b(1) of K.A.R. 5-5-11 *Applications for change in place of use for irrigation purposes.* The rights are all certified and the applications were filed to make an **identical place of use with each right**. It appears the determination of base acres is not necessary per the regulation.

The changes should help with the historical pumping above authorized in the 1990's under the junior rights. It will also resolve the incomplete overlap between File Nos. 20,992 & 22,215. The total combined quantity will provide 1.53 acre-foot acre, complying with K.A.R. 5-3-23, *Maximum reasonable annual quantity approvable for irrigation use for an application for change in place of use and a request to reduce a water right.* As detailed in K.A.R. 5-5-12, *Net irrigation requirements*, at an 80% chance of rainfall, Seward County irrigation requires 1.37 acre-foot per acre. It appears the combined quantity is reasonable and sufficient for the irrigation of corn and a conservation or operational plan will not be needed for the proposed changes. As the place of use will not be increasing, the changes should not result in an increase in the consumptive use, thus complying with K.A.R. 5-5-3, *Change in consumptive use*.

Compliance Investigations on the points of diversion under File Nos. 22,215; 22,216 & 22,218 were completed by the area field office. The locations were determined to be within 300 feet of authorized with the exception of ID 4 under Water Right, File No. 22,216, determined to be 359 feet from the authorized. The actual location complies with part (b) of K.A.R. 5-5-6, *Failure to construct diversion works at authorized location*, the right was approved in 1975, after construction, at a location approvable today. The locations will be updated by the approvals.

In a letter dated October 8, 2018, Jason Norquest, Assistant Manager, Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3, recommend approval of the applications.

Michael Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office area reviewed the proposed applications. In an email dated October 8, 2018, he recommended their approval.

Water flowmeters will be required for the change approvals pursuant to K.A.R. 5-5-11(e)(2) indicating 3,417 acre-feed is needed to be exempt from metering. Check valves will be required, if chemigating. As no new wells will be drilled a water level measurement tube and WWC-5 will not be a condition of the approvals.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes will create a place of use that is reasonable, and the historical consumptive use will not be increased, that impairment to existing water rights are unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the referenced applications be approved.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Christina G. Staufenberger on behalf of Henry C. Hitch Ranch Trust, Box 1308, Guymon, Oklahoma 73942, and Jason Hitch, Corporate Executive Officer, Hitch Enterprises, Incorporated, 309 Northridge Circle, Gymon, Oklahoma 73942, received in the office of the Chief Engineer on August 10, 2018, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the place of use shall be:

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a total of 2,120 acres in Sections 23, 24, 25, 26, 35 and 36, all in Township 32 South, Range 34 West, Seward County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the place of use.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 20,992, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 17, 1987.



RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any use of water that is not as authorized by the water right or permit to authorize water before the chief engineer approves this application is a violation of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act for which criminal or civil penalties may be assessed. Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). Civil penalties shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 per violation. In the case of a continuing violation, each day such violation continues may be deemed a separate violation. In addition to these penalties the water right may be modified or suspended. K.S.A. 82a-737, as amended.


