#### <u>MEMORANDUM</u>

Keegan Narin representing Narin & Narin Farms submitted applications on November 25, 2019, to change the irrigated place of use under File Nos. 4019 & 4107, and also signed a request to reduce the place of use with Gary Floyd on behalf of R & E Family Farms LP for File No. 9043.

The referenced rights appear not be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718, and in compliance with K.S.A. 82a-732. The required notice of well owners has been completed, complying with K.S.A. 82a-1906. It appears the applications for change comply with K.A.R. 5-5-1a and the requested reduction with K.A.R. 5-7-5.

Currently File Nos. 4019 & 9043 authorize 477 acres in the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of Section 31 and the West Half (W½) of section 32, all in Township 28, Range 39 West, Stanton County with a combined total of 954 acre feet, equating to 2 acre-foot per acre. The quantities are assigned per right with no overlapping limitations. File No. 4107 authorizes 320 acres in the South Half (S½) of Section 31 with an annual quantity of 640 acre feet, also providing 2 acre-feet per acre. The rights are not located within a special use area but are within the boundaries of Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3. The maps depicting the current place of use were corrected as File No. 4019 it didn't show the Northeast Quarter (NE¼) of Section 31 and File No. 4107, should show the South Half (S½) of Section 31.

The requested reduction will leave File No. 9043 to stand on its own to authorize 320 acres in the West Half (W½) of Section 32 with its developed 554 acre-feet, resulting in an irrigation ratio of 1.73 acre-feet per acre. This request complies with K.A.R. 5-3-23, *Maximum reasonable annual quantity approvable for irrigation use for an application for change in place of use and a request to reduce a water right*. The reduction results in R&E Family Farms LLC as owner of File No. 9043.

The requested reduction leaves File No. 4019, authorized 157 acres in the Northeast of Section 31 to be irrigated with 400 acre-feet to be overlapped with File No. 4107 that authorizes 320 acres located in the South Half (S1/4) of Section 31, authorized to be irrigated with 640 acre-feet. Together, File Nos. 4019 & 4107 will authorize 477 acres with a combined total of 1,040 acre-feet. The proposed changes are to make a complete overlap of the authorized acres without any modifications to the irrigated acres. The applications will be processed by Part b(1) of K.A.R. 5-5-11 Applications for change in place of use for irrigation purposes. The rights are all certified and the applications were filed to make an identical place of use with each right. It appears the determination of base acres is not necessary per the regulation. However, the requested change will result in an irrigation ration of 2.18 acre-foot per acre. To comply with K.A.R. 5-3-23, Maximum reasonable annual quantity approvable for irrigation use for an application for change in place of use and a request to reduce a water right, per part (c) the maximum certified was found to be two (2) acrefeet per acre. The owner, Keegan Narin was contacted by email February 18, to review the proposal. the regulation and our standard of applying a quantity limitation on the junior right, and send a copy of the modified application. In an email dated February 19, Keegan indicated Narin & Narin Farms was "OK" with the additional limitation on File No. 4107, limiting the quantity to 954 acre-feet for the requested approval of the place of use changes.

As the place of use will not be increasing and the quantity under File No. 4107 will be limited to not exceed 2 acre-feet per acre as developed by the appropriations, the changes should not result in an increase in the consumptive use, thus complying with K.A.R. 5-5-3, *Change in consumptive use*.

A Compliance Investigation completed by DWR staff on October 13, 2016 on the well under File No. 4019 determined the well to be within 20 feet of authorized. The approval under this right will update the well, ID 4, to be located 5,124 feet North and 2,006 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 31, Township 28 South, Range 39 West, Stanton County. The actual location complies with part (a) of K.A.R. 5-5-6, Failure to construct diversion works at authorized location.

In a letter dated February 26, 2020, Jason Norquest, Assistant Manager, Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3, recommend approval of the applications with the limitation on File No. 4107, and reduction in place of use on File No. 9043.

It appears there may be a domestic well in the area, an old nonauthorized irrigation well, in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW¼ NE¼) of Section 31, which is owned by one of the applicants. As required by KSA 82a-1906, notification was sent to Welch-Barber Resources LP, owner of the two irrigation rights, File Nos. 478 & 9428, located to the North of this project.

Michael Meyer, Water Commissioner of the Garden City Field Office area reviewed the proposed applications. In an email dated March 3, 2020, he requested the notification be reviewed as well as double checking the corrections to the maps. He recommended approval of the package.

Water flowmeters will be required for the change approvals pursuant to K.A.R. 5-5-11(e)(2). Check valves will be required, if chemigating. As no new wells will be drilled a water level measurement tube and WWC-5 will not be a condition of the approvals.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes will create a place of use that is reasonable, and the historical consumptive use will not be increased, that impairment to existing water rights are unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the referenced applications be approved.

Any use of water that is not as authorized by the water right or permit to authorize water <u>before</u> the chief engineer approves this application is a violation of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act for which criminal or civil penalties may be assessed. Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). Civil penalties shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 per violation. In the case of a continuing violation, each day such violation continues may be deemed a separate violation. In addition to these penalties the water right may be modified or suspended. K.S.A. 82a-737, as amended.

The application must be signed by all owners of the place of use authorized under the water right and his or her spouse, if married. Please indicate if there is no spouse. If land is being purchased under contract, the seller must sign as landowner until such time as the contract is completed.





The change overlapping of the place of use in Section 31 to authorize 477 acres under the files 4019 (400 AF) & 4107 (640 AF), will result in 1,040 acre-feet of water per year as certified under these two rights. This would result in 2.18 AF/acre. Due to the regulation KAR 5-3-23, requiring the maximum reasonable annual quantity for this area to be 2 acre-feet per acre the junior file, File No. 4107, should have a quantity limitation added. It will limit the quantity to 954 acre-feet and the approval for the requested change under File No. 4107 will state the limitation as:

This appropriation right is further limited to a quantity of water which when combined with the water right set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to File No. 4,019 will provide a total quantity not to exceed 954 acrefeet of water per calendar year for irrigation use at the location described herein.

Enclosed are the orders executed by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, approving the applications for change under the above referenced file numbers.

Since these orders modify the original documents referred to above, they should be recorded with the Register of Deeds as other instruments affecting real estate.

Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms and conditions specified in these approvals for change. A condition of the approvals is that an acceptable water flowmeter must be installed on the diversion works authorized under the referenced files. Please be reminded that the quantity of water authorized under File No. 4,107, is limited with the senior right listed herein.

An annual water use report must be filed with the Chief Engineer by March 1, following the end of each calendar year. If a complete annual water use report is not received by the deadline, then a fine may be assessed and all water use under such permit or right may be suspended. Reports submitted in paper form will be assessed a \$20 per file number paper filing fee. In order to avoid this filing fee, submit your reports online at www.kswaterusereport.org.

Road G, Johnson, Kansas 67855-8861, received in the office of the Chief Engineer on November 25, 2019, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated June 26, 1984, approving the application to change the place of use and point of diversion, and the Order of the Chief Engineer dated June 19, 1990, approving the application to change the point of diversion, and by the Correction Order of the Chief Engineer dated January 30, 1991, correcting the location of the point of diversion, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the place of use for irrigation use shall be:

That information in the office of the Chief Engineer finds that the point of diversion authorized would more accurately be defined as:

one (1) well located near the center of the North side of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW¼ NE¼) of Section 31, more particularly described as being near a point 5,124 feet North and 2,006 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 28 South, Range 39 West, Stanton County, Kansas.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 4,019, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated August 10, 1960, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

#### RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.
