David Clawson on behalf of High Plains Ponderosa Dairy, LLC, filed applications for approval to change the place of use authorized for stockwatering use. The applications for change were received in the Office of the Chief Engineer on June 26, 2017. It was determined toward the end of the processing a portion of the proposed stockwatering place of use is authorized for irrigation. The owners decided to change the irrigated place of use and applications for change were received on February 25, 2019, with the processing delayed for signatures.

The change in place of use is to expand the dairy and utilize the referenced files as dual use for irrigation and stockwatering. The requested change in point of diversion is to an exiting point of diversion.

The rights appear to be in compliance with K.S.A. 82a-718 with K.S.A. 82a-732. The applications are in compliance with K.A.R 5-5-2a, and appear to comply with K.S.A. 82a-1906, without any sent notifications as there are no well owners within one-half (½) mile of the wells authorized or proposed other than of the owners.

The referenced files are part of twenty-one (21) files authorized a limited 3,080 acre-feet (AF) for only irrigation use on 3,300 acres in Seward County and Meade County. File Nos. 41,578, 41,579 & 41,580, each authorize three (3) separate wells with File No. 41,580 further limited to 1,260 acre-feet, with File Nos. 41,578 & 41,579. The referenced files are also included in additional limitation on File No. 44,946, not to exceed 2,039.3 AF/YR at 2,000GPM. This limitation will remain on File No. 44,946. The requested change in use made of water is for dual use as allowed by K.A.R. 5-5-9, *Criteria for the approval of an application for a change in the use made of water from irrigation to any other type of beneficial use of water.* The regulation affords 84.8% of the permitted water to change to another use. This would limit the quantity to a total of 1,069 acrefeet (348 million gallons per year (mgy)) to be changed.

The proposed stockwatering use is an existing dairy located in the West Half (W½) and the Southeast Quarter (SE¼) of Section 18, Township 30, Range 33 West, Meade County, with a heard size of approximately 20,088 head. The dairy is currently authorized 223.5 million gallons (685.9AF) per year under File Nos. 12,332 and 45,387. The proposal is to expand to 30,000 head within the currently authorized place of use.

The submitted *Stockwatering Use Supplemental Sheet*, separately listed 14,500 cows and 13,000 heifers, with an annual total of 941.1 AF, equating to an average of 30.6 gallons per head per day for drinking water. The summary listed 592.6 AF (193.1 million gallons) per year for sanitation and cooling, equating to approximately 17.6 gallons per head per day at maximum capacity. K.A.R 5-3-22, *Maximum reasonable quantity of water for livestock and poultry* allows 35 gallons per head per day or 383.25 million gallons (1,176.15 AF) at the proposed maximum capacity for drinking. The regulation further allows 100 gallons per head per day in confined building capacity equating to 1,095 million gallons (3,360AF). A total of 1,478.11 million gallons per year (4,536.15 AF) for this type of stockwatering operation per K.A.R. 5-3-22. The dual stockwatering use permits under the referenced files will supply a limited additional 348.17 mgy (1,068.5 AF) to be added to the 223.5 mgy (685.9 AF) a total of 571.67 mgy (1,754.4 AF) for stockwatering use.

The owners have requested to utilize effluent as supplemental irrigation to maintain the currently authorized irrigated place of use. As a portion of the stockwatering use will be utilized for cooling and sanitation the request appears to be justified, approximately 593 AF will be available as waste water, resulting in only a 15% reduction in water available for the irrigation of 3,300 acres. The 2,604 AF available results in an overall irrigation ratio of 0.79AF per acre only slightly less than the current ratio of 0.93 represented by 21 water rights.

The requested change in point of diversion for File No. 41,578, proposes to move the 141 AF, irrigation use or 119.6 AF, stockwatering use, to be diverted at a rate of 410 gallons per minute to one(1) of the two(2) existing wells authorized under File No. 45,387. The proposed existing well us located approximately 2,124 feet to the Northwest and described as being located in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE½SW½ NW½) approximately 3,3787 feet North and 4,550 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 19, in Township 33 South, Range 31 West, Meade County. The authorized and proposed wells have been designated Ogallala Formation, (Code 211). The change in point of diversion will not alter the local source of supply, additionally it appears the change in point of diversion complies with part (b) of K.A.R. 5-23-3, *Minimum well spacing requirements: high plains aquifer*. The change proposes the well under File Nos. 41,578 & 45,387 authorize a maximum 539.96 AF. This quantity requires 2,300 feet of spacing per part (a) of K.A.R. 5-23-3. The WRIS database indicates the nearest nondomestic well is 2,355 feet away, File No. 44,946, and is owned by one of the applicants. There do not appear to be any domestic wells in the area.

In a letter dated May 24, 2019, copies of the applications were sent to Mark Rude, Manager of Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3 (GMD 3) along with a request to make a recommendation. In a letter dated June 11, 2019, Jason Norquest, Assistant Manager of GMD 3, indicated the proposal is not in conflict with their management plan and recommended approval of the applications.

Mike Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office, indicated that he is not opposed to approval of the applications, per his email dated June 27, 2019.

Water flowmeters are required for each use at the point of diversions authorized both irrigation and stockwatering use. Check valves are required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works. A notice of completion will be required for the requested change in point of diversion for File No. 41,578. The transmittal letter should also include the well plugging wording for File No. 41,578. It appears the term permit File No. 20199034 to overlap the point of diversion with File No. 41,579, is in the process of being worked.

