John DeWerff, on behalf of Ell-Bar Farm Inc., and Vernon and Marian DeWerff, on behalf of Vernon W. and Marian K. DeWerff Revocable Trusts, have filed an application for approval to change the authorized place of use.

It appears that the water right is not abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

The referenced file number, located in the Rattlesnake Creek subbasin, is authorized 117 acre-feet of groundwater for irrigation of 80 acres in the Northwest Quarter (NW¼) of Section 29, Township 22 South, Range 14 West, Stafford County. There are no overlaps in the point of diversion or current/proposed place of use. The water right owner proposes to increase the place of use from 80 acres to 130 acres in accordance with K.A.R. 5-5-11(b)(3); **Necessity to install a more efficient irrigation system; limited quantity.** 

- Big Bend Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 5 will assume monitoring responsibility.
- The applicants propose to increase the place of use they can irrigate in one calendar year from 80 acres to 130 acres in the Northwest Quarter (NW¼) of the aforementioned section. Base acres appear to be 80 acres, so the applicants have proposed a net increase of 50 acres above the "base acres".
- There has been no recent pattern of water use significantly in excess of the maximum annual quantity authorized, although the water right owners did violate a previous 5-year allocation and were suspended for two years.
- Limitations: The authorized quantity of water under the referenced water right will be limited to a **five-year fixed allocation of 484.7 acre-feet**:
  - 1.03'(50% N.I.R. Stafford County)/.85 x 80 base acres x 5 years= 484.7 acre-feet.
- Use of water in excess of the five-year allocation shall result in a two-year suspension of all water use under the referenced right and subsequent restriction of the authorized place of use to the base acreage at the location specifically set forth in the change approval.

The location of the authorized point of diversion will be better described with g.p.s. feet distances.

In a letter dated July 13, 2018, Orrin Feril, Manager of Big Bend Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 5 indicated that the Board of Directors voted not to enter a monitoring agreement and recommended denial of the application. The water right owners appealed the decision, and in a letter dated September 5, 2018, Orrin indicated that the Board now recommends approval of the application.

The same local source of supply will not change which has been previously determined to be Undifferentiated Kansan/Nebraskan (180).

Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office, indicated in an e-mail dated August 10, 2018 that he recommends approval of the application and further recommends the requirement of an anti-reverse totalizing water flowmeter and the requirement of a seal on the water flowmeter to the pipe. A check valve is required.

Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended that the referenced application be approved.

Dear Mr. DeWerff:

Enclosed is the order executed by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, approving the application for change under the above referenced file number.

Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, and limitations specified in this approval for change. A condition of this approval is that an acceptable water flow meter must be installed on the diversion works authorized under the referenced file number. Prior to the diversion of water for irrigation purposes, you must install an anti-reverse totalizing water flowmeter which meets or exceeds specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer. In addition, a seal shall be placed on the water flowmeter by the Division of Water Resources in such a manner as to render the meter non-removable from the measuring chamber without breaking the seal. Please return the required notification of completion of the diversion works and/or installation of the required meter as soon as these actions are completed. Please contact Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office, at (620) 234-5311 prior to construction of the diversion works to discuss how the well should be metered.

Approval of the application for File No. 14,442 does not allow the diversion of water in excess of the authorized quantity per calendar year or rate of diversion. Your attention should be drawn to the fact that the authorized quantity of water under File No. 14,442 is limited to a fixed allocation, 484.7 acre-feet during a period of five (5) years in this case, and further limited to the annual authorized quantity of 117 acre-feet any given year, provided that the five (5)-year fixed allocation is not exceeded. Non-compliance with the terms of this approval will result in substantial penalties.

