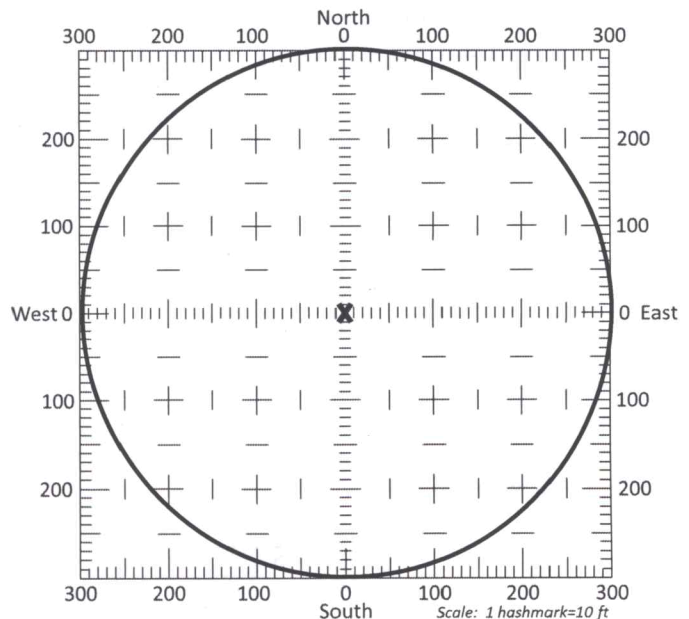

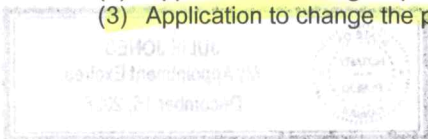

SUMMARY ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION FOR CHANGE AND IMPOSING CONDITIONS

This Summary Order is issued under authority of K.S.A. 82a-708b, as amended, and K.A.R. 5-5-1, *et seq.* and other applicable provisions of the *Kansas Water Appropriation Law, K.S.A. 82a-701 et seq.*, and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, With the exception of those conditions expressly contained herein, this Summary Order does not change the terms, conditions and limitations of File No. 21,865.

1. A change application was received on January 12, 2022 requesting that the place of use and / or point of diversion authorized under the above-referenced file number be changed as described in the application.
2. On and after the effective date of this summary order, the authorized place(s) of use shall be located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the place of use. Applicable Not Applicable
3. The change in point of diversion shall not impair existing rights and shall be limited to the same source or sources of water as previously authorized. 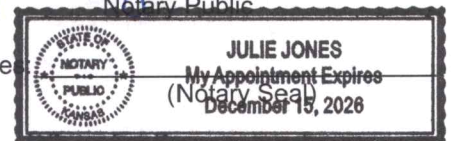

