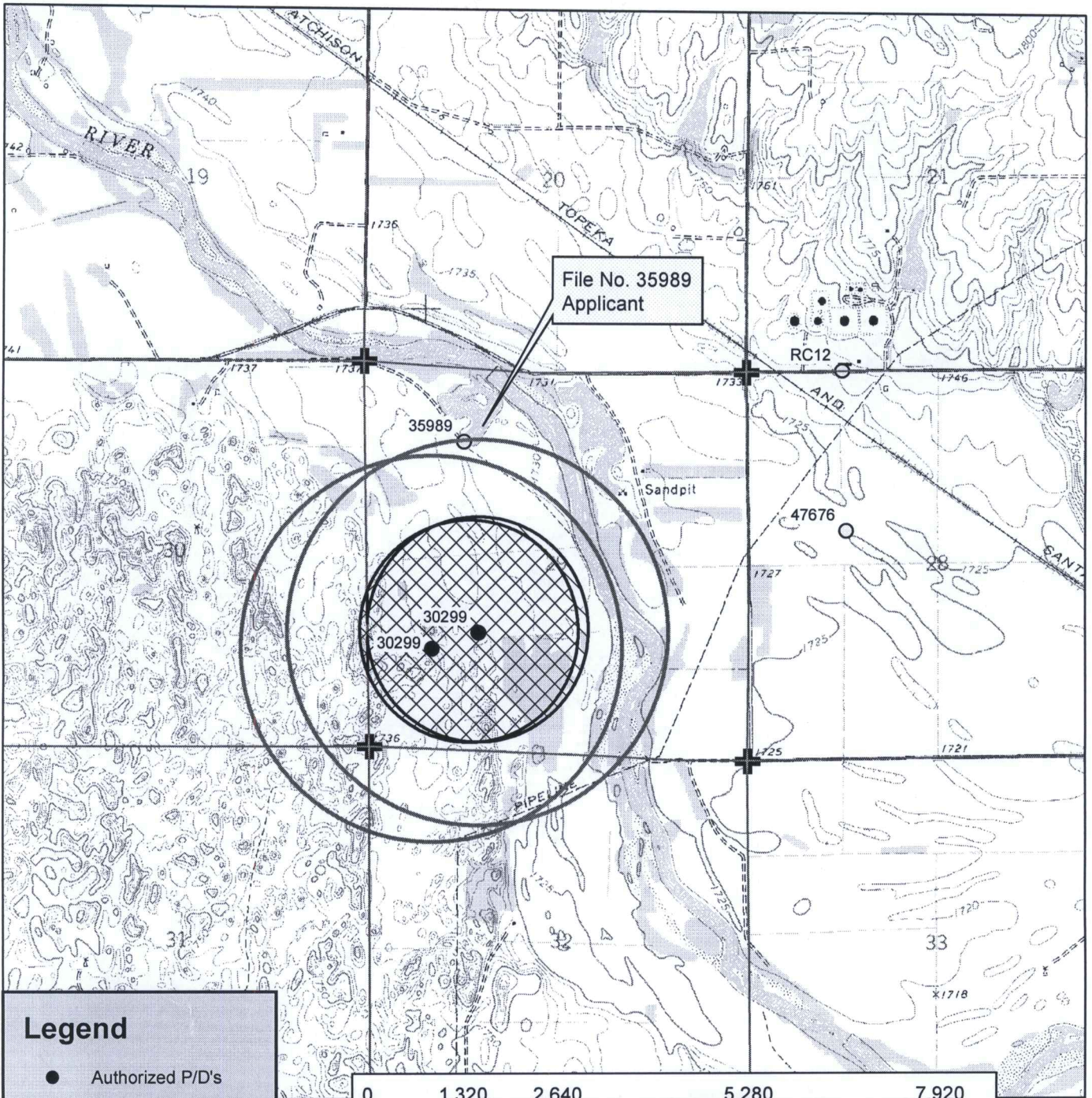
Change in Place of Use, Application Map

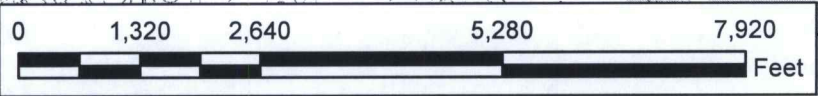