A condition of the approvals will be the requirement of flow meters pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-706c. A check valve will be required if there will be any chemigation, but would be prudent for this type of stockwatering facility that will water dairy cattle.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, consumptive use will not increase, impairment of existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the referenced applications for change be approved.

Enclosed are the orders executed by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, approving the applications for change under the above referenced files.

Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, and limitations specified in the approvals for change. A condition of each approval is the requirement that an acceptable water flowmeter must be installed so both irrigation and stockwatering uses can be metered independent of each other, from each of the diversion works prior to the diversion of water. Please return the required and enclosed form Notification of Completion of the Diversion Works and/or Installation of the Required Meters as soon as these actions are completed.

Any well abandoned by these approvals must be plugged in accordance with the requirements of Article 30 of the Rules and Regulations as adopted by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment.

Additionally, the approval under File No. 41,580, further limits the quantity authorized for stockwatering use to 1,069 acre feet (348.33 million gallons) per calendar year when combined with the stockwatering use under File Nos. 41,578 & 41,579.

Since these orders modify the original documents referred to above, they should be recorded with the Register of Deeds as other instruments affecting real estate.

APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN USE MADE OF WATER, PLACE OF USE AND ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE AUTHORIZED QUANTITY OF WATER AND ORDER MODIFYING THE ADDITIONAL LIMITATION WATER RIGHT, FILE NO. 41,580

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of David Clawson on behalf of High Plains Ponderosa Dairy LLC, 2042 V Road, Plains, Kansas 67869, Rock Ormiston on behalf of Ormiston Trust of 1992, The Ormiston Decedents Trust et al, Southwest Agri-Center Incorporated, and Parity Investments Incorporated, all of 303 Main Street, Kismet, Kansas 67859, Carl Ray and Zita Bond, 125 W 590 Avenue, Girard, Kansas 66743-2380, Rock A. and Stephanie K. Ormiston II, PO Box 43, Kismet, Kansas 67859-0043, received in the office of the Chief Engineer on February 20, 2019, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Orders of the Chief Engineer dated December 31, 2012; November 27, 2013 and July 10, 2018, approving the applications to change the place of use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The authorized quantity of water under this right will remain 805 acre-feet (262.31 million gallons). This order effectively limits the authorized quantity of water to 682.64 acre-feet (222.44 million gallons) per calendar year for both stockwatering and irrigation uses combined. That the limitation on the quantity of water shall exist until such a time that the quantity of water for stockwatering use authorized by this approval is no longer required.

This order effectively modifies the additional limitation on the authorized quantity as set forth by the Certificate of Appropriation of the Chief Engineer, Water Right, File No. 41,580 as follows:

This appropriation right is further limited to a quantity of water which when combined with the water rights set forth in the Certificates of Appropriation issued pursuant to File Nos. 41,578 and 41,579 will provide a quantity not to exceed 1,069 acre-feet (348 million gallons) of water per calendar year for irrigation use or stockwatering use at the places of use described herein.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the portion retained for irrigation use shall be authorized on the following described property:

and the portion changed to stockwatering use shall authorize the place of use at the location described as being:

a dairy located in the West Half (W½) and in the Southeast Quarter (SE¼) of Section 18, in Township 33 South, Range 30 West, Meade County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the use made of water and place of use.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install a separate acceptable water meter for each use made of water for the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meters has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meters in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted for stockwatering and irrigation use may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meters and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application. File No. 41,580, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 10, 2009, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.



We have completed a review of the applications for the above referenced water rights. The proposed change in place of use is making a complete overlap in acres and covering the additional stock use follows criteria set forth in K.A.R. 5-5-11. The proposed change in used made of water to create a dual use for the water rights is in accordance with K.A.R. 5-5-9, in which the wells can now supply the dairy and maintain some irrigation with a limit on the water rights as long as stock water is needed. The proposed change in point of diversion is in accordance with current area rules, K.A.R. 5-23-3, as it pertains to distance moved and minimum spacing to neighboring wells. Well analysis for the change in point of diversion are discussed below.

Well evaluations were conducted to estimate possible effects of the proposal on the supply of other wells with water rights prior to the proposal per K.S.A. 82a-708b, and the draft revised management program. Under K.S.A. 82a-708b, an applicant requesting a change in point of diversion must demonstrate to the chief engineer that any proposed change is reasonable and will not impair. The enclosed report is an analysis performed by the GMD on behalf of our membership. Under this analysis, the proposed change is considered to be reasonable and unlikely to impair if either the net in-season well-to-well effect of the proposed change is less than a strict maximum allowable threshold (4.0 ft in cases where saturated thickness is greater than 200 ft), or if no well with a net well-to-well effect exceeding the threshold is identified as critical. Critical wells are identified as wells that are expected to either lose or greatly diminish water supply over the next 25 years. The attached review information is based on a Theis analysis using inputs from the GMD3 aquifer model, which is considered to be the best information on well and aquifer data readily and easily available to the public. If either the applicant or the neighbors believe they have better data that might change the result of the analysis, they should contact GMD3. Conclusions of the well analysis may change if better information on well and aquifer data can be made available.

Every neighboring well within 1 mile of the proposed move was evaluated. Evaluations showed that in no case did the net effect on neighboring wells exceed the 4.0 ft maximum allowable threshold. It appears that all neighboring wells are in some way a part of the overall operating system of those that signed the applications. Therefore, GMD3 sees this move as reasonable and unlikely to impair neighboring wells. It should also be noted that the calculations is based on maximum annual quantity and rate. All other aspects of the applications also meets current area rules. It is therefore recommended that the applications be approved.

You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense