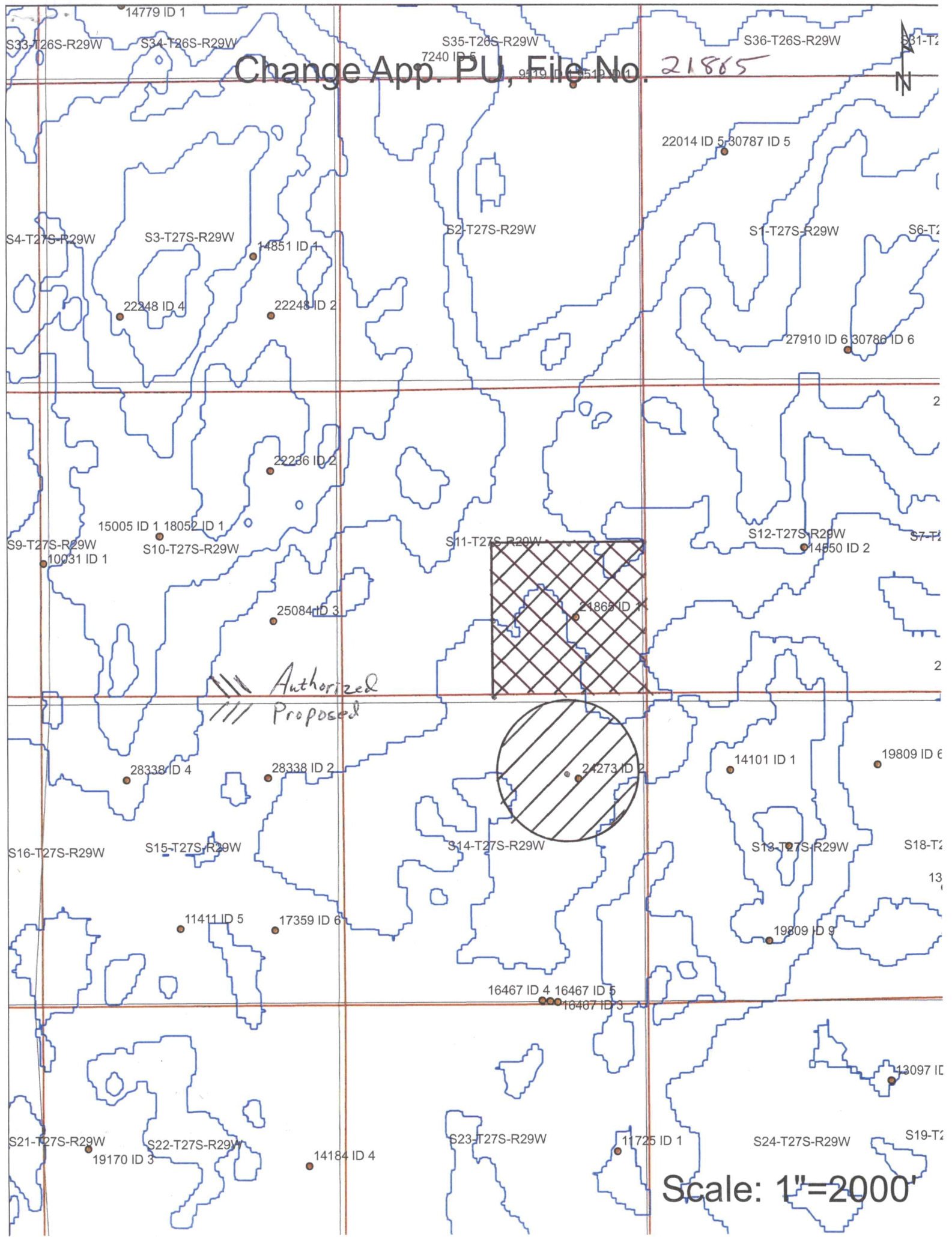

DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY FOR BUSINESS AND FINANCIAL PURPOSES

I, DENNIS L. WENDEL a/k/a as LEROY WENDEL, a resident of Gray County, Kansas, do hereby appoint my son DANIEL JOSEPH WENDEL, as my attorney in fact to act and sign for me in my name and stead, to exercise, do, or perform any act, right, power, duty or obligation whatsoever that I now have or may acquire, relating to any person, matter, transaction or property, real or personal, tangible or intangible, now owned or hereafter acquired by me. I grant to my agent full power and authority to do everything necessary in exercising any of the powers herein granted as fully as I might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution or revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that the agent shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of this durable power of attorney. Without in any manner limiting the foregoing general plenary grant of authority, my attorney in fact is specifically authorized to exercise the following enumerated powers:

1. To transact all of my business at any bank or other financial institution in which I may have deposited or may hereafter deposit or have deposited for me, any funds; to have access to my safety deposit box; to draw checks on my account in said bank or other financial institution, to endorse all checks, drafts and bills of exchange, securities, bonds, mutual funds, or other documents which may require my endorsement for collection or deposit; to waive demand, notice, and notice of protest thereon; and to open, remove from, and add to items in a bank safety deposit box on my behalf.

2. To forgive, request, demand, sue for, recover, collect, receive, hold all such sums of money, debts, dues, commercial paper, checks, drafts, accounts, deposits, legacies, bequests, devises, notes, interests, stock certificates, bonds, dividends, certificates of deposit, annuities, pension, profit sharing, retirement, Social Security insurance and other contractual benefits and proceeds, all documents of title, all property, real or personal, intangible and tangible property and property rights, and demands whatsoever, liquidated or unliquidated, now or hereafter owned by, or due, owing, payable or belonging to me or in which I have or may hereafter acquire an interest; to have, use, and take all lawful means and equitable and legal remedies and proceedings in my name for the collection and recovery thereof, and to adjust, sell, compromise, and agree for the same, and to execute and deliver for me, on my behalf, and in my name, all endorsements, releases, receipts, or other sufficient discharges for the same.

