Jerry Kuckelman, President and CEO, on behalf of ILS Land Inc., owner of the above referenced water right, filed an application for approval to change the place of use and use made of water for Water Right, File No. 18,924, located in the Rattlesnake Creek Drainage Basin.

The referenced file number does not appear abandoned pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-718.

File No. 18,924 has no overlaps in the authorized point of diversion or place of use and is authorized 189 acre-feet of groundwater from one well for irrigation of 144 acres all located in the Southwest Quarter (SW¼) of Section 9, Township 24 South, Range 14 West, Stafford County. Paragraph No. 17 of the application requests a dual use of water that will allow them to retain the original 189 acre-feet for irrigation but will limit the total annual use to 159.516 acre-feet in any year when water is used for stockwatering during the duration of the dual use stockwater/irrigation dual use permit. Should the stockwatering use ever cease, the applicant will request to revert back to irrigation for the full original quantity of 189 acrefeet. The temporary reduced quantity is based on K.A.R. 5-5-9/5-5-10 calculations. In addition, the irrigation place of use will be changed from 144 acres to the 133 acres actually covered by the center pivot. The applicant indicated in Paragraph No. 13 their nutrient management plan utilizes the return water of the feedlot back to irrigation. The stockwatering place of use will be the Northwest Quarter (NW¼) of Section 9 of the aforementioned township and range, creating a complete overlap in place of use with Water Right, File No. 18,356.01.

All non-domestic and domestic well owners identified on the map by the applicant or in WRIS were notified of the proposed changes by letters dated July 3, 2018 to comply with K.S.A. 82a 1906; no responses have been received as of today's date.

The local source of supply will not change, which appears to be undifferentiated Kansan/Nebraskan (180).

In a letter dated July 31, 2018, Orrin Feril, Manager of Big Bend Groundwater Management District No. 5 recommended approval of the application.

In an e-mail dated August 2, 2018, Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office, indicated that he is not opposed to approval of the application.

A water flow meter is required. A check valve is required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Jerry Kuckelman, President and CEO, ILS Land LLC, PO Box 1506, Great Bend, Kansas 67530-1506, as owner of the referenced water right, received in this office on May 31, 2018, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use and the use made of water, under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and are hereby approved.

The authorized quantity of water under this right will remain 189 acre-feet (61.59 million gallons). This order effectively limits the authorized quantity of water to 159.516 acre-feet (51.98 million gallons) per calendar year for both stockwatering and irrigation uses combined. That the limitation on the quantity of water shall exist until such a time that the quantity of water for stockwatering use authorized by this approval is no longer required.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the portion retained for irrigation use shall be authorized a maximum quantity not to exceed 159.516 acre-feet (51.98 million gallons) of groundwater per calendar year, for irrigation use on the following described property:

The water right owner shall properly install a separate acceptable water meter for each use made of water for the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted for irrigation and stockwatering use may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 18,924, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated January 11, 1984.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Therefore, the application appears to be consistent with 5-25-20(b) and is recommended for approval.

The application to change is subject to the District's well equipment regulation K.A.R. 5-25-5 for a required flow meter.

Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.