Since the order for the referenced file number modifies the original document referred to above it should be recorded with the Register of Deeds as other instruments affecting real estate.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of John DeWerff, on behalf of Ell-Bar Farm, Incorporated, 941 Southeast 50 Road, Ellinwood, Kansas 67526, and Vernon and Marian DeWerff, on behalf of Vernon W. and Marian K. DeWerff Revocable Trusts, 527 Southeast 100 Avenue, Ellinwood, Kansas 67526-9222, received in this office on February 23, 2018, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Findings and Order of the Chief Engineer dated April 23, 1996, more accurately describing the location of the authorized point of diversion, by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated June 16, 1997, approving the application to change the place of use, and by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated July 10, 1997, approving the application to change the point of diversion, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the place of use shall be:

one(1) well located near the center of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼) of Section 29, more particularly described as being near a point 3,980 feet North and 3,981 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 22 South, Range 14 West, Stafford County, Kansas.

By this order, this water right is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the quantity of water authorized under Water Right, File No. 14,442 shall not exceed 484.7 acre-feet per five (5)-year period; the first period being calendar years 2018 through 2022, ad infinitum.
- 2. That the quantity of water authorized under Water Right, File No. 14,442 shall not exceed 117 acrefeet per calendar year, provided that 484.7 acre-feet per five (5)-year period is not exceeded.

3. That use of water in excess of 484.7 acre-feet per five (5)-year period shall result in a two (2)-year suspension of all water use under this water right, effective the next two (2) calendar years, and a subsequent restriction of the authorized place of use to the following described property:

4. That if Big Bend Groundwater Management District No. 5 and/or the Division of Water Resources terminate(s) their/its Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) pertaining to K.A.R. 5-5-11(b)(3), (4) and (5), by which the District assumes monitoring responsibility, then the place of use authorized by this change approval, which was issued by the Division pursuant to the MOU shall revert to the property described in paragraph no. 3, above, starting the calendar year following the year of termination.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

The owner of the Water Right(s) identified in this order shall install an anti-reverse totalizing water flowmeter which meets or exceeds specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer.

A seal shall be placed on the water flowmeter by the Division of Water Resources in such a manner as to render the meter non-removable from the measuring chamber without breaking the seal. If the seal is broken without the written permission of the chief engineer, this shall create a rebuttable presumption that the point of diversion had been unlawfully operated in violation of the order of the chief engineer and that the water right holder had been acting in violation of the conditions of his or her water right. If any such violation occurs, a written order shall be issued by the chief engineer stating the nature of the violation and the civil penalty, suspension of water right or modification to the water right, or any combination of these to be imposed.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 14,442, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated January 3, 1983, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

#### RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 - 6777.

The Big Bend Groundwater Management District #5 has reviewed the above referenced application to change the place of use under Water Right File No. 14,442. Currently the authorized place of use for this file is 80 acres in the NW quarter of 29-22S-14W in Stafford County. Through the application of K.A.R. 5-5-11, the applicant is requesting to allow the center pivot system to complete the circle and irrigate 122 acres. For this to be possible, the District must agree to monitor the place of use through a monitoring agreement.

The application was presented to the Board of Directors at the July regular board meeting for review. The Board reviewed the history of the water right file including the previous monitoring agreements, water use history, and irrigated acreage history. Based upon information received in the District office and the discussion at the board meeting, the Board voted to not enter into a monitoring agreement and to recommend denial of this application. This recommendation was sent to your office on July 13, 2018.

The applicant requested an appeal of this decision at the August regular board meeting. The applicant discussed the issues regarding this center pivot system and the history of the water right file with the Board. Based upon this discussion, the Board voted to recommend approval of this application provided the applicant enter into a monitoring agreement with the District. The District received the required monitoring agreement on August 31, 2018. Therefore, the application for change in place of use is recommended for approval. A copy of the monitoring agreement is included with this recommendation for your records. This recommendation supersedes the previous recommendation submitted on July 13, 2018.

The application to change is subject to the District's well equipment regulation K.A.R. 5-25-5 for a required flow meter.

At the start of 2004 the Nelson p100 end gun and booster pump were removed and the system was re-nozzled for 650gpm and the drops were lowered to be 4ft off the ground.

