Harrison Krey, Ethan and Jaycee Bruland, and Glen and Tammy Weidner, have filed applications to change the authorized place of use under the above referenced files.

The referenced files do not appear abandoned pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-718.

The certificates authorize a limited total of 670 acre-feet of groundwater for irrigation of the same 405 acres in Section 19, Township 34 South, Range 39 West and Section 25, Township 34 South, Range 40 West, Morton County, Kansas. File Nos. 42,399 and 43,153 overlap in their authorized point of diversion and File No. 41,785 has no point of diversion overlap. Garden City Field Office staff recently discovered during a review of aerial photos that the pivot located in Section 25, Township 34 South, Range 40 West, Morton County, is not in the approved location. The original approval documents, the 1998 change in place of use maps, and the map on the June 30, 1999 Field Inspection Report all show the location of the pivot in Section 25 as authorized. However, 2002 aerial photography taken during the perfection period of the three files shows the pivot as it is actually located today. In addition, an aerial photo submitted with a July 3, 2007 memorandum to the files by Garden City Field Office staff shows the pivot as it is located today, but the discrepancy between the legal description of the pivot and the actual pivot location was not identified at that time. There are no records to indicate that the water right owner was ever notified that the pivot is in the wrong location so that actions could have been taken during the perfection period to correct the error. Based upon this information it appears that the changes should be approved nunc pro tunc as June 30, 1999, the date of the Field Inspection Report, to authorize the pivots as actually installed.

The referenced change application will not change the number of authorized acres, just the location of the acres. The authorized 670 acre-feet will still irrigate the 405 acres with 1.65 acre-feet per acre, which appears reasonable.

The same local source of supply will not change, previously determined to be Quaternary System (100)/Ogallala Formation (211).

The application and attachments was sent for review to Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3. In a letter dated June 27, 2018, Jason Norquest, Assistant Manager of Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3 indicated that the proposal is not in conflict with their regulations and recommended approval.

In an e-mail dated July 9, 2018, Michael Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office, recommended the referenced applications for change be approved and requested that the meters be sealed to the pipe on both wells. The wells will be better described as per February 14, 2018 compliance investigations.

Water flow meters will be required. Check valves are required if chemigating.

Based on the above discussion, that the change approvals are approved nunc pro tunc, that the changes are reasonable, that impairment of existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended that the referenced change applications be approved.

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

FINDINGS

1. That on May 15, 1998, the Chief Engineer approved an application pursuant to File No. 43,153, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use which authorized the diversion of groundwater by means of one (1) well located in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE½ SE½ SW½) of Section 19, more particularly described as being near a point 150 feet North and 2,790 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 34 South, Range 39 West, Morton County, Kansas, at a maximum diversion rate not in excess of 1,500 gallons per minute (3.34 c.f.s.) and in a quantity not to exceed 600 acre-feet of water per calendar year, for irrigation use at the following described location:

- 3. That on June 30, 1999, a field inspection was conducted as required by K.S.A. 82a-714 on the well authorized by File No. 43,153. The well was found to be located as follows: one (1) well located in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE¼ SE¼ SW¼) of Section 19, more particularly described as being near a point 110 feet North and 2,710 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 34 South, Range 39 West, Morton County, Kansas. That on February 22, 2008, the Chief Engineer, in accordance with K.S.A. 82a-714, issued a Certificate of Appropriation pursuant to File No. 43,153, for beneficial use which authorized the diversion of groundwater by means of a well located in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE¼ SE¼ SW¼) of Section 19, more particularly described as being near a point 110 feet North and 2,710 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 34 South, Range 39 West, Morton County, Kansas, at a diversion rate not in excess of 1,085 gallons per minute (2.42 c.f.s.) and a quantity not to exceed 250 acre-feet of water per calendar year for irrigation use on the following described property:

5. That the Certificate of Appropriation pursuant to File No. 43,153 also modified the additional rate and quantity limitations as follows:

This appropriation right is further limited to a diversion rate and a quantity of water which when combined with the water right set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to File No. 42,399, will provide a maximum diversion rate not in excess of 1,085 gallons per minute (2.42. c.f.s.) and a total quantity not to exceed 250 acrefeet of water per calendar year for irrigation use at the location described herein.