 29 -20S-10W // Rice County

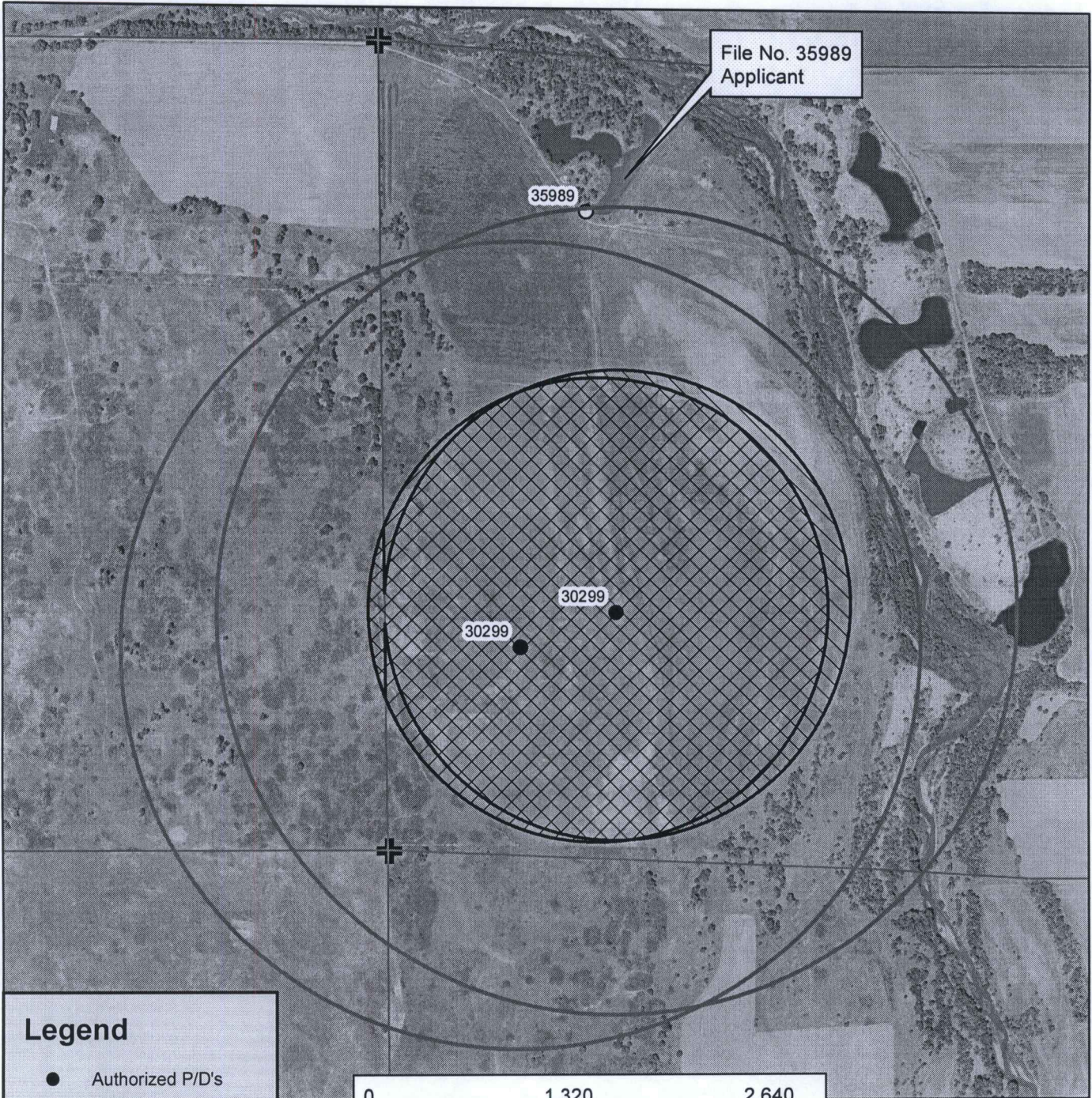

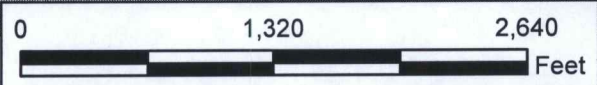
