Kelly & Christy Hrencher, owners of File No. 48,303 have filed an application for approval to change the place of use and a new application to appropriate water for beneficial use, File No. 49,867 for irrigation use. The applications were received on July 5, 2017. Along with the applications, a voluntary dismissal for Water Right, File No. 46,018 was received.

Change Application File No. 48,303

The referenced file number do not appear to be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

File No. 48,303 is currently authorized 148.4 acre-feet, 51.4 acre-feet additional, of groundwater to be diverted at a maximum rate of 800 gallons per minute from one well located in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼ NE¼ NW¼) of Section 13, more particularly described as being near a point 5,329 feet North and 3,744 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 32 South, Range 11 West, Barber County, Kansas. Note: the location of the point of diversion has been gps during a field investigation conducted in 2014. This order will modify the point of diversion to better reflect that actual location. This file was limited to 148.4 acre-feet when combined with Water Right, File No. 46,018. With the dismissal of File No. 46,018, the limitation will be removed.

The place of use is currently 106 acres in the Southwest Quarter (SW¼) of Section 12. This application for change in place of use proposes to add 54 acres located in the Southwest Quarter (SW¼) of Section 12 bring the total to 160 acres. This will create an overlap in place of use with New Application, File No. 49,867. The additional acres will be covered by the quantity appropriated under File No. 49,867 thus there is no increase in consumptive use with the proposed change in place of use.

The applicant identified zero nearby wells not owned by the applicant located within one-half mile of this existing well. No nearby well owner letters referencing the change in place of use were sent out.

Based on the above discussion, the change is reasonable, the application complies with consumptive use criteria, approval of the application will not impair senior water rights nor prejudicially or unreasonably affect the public interest. It is recommended that the referenced change application be approved to create a complete overlap with New Application, File No. 49,867.

New Application, File No. 49,867

The filed new application is proposing to appropriate 224 acre-feet of groundwater at a diversion rate of 800 gallons per minute for irrigation use in the Sandy Creek Basin. The applicant proposes to withdraw from an existing battery of wells with a geographic center located in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW¼ SE¼ SW¼) of Section 12, more particularly described as being near a point 1,166 feet North and 3,822 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 32 South, Range 11 West, Barber County, Kansas. This is an overlap in point of diversion with Water Right, File No. 46,018 that is due to be dismissed with the approval of this new appropriation. The quantity will be limited to 224 acre-feet when combined with Appropriation of Water, File No. 48,303.

The proposed place of use is 160 acres located in the Southwest Quarter (SW¼) of Section 12, in Township 32 South, Range 11 West, Barber County, Kansas. This will create an overlap in place of use with Appropriation of Water, File No. 48,303. The proposed quantity of 224 acre-feet per calendar year limited when combined with the appropriated quantity under File No. 48,303 provides 1.4 acre-feet per acre, making it within the reasonable quantity for Barber County (1.4).

Based off well information that was submitted with the pending application that is the same used for the senior file, the source of supply for the well appears to be alluvium. The point of diversion is located within the South-Central Kansas Designated unit area – SAN 46 boundary which is currently open to new appropriations. Per the requirements in K.A.R. 5-3-11, safe yield is determined by the extent of the unconfined aquifer within a two-mile radius of the point of diversion, which establishes the area of consideration. Evaluation of the area of consideration included the extent of the unconfined aquifer and keeping consistent with the boundaries set in senior appropriation File No. 48,303, which provided an area of consideration of 6,240 acres. With a potential annual recharge of 1.8 inches, and 50% of recharge available for appropriation, safe yield was determined to be 468 acre-feet. Existing water rights have appropriated 268.4 acre-feet, providing a difference of 199.6 acre-feet available for appropriation, and the application requesting an additional quantity of 75.6 acre-feet complies with safe yield.

According to the WRIS database, the nearest non-domestic point of diversion (File No. 48,303) is located 1,346 feet away. The applicant identified one (1) nearby domestic well not owned by the applicant located within one-half mile of this existing well. There does not appear to be any domestic well within 660 feet. Nearby well owner letter were sent out on July 18, 2017, referencing the proposed change application and new application. The domestic owner called in with questions regarding the applications but never formally submitted a letter in opposition of the appropriations. Per K.A.R. 5-4-4 for all other aquifers, the application complies with minimum well spacing criteria to all existing wells.

In accordance with K.S.A. 82a-706c, the Chief Engineer retains full authority to require any water user to install meters, gages, or other measuring devices, which devices he or she or his or her agents may read at any time. Water flowmeter requirements are further described in K.A.R. 5-1-4 through K.A.R. 5-1-12. If any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water pumped under this permit, a check valve will also need to be installed.

In an August 3, 2017, e-mail, Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner, Stafford Field Office, recommended approval of the application.

Based on the above discussion, the area is open to new appropriations, the application complies with safe yield and well spacing criteria, approval of the application will not impair senior water rights nor prejudicially or unreasonably affect the public interest. It is recommended that the referenced new application be approved and create a place of use overlap with Appropriation of Water, File No. 48,303 and Water Right File No. 46,018 be dismissed.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Kelly & Christy Hrencher, 3906 SE US Highway 160, Medicine Lodge, Kansas 67104-8086, received in the office of the Chief Engineer on July 5, 2017, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the Approval of Application and Permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

This order effectively removes the additional limitation on the quantity of water that it not exceed 148.4 acre-feet per calendar year when combined with Water Right, File No. 46,018 at the place of use authorized herein.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year

In all other respects, the Approval of Application, File No. 48,303, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Approval of Application and Permit to Proceed dated October 22, 2013.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 – 6777.



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Any use of water that is not as authorized by the water right or permit to authorize water <u>before</u> the chief engineer approves this application is a violation of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act for which criminal or civil penalties may be assessed. Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). In addition to these penalties the water right may be modified or suspended. K.S.A. 82a-737, as amended.



As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.
