Change Application, File No. 47,585

Matt Brack filed the referenced application to appropriate groundwater for irrigation use, requesting a quantity of 317.8 acre-feet and a limited diversion rate of 800 gallons per minute. The proposed point of diversion will be a battery of four (4) wells with a geographic center located 326 feet North and 4,754 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 27, Township 23 South, Range 5 West, Reno County within the drainage basin of Cow Creek (Not Arkansas River as shown in WRIS & application). The proposed point of diversion will overlap the geocenter of the battery proposed for File No. 47.585 by a change in point of diversion application filed by Mr. Brack. No overlaps in the authorized places of use are proposed for the referenced files. The proposed acreage is owned by Harold E. Swanson Trust, Hal E. Swanson, Kim E. Brack, Guy S. Swanson Trust, and Harold E. and Donna J. Swanson Trust No. 2. File No. 49,601 will be limited to 800 gallons per minute when combined with File Nos. 47,585.

The referenced change application is not abandoned pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-718 and the perfection period for File Nos. 47,585 expired on December 31, 2016. The same local source of supply will not change for either file. The proposed change in point of diversion involves a move of approximately 200 feet from the presently authorized geocenter.

WRIS indicates two batteries of irrigation wells authorized by Appropriation of Water, File Nos. 46,220 and 47,942 and three domestic wells within one-half mile of the proposed geocenter. The nearby well owners were notified of the referenced applications by letters dated June 8, 2016; no responses have been received as of today's date.

In letters dated February 6, 2017 with attachments, received May 18, 2017, Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2 recommended the referenced applications be approved and indicated that the applications comply with K.A.R. 5-22-1 through K.A.R. 5-22-17. File No. 49,601 was recommended contingent upon the approval of the change application for File No. 47,585; the maximum rate is limited to 800 g.p.m. when combined with File No. 47,585; and provided the water meter for File No. 49,601 is installed in a manner so it only measures the water applied to the place of use of File 49,601, and metered separately from the place of use authorized by File No. 47,585.

The total quantity available for irrigation use by File No. 49,601, 317.8 acre-feet, will irrigate the proposed 227 acres with 1.4 acre-feet per acre and is the maximum reasonable quantity allowed pursuant to K.A.R 5-3-24 in Reno County.

No test hole log was submitted with the pending new application. The source of supply was previously determined to be Equus Beds (190).

In accordance with K.S.A. 82a-706c, the Chief Engineer retains full authority to require any water user to install meters, gages, or other measuring devices, which devices he or she or his or her agents may read at any time. Water flowmeter requirements are further described in K.A.R. 5-1-4 through K.A.R. 5-1-12. If any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water pumped under this permit, a check valve will also need to be installed. A water level measurement tube is required. The applicant signed, notarized, and returned a minimum desirable streamflow form to our office.

In an August 3, 2017 e-mail, Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner, Stafford Field Office, recommended approval of the referenced applications.

Based on the above discussion, safe yield criteria are met, approval of the applications will not impair senior water rights nor prejudicially or unreasonably affect the public interest, it has been recommended that the Richelle A. Krueger referenced applications be approved.

There is enclosed a permit (File No. 49,601) to appropriate water authorizing you to proceed with construction of the proposed diversion works (except those dams and stream obstructions regulated by K.S.A. 82a-301 through 305a), to divert such unappropriated water as may be available from the source and at the location specified in the permit, and to use it for the purpose and at the location described in the permit.

Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, and limitations specified in this permit. Failure to notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources of the completion of the diversion works within the time allowed, or within any authorized extension of time thereof, will result in the dismissal of this permit. Enclosed is a form which may be used to notify the Chief Engineer that the proposed diversion works have been completed.

Acceptable water flow meters must be installed on the diversion works in such a manner that the quantity of water perfected by File No. 49,601 may be readily determined. The water flow meter must be installed in a manner so that it only measures the water applied to the place of use authorized by File No. 49,601, and is metered separately from the place of use authorized by Appropriation of Water, File No. 47,585. Please contact Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office, at (620) 234-5311 prior to construction of the diversion works to discuss how the referenced battery of wells should be metered.