6. That a review of aerial photography by Garden City Field Office staff discovered that the pivot located in Section 25, Township 34 South, Range 40 West, Morton County, Kansas, is not located as authorized. The original approval documents, and the map on the June 30, 1999 Field Inspection Report all show the location of the pivot in Section 25 as authorized. However, 2002 aerial photography shows the pivot as it is located today. In addition, an aerial photo submitted with a July 3, 2007 memorandum to the files by Garden City Field Office staff shows the pivot as it is located today, but the discrepancy between the legal description of the pivot location and the actual pivot location was not identified at that time.

- 7. That there are no records to indicate that the water right owner was notified that the pivot is in the wrong location, so that actions could be taken at that time to correct the error in the description of the authorized place of use such as the filing of a change application.
- 8. That on April 9, 2018, the office of the Chief Engineer received an application for approval to change the place of use for File No. 43,153 from Harrison Krey, 1760 Road 20, Rolla, Kansas, 67954, and Ethan and Jaycee Bruland, and Glen and Tammy Weidner, P.O. Box 565, Humphrey, Nebraska, 68642, requesting approval to change the location of the place of use to where the pivots are actually located:

That it has been determined by the Chief Engineer that said application as described in Paragraph No. 8 of these findings is in proper form and should be approved subject to three conditions: 1) All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an inline, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer. 2) The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year. 3) A seal shall be placed on the water flowmeter by the Division of Water Resources in such a manner as to render the meter non-removable from the measuring chamber without breaking the seal. If the seal is broken without the written permission of the chief engineer, this shall create a rebuttable presumption that the point of diversion had been unlawfully operated in violation of the order of the chief engineer and that the water right holder had been acting in violation of the conditions of his or her water right. If any such violation occurs, a written order shall be issued by the chief engineer stating the nature of the violation and the civil penalty, suspension of water right or modification to the water right, or any combination of these to be imposed.

10. That the application for approval to change the place of use for File No. 43,153 received in the office of the Chief Engineer on April 09, 2018, should be approved nunc pro tunc "now for then" to henceforth be considered as having been approved on June 30, 1999, the date of the field inspection.

- 11. That during a February 14, 2018 compliance investigation by personnel from the Garden City Field Office, it was determined with the use of a global positioning device that the irrigation well described in Paragraph No. 4 of these findings is actually located as follows:
 - one (1) well located near the center of the South side (CS) of Section 19, more particularly described as being near a point 138 feet North and 2,632 feet West of the Southeast corner said section, in Township 34 South, Range 39 West, Morton County, Kansas.
- 12. That K.A.R. 5-5-6(a) states:
 - (a) If an application to appropriate water for beneficial use is approved by the chief engineer, the location of the point of diversion shall be limited to a specific tract of land and to within 300 feet of a point identified in distances measured in feet north and west from the southeast corner of the legal section.
- 13. The actual location of the point of diversion described in Paragraph No.11 is in compliance with K.A.R. 5-5-6(a).

If the seal is broken without the written permission of the chief engineer, this shall create a rebuttable presumption that the point of diversion had been unlawfully operated in violation of the order of the chief engineer and that the water right holder had been acting in violation of the conditions of his or her water right. If any such violation occurs, a written order shall be issued by the chief engineer stating the nature of the violation and the civil penalty, suspension of water right or modification to the water right, or any combination of these to be imposed.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation for Beneficial Use of Water, issued pursuant to Water Right, File No. 43,153 dated February 22, 2008, remains as authorized.

This is a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). You may pursue judicial review of this Order as provided in the Kansas Judicial Review Act. K.S.A. 77-601 et seq. A petition for judicial review must be filed in a Kansas court of competent jurisdiction within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-613. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review on behalf of the Kansas Department of Agriculture is the Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Dr. Manhattan, KS 66502.

I have been reviewing the referenced changes which propose to correct the place of use.

The original approval maps, 1998 change in pu maps, map on the Field Inspection Reports in 1999 by Jim Congrove show the pivot in Section 25 as is shown as currently authorized on the map with the 2018 change apps.

Chuck Schmidt's 2007 aerial photo accompanying his memo show the pivot as actually located but did not pick up on the discrepancy between legal description and actual pivot location.

Do you think we should do a nunc pro tunc on this? Do we have aerial imagery or other info that shows the pivot was always located as it currently is located?

What are the individual and combined base acres on these?

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.
