

An application to change the place of use has been received for the referenced file which requests that the place of use be identical with Water Right, File Nos. 3,184; 7,755; 12,836 and 24,397 which approve 1,280 acres for irrigation. A certificate has been drafted for File No. 28,903 to be issued the day before the change is approved which will authorize 480 acres which are part of the 1,280 acres approved under the other files.

The four senior water rights authorize a total quantity of 2,013 acre-feet. The certificate for File No. 28,903 will authorize a quantity of 720 acre-feet and a limitation of 960 acre-feet when combined with the senior files for the 480 acres described on the certificate. This limitation will be modified to 2,560 acre-feet with the change approval to reflect 2 acre-feet per acre for the 1,280 acres. The additional quantity authorized under File No. 28,903 is 547 acre-feet (2,560-2,013).

The application complies with K.A.R. 5-5-11 as an identical overlap in place of use with other water rights is requested and no land not currently authorized under the other water rights is requested. The authorized quantity under the water rights which is 2 acre-feet per acre appears to be reasonable for irrigation of crops in Haskell County. A conservation plan pursuant to Administrative Policy No. 89-1 is not required since no additional land is being irrigated.

File No. 28,903 was determined to be in good standing as to non-use, pursuant to Administrative Policy No. 92-3, during the processing of the draft certificate.

Dear Austin:

We have completed a review of the application for the above referenced water right. The proposed change in point of diversion is in accordance with current area rules, K.A.R. 5-23-3, as it pertains to minimum spacing to neighboring wells and distance moved.

Well evaluations were conducted to estimate possible effects of the proposal on the supply of other wells with water rights prior to the proposal per K.S.A. 82a-708b, and the management program. Under K.S.A. 82a-708b, an applicant requesting a change in point of diversion must demonstrate to the chief engineer that any proposed change is reasonable and will not impair. The enclosed report is an analysis performed by the GMD on behalf of our membership. Under this analysis, the proposed change is considered to be reasonable and unlikely to impair if either the net in-season well-to-well effect of the proposed change is less than a strict maximum allowable threshold (3.0 ft with saturated thickness is between 125-150ft), or if no well with a net well-to-well effect exceeding the threshold is identified as critical. Critical wells are identified as wells that are expected to either lose or greatly diminish water supply over the next 25 years. The attached review information is based on a Theis analysis using inputs from the GMD3 aquifer model, which is considered to be the best information on well and aquifer data readily and easily available to the public. If either the applicant or the neighbors believe they have better data that might change the result of the analysis, they should contact GMD3. Conclusions of the well analysis may change if better information on well and aquifer data can be made available.

Every neighboring well within 1 mile of the proposed move was evaluated. Evaluations showed that several of the neighboring wells exceeded the net effect above the maximum allowable threshold and needed further evaluation. That evaluation showed the potential of the wells could be critical, if the proposed well is pumped at maximum authority. We did not receive any comments from neighboring well owners. Therefore, GMD3 sees this move as meeting current area rules and would recommend approval with verification that there will not be adverse effects to neighboring wells. If aquifer conditions change or there is a change to the water right in the future, we would be happy to evaluate the effects at that time.
