- 1. That K.A.R. 5-25-2 (a)(1) *Well spacing* states in part that non-domestic wells shall be 1,320 feet from all other non-domestic wells and proposed non-domestic wells that carry an earlier priority; and baseflow nodes.
- 2. That the referenced file number, located in the Arkansas River Basin, is authorized two wells with assigned rates and quantities and shares a common irrigation place of use with Water Right, File No. 15,699. The application to change the point of diversion for Water Right, File No. 31,452 proposes to transfer 24 acre-feet (and no additional diversion rate) from the southernmost well to the northernmost well authorized by File No. 31,452 located 4,813 feet North and 1,305 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 20, Township 20 South, Range 14 West, Barton County. A total of 170 acre-feet and 820 gallons per minute will be authorized at the northernmost well under File No. 31,452.
- 3. That the proposed existing well under File No. 31,452 does not meet the 1,320 feet well spacing requirements to the well authorized by File No. 15,699 since the wells in question are approximately 981 feet apart.
- 4. That in a letter dated February 17, 2017, Big Bend Groundwater Management District No. 5 recommended approval of the referenced change application and waiver of K.A.R. 5-25-2 (a)(1). The wells in question are under common ownership.
- 5. That the referenced application for File Nos. 31,452 should be approved with a waiver of K.A.R. 5-25-2 (a)(1).
- 6. That the waiver of K.A.R. 5-25-2 (a)(1) will neither prejudicially nor unreasonably affect the public interest and it will not impair an existing water right.

Brent Clarke, President, on behalf of Clarke Farms, L.L.C., owner of the referenced file number, filed an application for approval to change the authorized point of diversion for File No. 31,452, authorized for irrigation use in the Arkansas River drainage basin.

The referenced water right does not appear abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

The referenced file number is authorized two wells with assigned rates and quantities for irrigation of 246 acres all located in Sections 17 and 20, Township 20 South, Range 14 West, Barton County, Kansas. File No. 31,452 is also limited to 244 acre-feet for irrigation use on the land described herein. The northernmost well in Section 20 was overlapped by MYFA Term Permit File No. 20127118 MF and will be overlapped by Application, File No. 20167075 MF. The southernmost well in Section 20 was overlapped by MYFA Term Permit File No. 20127117 MF and will be overlapped by Application, File No. 20167074 MF. The authorized place of use is overlapped by the referenced term permits and Water Right, File No. 15,699. The water right owner proposes to transfer 24 acre-feet (no rate) between wells authorized by File No. 31,452, specifically from the southernmost well (3,524'N, 2,608'W) to the northernmost well (4,813'N, 1,305'W) authorized by File No. 31,452. GPS data provided with the application indicate that the proposed move is approximately 1,833 feet. A limited total of 170 acre-feet and 820 gallons per minute will be authorized at the northernmost well while the southernmost well will be authorized a limited total of 97 acre-feet and 940 gallons per minute. No change is proposed to the overall limitation of 244 acre-feet.

WRIS and the application map indicate the only non-domestic well within one half mile of the northernmost well is the irrigation well under common ownership authorized by File No. 15,699 (approximately 981 feet based on WRIS). Numerous domestic wells were indicated on the application map since the town of Dundee is within the half-mile radius of the northernmost well.

The nearby domestic well owners were notified of the proposed change in point of diversion by letters dated January 11 and 25, 2017. Cathy McVey, nearby domestic well owner, contacted this office to inquire about the proposed change. Ms. McVey indicated the domestic well was drilled about five years ago, she has no present problems with the well and does not want any. The well appears to be located about 2,500 feet from the proposed existing well. She was informed that no new wells are being drilled, that quantity-only was being transferred and to contact the Stafford Field Office if she does become impaired. She was also instructed to put her concerns in writing and send them to this office by January 27th if there were further issues to be addressed; no written comments were received from her (or anyone for that matter) regarding the proposed change.

The same local source of supply does not appear to change, which appears to be Main Stem Alluvium (113) based on available information.

In a letter dated February 17, 2017 received via e-mail, Orrin Feril, Manager of Big Bend Groundwater Management District No. 5, indicated that the Board of Directors voted to waive K.A.R. 5-25-2 (a)(1) *Well spacing* since the proposed existing well does not meet spacing requirements to the well authorized by File No. 15,699.

In an e-mail dated February 28, 2017, Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office, indicated he recommends approval of the referenced change application.

A water flow meter is required. A check valve is required if any chemical or foreign substances are injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, that no change in the local source of supply will occur, and if the Chief Engineer waives K.A.R. 5-25-2 (a)(1), it has been recommended that the referenced application be approved.

APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION WATER RIGHT FILE NO. 31.452

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Brent Clarke, on behalf of Clarke Farms, L.L.C., 8822 3rd Street, Great Bend, Kansas, 67530, received in this office on December 27, 2016, for approval of a change in the location of the point of diversion under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated August 18, 1992, approving the application to change the place of use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the point of diversion shall be:

one (1) well located in Lot 4 of Section 20, more particularly described as being near a point 4,813 feet North and 1,305 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, at a diversion rate not in excess of 820 gallons per minute (1.83 c.f.s.) and in a quantity not to exceed 170 acre-feet of water per calendar year, and

one (1) well located in Lot 3 of Section 20, more particularly described as being near a point 3,524 feet North and 2,608 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, at a diversion rate not in excess of 940 gallons per minute (2.09 c.f.s.) and in a quantity not to exceed 97 acre-feet of water per calendar year,

both in Township 20 South, Range 14 West, Barton County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the map accompanying the application to change the point of diversion.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2017, or within any authorized extension of time. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 31,452, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated July 13, 1989, as modified and amended by the aforementioned order.

This Order shall become a final agency action, as defined by K.S.A. 77-607(b), without further notice to the parties, if a request for hearing or a petition for administrative review is not filed as set forth below.

Request for Hearing. According to K.A.R. 5-14-3(c), any party who desires a hearing must submit a request within 15 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order. Filing a request for a hearing will give you the opportunity to submit additional facts for consideration, contest any findings made by the Chief Engineer or present any other information you believe should be considered in this matter. A timely-filed request for hearing will stay the deadline for requesting administrative review of this Order pending the outcome of the hearing.

Petition for Review. Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition for administrative review, pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-708b(a) and K.S.A. 82a-1901(a). The petition must be filed within 30 days after the date shown on the Certificate of Service attached to this Order and must set forth the basis for the review, unless stayed by the timely filing of a request for hearing.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 - 6777.





When I was completing an application to change the point of diversion for the referenced file number, I observed that the GPS based footages for the north well (ID01) do not fall within 300 feet of the authorized description. After further review, I believe this is still the original well that was permitted. However, the section is oddly shaped and is substantially shorter on the east side than the west side. According to LeoBase 7, the east line of Section 20-20-14W is only 4,838 feet long and the west line is described at 5,316 feet long. A print out of this information is attached to this memo. Based on this information having a well in the northeast quarter described at 5,215 feet north is impossible. In fact, WRIS plotted the well in the wrong section because of this incongruity.

It is recommended that the footage description for the north well (ID01) under File No. 31452 be corrected with the next order issued.

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.