System is currently running with midwest energy on time and temp so it doesn't run in the heat of the day in order to minimize water evaporation and use our available water to the best of our ability.

Our crops are planted at a higher dryland rate (currently 24,000 for corn) in order to more effectively manage the water allotment.

In 2010 and 2011 we served a two year penalty for being out of compliance in our five year plan, giving up 200 acre foot in those two years for over-pumping 20 acre feet.

State compliance would be to water 88 approved acres with a windshield wipe style pivot with a water allowance of 117 acre foot per year. My proposal is to water 122 acres with a full-circle pivot with a water allowance of 480 acre foot in 5 years, no more than 117 acre foot in a single year which averages out to 96 acre foot per year. My proposal would result in a savings of 21 acre foot of water every year opposed to what would put me in compliance. I have been communicating with Jeff Lanterman with the state and he is in favor of this proposition because it would be conserving more water.

If this board would vote in favor of putting me in a monitoring agreement I would be diligent about adhering to any guidelines given to me in such arrangement.

Reference is made to the Application for Approval of the Chief Engineer to Change the Authorized Place of Use under the referenced file number which was received in this office on February 23, 2018. Please note that K.A.R. 5-5-11(b) of K.A.R. 5-5-11 *Applications for change in place of use for irrigation purposes*, states in part that an application to change the authorized place of use for irrigation purposes which would permit the applicant to exceed the base acreage by 10 acres or 10 percent, whichever is less, shall not be approved by the chief engineer because it would result in a substantial increase in net consumptive use in violation of K.A.R. 5-5-3 except when one of six listed criteria are met. In Paragraph No. 3 of the submitted application you requested to process your application subject to one of the six listed criteria, specifically a five-year allocation of water in accordance with K.A.R. 5-5-11(b)(3) *Necessity to install a more efficient irrigation system; limited quantity*. Please note that K.A.R. 5-5-11(b)(3) states in part:

- (A) The groundwater management district in which the point of diversion is located shall agree to assume monitoring responsibility to ensure compliance with the conditions of the change approval;
- (B) the applicant shall submit information demonstrating to the satisfaction of the chief engineer that it is necessary to increase the base acreage so that a significantly more efficient irrigation delivery system may be installed;
- (C) the applicant shall submit a feasible operation plan demonstrating to the satisfaction of the chief engineer that the amount of water available for appropriation under that water right is reasonable to irrigate the number of acres requested to be irrigated; and
- (D) the water right owner shall have no recent pattern of water use significantly in excess of the maximum annual quantity of water authorized.

The Board of Directors of Big Bend Groundwater Management District No. 5 voted not to enter into a monitoring agreement and recommended denial of the application. Therefore, it will be recommended to the Chief Engineer that the Application for Approval to Change the Place of Use under Water Right, File No. 14,442 be denied and dismissed due to failure to meet the criteria of K.A.R. 5-5-11(b)(3) which requires in part a signed monitoring agreement with GMD 5.

This does help. I do have more questions after digging in deeper into this file.

- 1) What are the proposed acres for this application? It has 130 acres as the proposed acres, but 122 is written in just below it. This is also true in the legal description of the field to be irrigated on DWR 1-100.4.
- 2) So according to our records, this place of use was authorized for 10 years under two separate monitoring agreements with the District. Following non-compliance with the second agreement, KDA–DWR issues a two-year suspension and reversion of acres. Since that time, the producer has been irrigating those illegal acres from 2011-2017. What makes us think the applicant would comply with the terms of a new agreement, let alone an enforcement from KDA–DWR on the reversion acreage?

I'll take this to the board for their review, but I'm not inclined to enter into another agreement. Our next board meeting will be June 14. We'll need an extension of time until then to make our recommendation.

An application for approval of the Chief Engineer to change the following condition or conditions of the file number referred to above has been received:

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor... A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.




