Greg Grewell and Donald P. Grewell, on behalf of Grewell Land, L.L.C., GPG L.L.C. and DKGG L.L.C., water right owners, filed applications for approval to change the authorized point of diversion for Water Right, File Nos. 42,210 and 44,186, and the authorized place of use for File Nos. 41,463; 42,210; 42,336 and 44,186, all files authorized groundwater for irrigation use in the Cimarron River Basin.

The referenced files do not appear abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

File No. 42,210 has no overlaps in the point of diversion and place of use and is authorized 61 acre-feet and 620 gallons per minute from one well for irrigation of 130 acres all located in Section 16, Township 34 South, Range 38 West, Stevens County, Kansas. File No. 41,463 has two wells with no overlaps while File Nos. 42,336 and 44,186 are authorized the same well. File Nos. 41,463, 42,336 and 44,186 are authorized a limited total of 1,960 acre-feet for irrigation of the same 1,073 acres in Sections 14,15 and 16 of the aforementioned township and range. The water right owners of File No. 44,186 propose to unstack the authorized quantity and diversion rate from the well it shares with File No. 42,336 and move it a distance of 2,280 feet to a well to be drilled 1,074 feet North and 808 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 16 pursuant to K.A.R 5-5-16 Additional wells. The currently authorized well for File No. 44,186 will remain authorized under File No. 42,336.

File No. 44,186 is limited to 1,960 acre-feet of water per calendar year when combined with File Nos. 41,463 and 42,336; and further limited to 2,400 g.p.m. when combined with File No. 42,336 for irrigation use from the diversion point. Since the additional well regulation requires that each point of diversion authorized by an approval of an application for change for an additional well shall have a specific assignment of a maximum instantaneous rate of diversion and a maximum annual quantity of water, it was determined that rates and quantities should be divided among File Nos. 41,463; 42,336 and 44,186 in order to eliminate the additional rate and quantity limitations on File No. 44,186. In a phone conversation on August 8, 2018 between Mike Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office and Brent Turney, Change Application Unit Supervisor, Mike indicated the 1,960 acre-feet limitation was a place of use limitation only, that File Nos. 42,336 and 44,186 perfected 1,172 acre-feet of water (all additional) and would be able to pump the full amount if File No. 41,463 does not pump, therefore the consumptive use reduction must be to the 1,172 acre-feet currently authorized by File Nos 42,336 and 44,186. Pursuant to the K.A.R. 5-5-16 (a)(2)(C)(i) calculation:

586 max acres (File Nos. 42336/44186) x 1.40'(80% Stevens) = 965 AF to be authorized between File Nos. 42,336 and 44,186.

However, 1960 acre-feet is all that is authorized amongst File Nos. 41,463; 42,336 and 44,186 combined so:

1960 AF – 965 AF (File Nos. 42,336 and 44,186) = 995 acre-feet to remain authorized for File No. 41,463.

A rate test conducted on the presently authorized well by Southwest Groundwater Management District No. 3 staff indicates that 1,907 gallons per minute will be split between File Nos. 42,336 and 44,186. The water right owners chose to retain 753 acre-feet and 1,350 g.p.m. on the well to remain authorized by File No. 42,336 and move 212 acre-feet and 557 g.p.m. for File No. 44,186 to the new well.

The water right owners also propose to move the 61 acre-feet and 620 g.p.m. authorized by File No. 42,210 to the new well location to be authorized by File No. 44,186, a distance move of approximately 2,368 feet. The proposed well appears to meet well spacing requirements.

The water right owners also propose to create an exact overlap in the place of use among File Nos. 41,463; 42,210; 42,336 and 44,186 for a total of 1,203 acres to be irrigated in Sections 14,15 and 16. The total quantity to be authorized under the referenced file numbers, 2,021 acre-feet, can irrigate the proposed 1,203 acres with 1.68 acre-feet per acre which appears reasonable and complies with K.A.R. 5-3-19.

Based on WRIS and the application map the only wells within one-half mile of the proposed new well are owned by the water right owners, and the proposed change in place of use creates an exact overlap in place of use among all of the referenced file numbers, so no nearby well owner notification letters sent.

The same local source of supply will not change, previously determined to be Tertiary System (200)/Ogallala Formation (211).

