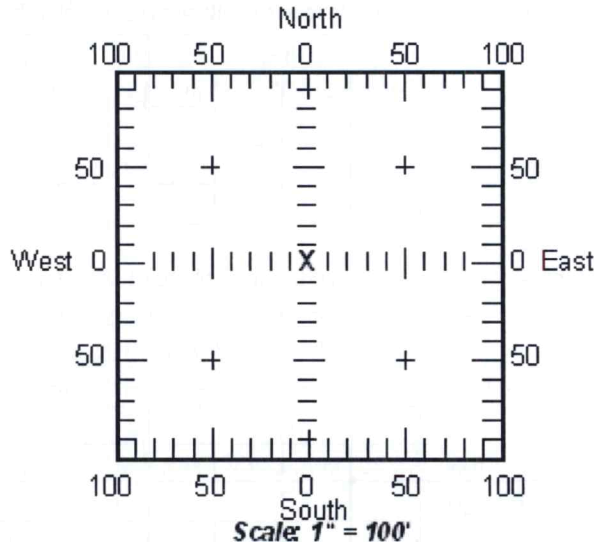

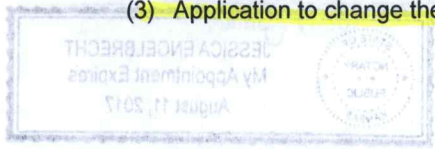

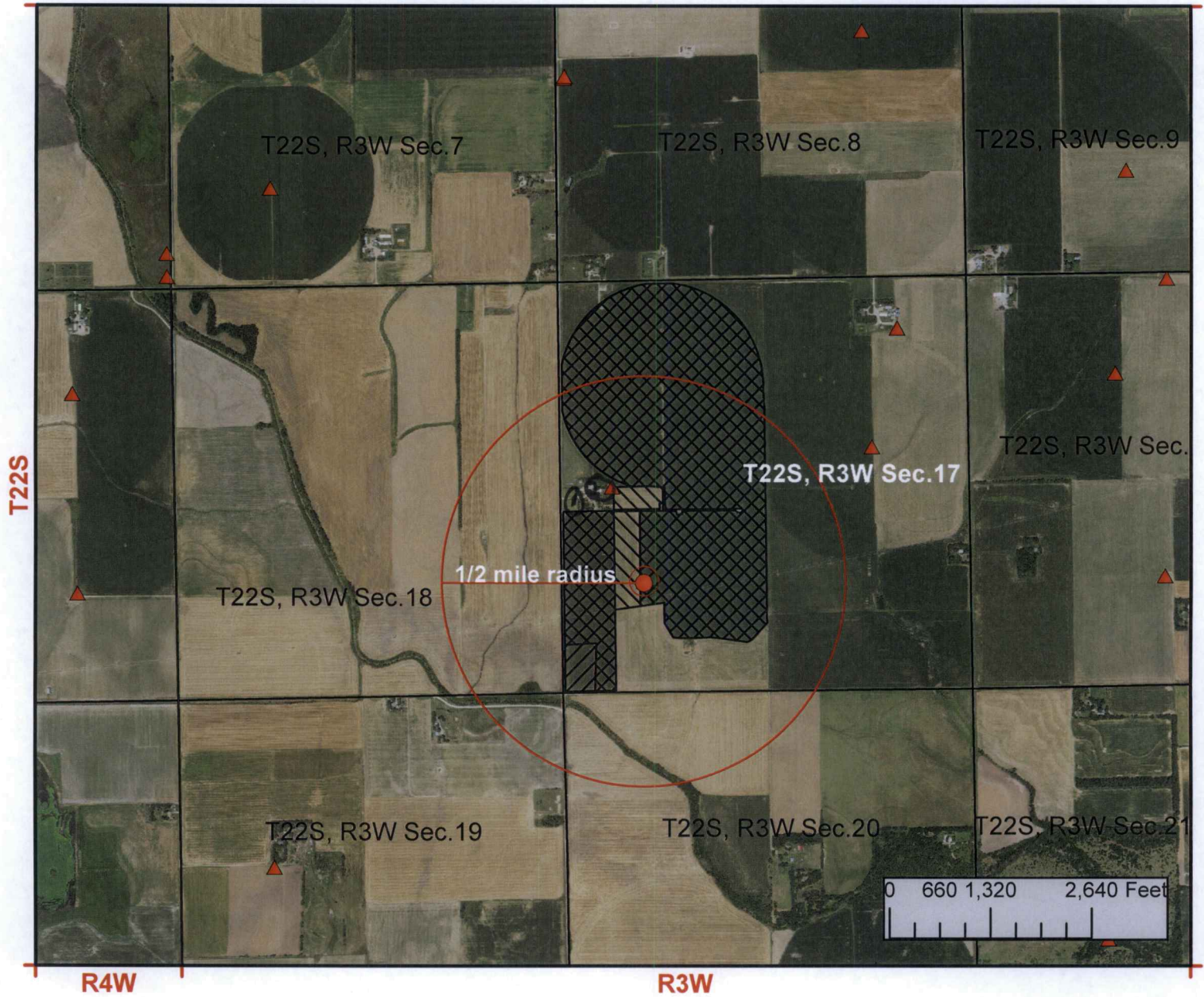

The Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2 reviewed the referenced change in place of use applications on August 7, 2017, using the District's Revised Management Program (effective May 1, 1995) and Rules and Regulations K.A.R. 5-22-1 through 5-22-17.

The change applications propose to increase the place of use from 238 acres to 246.5 acres and an identical place of use overlap will exist between Water Right Nos. 5642 & 33142, resulting in a water to land ratio of 1.087 acre-feet per acre.

The District's review found that the change applications comply with the Revised Aquifer Management program approved by the Chief Engineer and with the District's Rules and Regulations K.A.R. 5-22-1 through 5-22-17.

The Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2 made a recommendation to the Division of Water Resources that Change Application Nos. 5642 & 33142 approved. Pursuant to K.A.R. 5-22-4a, the wells described in the applications must be equipped District approved water flowmeters:

The wells are located:

Water Right No. 5642: One well near the center of the West half of the West half of Section 17, Township 22 South, Range 3 West, Harvey County; and

Water Right No. 33142: One well located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 22 South, Range 3 West, Harvey County.

The wells must be properly equipped with approved meters within 30 days after the approval of the change applications and prior to operation of the wells. If more time is needed to install the meters or modify an existing meter installation, you may request an extension of time. The request must be made to the District before the end of the 30-day period.

Enclosed are two Flow Meter Installation forms to be completed and returned to this office after completion of the meter installation or modification. A copy of the Division of Water Resources' meter installation notification form (Notice and Proof of Completion of Works) may be substituted for the District form. Upon receiving the completed forms, the District will inspect the installations.

Also enclosed is a copy of water meter and installation specifications. Water meters must meet these specifications and the list of certified water meters provided under K.A.R. 5-1-12, for District approval.