3. To prepare, execute, and file both federal and state income tax returns, or amendments thereto, and any claims for refund, or to make any report required by governmental agencies, to contract with and make claims to any governmental organization or private company with regard to any insurance matter, medical, or retirement related matters. This authority applies to KPERS, Social Security, Medicaid, Medicare, Farm Service Agency, Veteran's Administration, Social Security Administration, and Internal Revenue power of attorney and any other governmental agency. IRS form 2848 can be signed by my agent on my behalf.

4. To lease, sell, assign, mortgage, and convey personal property, standing in my name or which I may now or hereafter own, at market value; and to invest and reinvest the proceeds from such sales or deposit such proceeds in my account in any bank or financial institution in which I may have or may deposit funds. To execute, sign, and complete any documents necessary under the powers granted herein, including execution of contracts, leases, assignments, title transfers, and security agreements.

5. To lease, grant easements, and mortgage real estate, standing in my name or which I may now or hereafter own, at market value; and to invest and reinvest the proceeds from such mortgages or deposit such proceeds in my account in any bank or financial institution in which I may have or may deposit funds. To execute, sign, and complete any documents necessary under the powers granted herein, including execution of mortgages, leases, assignments, easements, rights of way, and security agreements.

6. My current homestead is located at 408 East 3rd Avenue, Ingalls, Kansas 67853. The legal description is

My agent has specific authority to sell, assign, mortgage or convey this homestead and to execute a contract, deed, mortgage, lease or assignment for this property. My agent has authority to designate a different homestead, domicile or residence on my behalf.

7. To maintain, repair, improve, invest, manage, insure, rent, lease, encumber, and in any manner deal with any real or personal property, tangible or intangible, or any interest therein, that I may now own or hereafter acquire, in my name and for my benefit, upon such terms and conditions as my agent shall deem proper. To take whatever action is necessary in order to collect any government benefit due me or any member of my family.

8. To operate my farm property with hired labor, tenants, or a farm management service; to supervise the farming operations; to lease or rent my land for cash or on shares; to sell, purchase, exchange or otherwise acquire or dispose of all farm products, or other proceeds from the land; and to pay on my behalf or charge to me fertilizer, chemicals, other related expenses.

9. To lease my property for oil, gas, or other minerals upon such conditions as may be customary in the community, regardless of whether the terms of such lease may extend beyond the termination of this power of attorney.

10. To execute contracts, notes chattel mortgages, and other agreements relating to agriculture with the Commodity Credit Corporation, the Secretary of Agriculture, the Farm Service Agency, or any other officer or agency of the federal or state government, or of any corporation organized under them; to enter into acreage reduction agreements; to make soil conservation commitments; and in general, to do all acts necessary to cooperate with any governmental agricultural program and to participate in and receive all payments and other benefits and proceeds under any such programs.

11. To apply for a certificate of title upon, and endorse and transfer title thereto, for any automobile, truck, pickup, van, boat, mobile home, motorcycle or other motor vehicle, and to represent in such transfer or assignment that the title to said motor vehicle is free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except those specifically set forth in such transfer assignment.

12. To waive the attorney/client privilege between myself and my attorney at law so that my attorney at law can freely communicate with the agent named herein.

13. To take any and all actions with life, health, property and casualty insurance as though he were, in fact, the owner thereof. This authorization includes but is not limited to, the power to apply for insurance, to select proper amounts and types of coverage, cancel, change insurers, and settle any and all claims with or without resort to litigation. As to any policy of life insurance, the attorney in fact shall have the power and right to surrender, cancel, or assign the policy, to pledge the policy for a loan, or to obtain a loan from the insurer on the cash surrender value of the policy so long as such action is reasonably done in the best interest of my person or estate. The receipt of the beneficiary or attorney in fact shall discharge the insurance company from any responsibility for proper expenditure.

This power of attorney shall become effective immediately and shall not be affected by my subsequent disability or incapacity.

I HEREBY GIVE AND GRANT unto my said attorney herein named full power and authority to do and perform all and every lawful act and thing whatsoever that may be necessary to be done, as fully and to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, and hereby ratify and confirm all that my attorney shall lawfully do, or cause to be done hereunder.

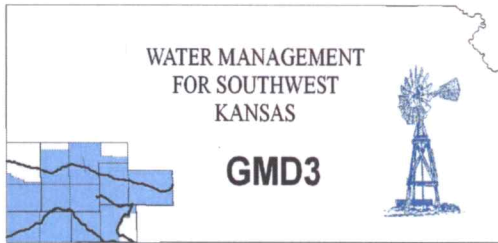
