

We have completed a review of the applications for the above referenced water rights. The proposed change in place of use are not in conflict with the Management Program of the Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3 (GMD3). The proposed change in place of use will make a complete overlap and increases base acres by 10 acres in accordance with K.A.R. 5-5-11(b).

The proposed change in allocation between the wells under Water Right 17668 meets the criteria set forth in K.A.R. 5-23-3, as it pertains to distance moved and minimum spacing to neighboring wells. These two wells have had reallocation applications approved in the recent past. Each time the analysis showed possible effects within our guidelines. The most recent reallocation approved does not give us enough history for an analysis. It is also noted that this proposed reallocation will only change the original certified amounts by a minimal amount and would more than likely be minimal effects for the area.

After review of all this information, it is therefore recommended that the applications be approved at this time.

Is a waiver needed: The change in PU increase base acres by the 10acres allowed and will make a complete overlap. The reallocation is moving authority back to very similar to how it was originally. Looking at how it was certified, we are moving a very small amount (roughly 12AF). Not enough time since the last reallocation to really determine if there will be effects since then.

Recommendation: <u>after review of all available information</u>, it appears that the proposal meets current area rules. When going back to certificate for 17668, we are dealing with a small amount in the reallocation and is hard to do analysis since the previous changes really were not in place long enough to get good data on the possible effects to the area. Also, the previous analysis showed possible effects within our guidelines. Staff therefore recommends approval of the applications.

attached is a request for a recommendation for the pending applications.

all applications are proposing to make a complete overlap in place of use and to add a center pivot. some pivots have been moved and to current size proposal

base acres are as follows:

16613 has 264 base acres

17668 has 265 base acres

26150 has 130 base acres

41286 has 120 base acres

total base acres = 779 acres.

the proposal is to add 10 acres above base for File Nos. 17668, add 10 acres above base of File Nos.

16613/4286, and add 10 acres above base for File No. 26150

(30 additional acres above base for these individual sperate water rights)

total proposed for application= 806 acres

also, recall, in the past File no. 17668 has been shifting quantities between the two wells under the same water right to manage rotation of crops. therefore, there is a change in point of diversion under File No. 17668 to even out the quantities between the two wells. now that they got the ground healthy again, plumbing all wells together, this should be the final quantity shift between the 2 wells.

Good afternoon,

As you have probably heard, there is a significant water related legislative bill that was introduced last week and being heard this week. You may have, or get, questions about what is in the bill or what it means for you. So here is the relatively short explanation as I know it.

Reorganization

- Creates a new secretary led cabinet level agency, the Kansas Department of Water and Environment combining
 - KDA Division of Water Resources
 - KDA Division of Conservation
 - KDHE Division of Environment
 - o Kansas Water Office
- All authorities, resources, and staff of current agencies and divisions would be moved to the newly created agency
- All current field offices would remain, although there would be a review over the next 5 years of the opportunity to co-locate field staff from the different divisions. That could mean combining field DWR and KDHE field offices if it made sense financially and if it serves the public well.
- There is no change to the authorities of the chief engineer due to this proposed change.

Funding and Fees

- Creates a water maintenance trust fund and trust board
- Increases water protection fee for municipal, industrial, and stockwater from 3 cents/1000 gallon to 5. (raises about \$2.5M)
- Creates a water right fee that is \$1 / authorized af, with a minimum of \$25 and maximum of \$250 per water right. Mun, Ind, and Stk exempt from water right fee since they are paying water protection fee. (raises about \$6M)

- Water protection fee continues to go into state water plan fund with recommendations from the Kansas Water Authority. SWPF becomes a subaccount of the water maintenance trust fund.
- Water right fee goes into water maintenance trust fund and overseen by trust board.

Groundwater Management Districts

- Changes board elections to one person one vote for anyone living within the GMD boundary.
- Changes the number of board members to 5, 7, or 9
- Requires that the GMD provide a financial accounting and budget to the legislature by Feb 1 of each year
- Requires that the GMDs identify areas of significant concern (GW decline) by end of 2024 and develop a plan to
 address the decline by 2026. If no plan is developed, Chief Engineer authorized to develop an IGUCA to address
 the issues and report back to the legislature annually by 2027

Secretarial Review of Chief Engineer Decision

- Removes secretarial review of chief engineer decisions that are currently allowed.
- Hearing procedure outlined by Kansas Administrative Procedure Act still apply and decisions can still be taken to district court

Dam Safety

- Exempts dry detention road fill and low head dams from many dam safety requirements, but still treated as stream obstruction
- Allows dam inspections to be done under the supervision of a licensed engineer rather than required the PE do the inspection
- Allows for civil penalties for dam safety violations
- Creates a dam safety emergency fund for use when dam owner doesn't have resources.