Approval of the application for File No. 44,186 will be subject to the condition that for the sole purpose of administering wells concerning direct impairment, the additional well shall be considered to have the priority of the date the application was filed (July 16, 2018) to add the additional well.

In a letter dated September 25, 2018, Jason L. Norquest, Assistant Manager of Southwest Groundwater Management District No. 3, indicated that the Board of Directors recommended approval of the referenced applications at this time.

In an e-mail dated September 27, 2018, Mike Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office recommended approval of the applications.

Water flow meters are required. A water level measurement tube and check valves are required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended that the referenced applications be approved.

Enclosed are the orders executed by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, approving the applications for change under the above referenced file numbers.

Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, and limitations specified in these approvals for change. A condition of these approvals is that acceptable water flow meters must be installed on the diversion works authorized under the referenced file numbers. Please return the required notification of completion of the diversion works and/or installation of the required meters as soon as these actions are completed.

Please note that the application to change the point of diversion for File No. 44,186 is approved subject to the condition that for the sole purpose of administering wells concerning direct impairment, the additional well shall be considered to have the priority of the date the application was filed (July 16, 2018) to add the additional well. In addition, the Chief Engineer specifically retains jurisdiction in this matter with authority to review the approval of the additional well at intervals of no fewer than five years, and no more than ten years to determine if the total annual quantity of water actually being withdrawn by all wells authorized by the approval of application for change is exceeding the total annual quantity of water that could have been physically withdrawn if the additional well had not been approved, and based on the review, the Chief Engineer retains authority to make a reasonable reduction in the authorized quantity of water as may be deemed to be in the public interest.

Since these orders modify the original documents referred to above, they should be recorded with the Register of Deeds as other instruments affecting real estate.

APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND ORDER REDUCING THE AUTHORIZED DIVERSION RATE AND QUANTITY WATER RIGHT FILE NO. 42,336

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Greg Grewell and Donald P. Grewell, on behalf of Grewell Land L.L.C., 193 Road 12, Hugoton, Kansas, 67951, and GPG L.L.C. and DKGG L.L.C., 1114 Road A, Hugoton, Kansas, 67951, received in this office on July 16, 2018, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated June 12, 2003, approving the application to change the place of use, and by the Findings and Order of the Chief Engineer dated August 22, 2013, reducing the authorized place of use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

This order effectively reduces the authorized diversion rate to 1,350 gallons per minute (3.01 c.f.s.) of water per calendar year, and the authorized quantity to 753 acre-feet of water per calendar year in accordance with the Application for Approval to Change the Place of Use, File No. 42,336 received in the Office of the Chief Engineer on July 16, 2018.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the irrigation place of use shall be:

All diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 42,336, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated April 26, 2002, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 - 6777.

It was good to see you when you were here a week (or two maybe three lol) ago! We had talked a bit about the Grewell applications and I think you wanted me to send you what we need. Unfortunately I am just now getting back to this. I had discussed this with Mike and Brent and here is what we need to get these applications moving:

- They need to determine how they want to split the 1907 g.p.m between the well to remain authorized by File No. 42336 and the proposed additional well to be authorized by File No. 44186 the 2400 g.p.m. limitation on the rate on File No. 44186 will then be removed We will keep 1350gpm on the current well under 42336 and move 557gpm over with 44186.
- They will have to determine how to split 965 acre-feet between File No. 42336 and 44186 since they perfected their quantity from the same well
 - K.A.R. 5-5-16 calculation: 586 max perfected acres (File Nos. 42336/44186) x 1.40'(80% Stevens) = 965 AF Here we will keep 753AF on current well under 42336. Then move the 212AF over with 44186 to stack on the 61AF of 42210.
- Senior File No. 41463 would have to take a reduction to 995 acre-feet to get rid of the quantity limitation on File No 44186(44186 limited to 1960 AF w/c 41463 and 42336). If all File Nos. 42336 and 44186 can pump is 965 AF all 41463 could pump would be 1960 AF 965 AF(42336/44186) = 995 AF left for File No. 41463 so I guess they need to decide which well takes the 5 AF reduction. To reduce the 5AF, he wants to take it all off one well. So the well under ID 1 in section 15 will stay at 500AF and the well under ID 3 in section 14 will drop to 495AF.

If you need something else or prefer I write them a letter, just let me know. Thanks, as always, for your help!





In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.
