**Authorized Place of use**

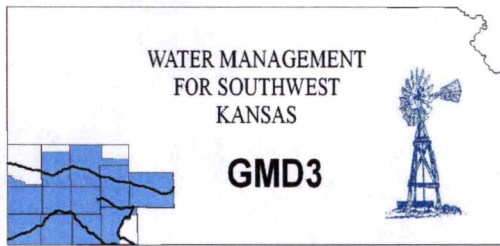