All requests for extensions of time to complete diversion works, or to perfect appropriations, must be submitted to the Chief Engineer before the expiration of time originally set forth in the permit to complete diversion works or to perfect an appropriation. If for any reason, you require an extension of time, you must request it before the expiration of time set forth in this permit. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in the dismissal of your permit or your water right. Any request for an extension of time shall be accompanied by the required statutory fee, which is currently \$100.00.

There is also enclosed an information sheet setting forth the procedure to obtain a Certificate of Appropriation which will establish the extent of your water right.

In addition, enclosed is the order executed by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, approving the application for change under Appropriation of Water, File No. 47,585. A condition of this approval is that acceptable water flow meters must be installed on the diversion works authorized under the referenced file numbers. Please return the required notification of completion of the diversion works and installation of the required meter as soon as these actions are completed.

Please be reminded that reports of water usage must be submitted to this office annually. Records indicating the amount of water used should be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of the previous calendar year so that the continued use of water becomes a matter of record in this office. The owner, or his or her legally designated agent, is held responsible for submitting annual water use reports. Failure to file an accurate water use report is a violation of law which makes you subject to civil penalties.

APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION APPROPRIATION OF WATER FILE NO. 47.585

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Matt and Valerie Brack, 4001 East Avenue G, Hutchinson, Kansas, 67501-8280, Donna Swanson, Trustee, Guy S. Swanson, Trustee, and Guy S. Swanson, P.O.A., on behalf of the Harold E. Swanson Trust, Guy S. Swanson Trust, Hal E. Swanson, and Harold E. and Donna J. Swanson Trust No. 2, 5500 East Avenue G, Hutchinson, Kansas 67501, and Kim E. Brack, 4745 Southwest Fairlawn Road, Topeka, Kansas, 66610, received in this office on March 28, 2016, for approval of a change in the location of the point of diversion under Approval of Application, File No. 47,585, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the point of diversion shall be:

a battery of four (4) wells with a geographic center located in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW½ SW½ SW½) of Section 27, more particularly described as being near a point 326 feet North and 4,754 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section.

in Township 23 South, Range 5 West, Reno County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the map accompanying the application to change the point of diversion.

The point of diversion described herein as a battery of four (4) wells is further limited such that the wells shall be located within a three hundred (300) foot radius circle, in the same local source of supply and shall be limited to a maximum diversion rate not in excess of four hundred (400) gallons per minute (0.89 c.f.s.) per well.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2018, or within any authorized extension of time. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

All wells with a diversion rate of 100 gallons per minute or more drilled under the authority of this order shall have a tube or other device installed in a manner acceptable to, and in accordance with specifications adopted by, the Chief Engineer. This tube or device shall be suitable for making water level measurements and shall be maintained in a condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall submit to the Chief Engineer a copy of the well log required by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment under the authority of K.S.A. 82a-1212, currently form WWC-5, within 30 days following the drilling of the well at the location authorized herein.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Approval of Application, File No. 47,585, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the approval dated December 20, 2010.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 – 6777.

Jeff, WRIS needs fixed, there is NO overlap in place of use between the new app and the senior file no. 47585. The new application was revised to show no overlap in place of use. See attached very rough map, the circles aren't perfect, just meant to show you what is going on!

The p/d change on 47585 going from the currently authorized battery of 2 wells to a battery of 4 wells looks ok for approval.

The new application covering the same battery of 4 wells and providing an additional quantity of 317.8 AF on the proposed acreage in the N% of the section is reasonable at 1.4 AF/acre. This will be limited to no more than 800gpm at any time.

Spacing is met in all cases, nearbys were notified and no comments were provided.

Nearby hydrographs shown below indicate a stable water level in the general area.

The Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2 made a recommendation to the Division of Water Resources that change in point of diversion application No. 47585 be approved. Pursuant to K.A.R. 5-22-4a, the well battery described in the application must be equipped with a District approved water flowmeter: The well battery geocenter is located in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 27, Township 23 South, Range 5 West, Reno County.

The battery must be properly equipped with an approved meter within 30 days after the approved battery is operational and prior to its operation. If more time is needed to install the meter or modify an existing meter installation, you may request an extension of time. The request must be made to the District before the end of the 30-day period. 



Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.




