File Nos. 4,537D1, 4,537D2, 4,894 and 29,958

Raymond and Susan Flickner owners of the above referenced water rights have filed applications for approval to change the place of use under the above referenced water rights. The applications propose to add additional acres to the existing places of use and to also create a complete overlap in the authorized places of use between the four water rights.

The referenced files do not appear to be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

The changes in place of use under propose to increase the authorized acres to a total of 483 acres from the currently authorized 426.39 acres of land. Water Right, File Nos. 4,537 D1 and 29,958 are currently authorized a total of 230 acres and are currently in 5 year allocations that total 1,006 acre-feet of water in a 5 year period. Water Right File No. 4,894 is currently authorized a total of 156.39 acres and is currently in a 5 year allocation to 529.5 acre-feet in a 5 year period. Both of these 5 year allocations will start over for the period beginning in 2018 through 2022. While Water Right, File No. 4,537 D2 is not currently in a 5 year allocation, it is proposed that it be place in one based upon the following calculation:

50% NIR McPherson County (10.8 inches / 0.85 efficiency / 12 inches x 81 base acres x 5 years = 428.8 acre-feet. Since the water right is only authorized 52 acres-feet, the allocation is equal to 5 times authorized or 260 acre-feet

In compliance with KAR 5-5-11(b)(3)(A), GMD No. 2 has agreed to monitor the project and has submitted a monitoring agreement between the GMD and Mr. Flickner.

In an letter dated, December 7, 2017, a letter and a copy of the applications were submitted to the Equus Beds GMD No. 2 along with a request to make a recommendation. In a letter date January 30, 2018, Tim Boese, Manager, GMD No. 2, recommended that the applications for change in place of use be approved.

In an email dated todays date, Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner, Stafford Field Office, recommended that the applications be approved.

A check valve will be required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, that no change in the local source of supply will occur and that the new application will account for any increase in the consumptive use, it is recommended that the referenced application be approved.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Raymond and Susan Flickner, 2701 N North Shore Circle, Wichita Kansas 67205-1079, received in this office on November 27, 2017, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, by the order of the Chief Engineer dated May 9, 2000, approving the application to change the location of the place of use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

This order effectively removes the additional conditions which established the five (5)-year allocation as set forth by the Approval of Application for Change in Place of Use, Water Right, File No. 29,958, dated May 9, 2000.

- 1. That the quantity of water authorized under Water Right, File No. 29,958, when combined with Water Right, File No. 4,537 D1, shall not exceed 1,006 acre-feet per five (5)-year period; the first period being calendar years 2018 through 2022, ad infinitum.
- 2. That the quantity of water authorized under Water Right, File No. 29,958 shall not exceed 165 acre-feet per calendar year, provided that 1,006 acre-feet per five (5)-year period is not exceeded.
- 3. That use of water in excess of 1,006 acre-feet per five (5)-year period shall result in a two (2)-year suspension of all water use under this water right, effective the next two (2) calendar years, and a subsequent restriction of the authorized place of use to the following described property:

That if Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2 and/or the Division of Water Resources terminate their/its Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) pertaining to K.A.R. 5-5-11(b)(3), (4) and (5), by which the District assumes monitoring responsibility, then the place of use authorized by this change approval, which was issued by the Division pursuant to the MOU shall revert to the property described in paragraph no. 3, above, starting the calendar year following the year of termination.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

### RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Brent – I am finishing up our review of the referenced change in place of applications and had some questions concerning the 5 year allocation.

The overall 5 year allocation for all the water rights would be 1964.1 AF based on a combined base acres total of 371 acres. The change applications also specify individual 5 year allocations for each file as follows:

4894: 529.5 AF 4537D1: 525 AF 4537D2: 260 AF 29958: 825 AF

The 5 year allocation for 4894 appears to be based on 100 base acres  $\times 0.9' / 0.85 \times 5 = 529.5 \text{ AF}$ 

The other 5 year allocation are all based on the authorized quantity X 5.

Why is there a difference in the way the 5 year allocation is determined? Also, perhaps it does not matter and the rights will only be subject to overall 5 year allocation of 1964.1AF?

4.1 Services will be performed during normal business hours of the Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2, which are from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday, exclusive of District holidays.

### 5 **SERVICE PERFORMED**

    - 5.6.1.5 name of inspector,
    - 5.6.1.6 model and serial number,
    - 5.6.1.7 units of measure for rate and totalizer, and
    - 5.6.1.8 multiplication factor.
  - 5.6.2 Point of Diversion
    - 5.6.2.1 legal description and coordinates of the point of diversion,
    - 5.6.2.2 operational status of the point of diversion, and
    - 5.6.2.3 total discharge flow metered.
  - 5.6.3 Place of Use
    - 5.6.3.1 irrigated acres legal description,

#### 6 **CUSTOMER RESPONSIBILITY**

- 6.1 The Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2 will have ingress and egress to the point of diversion, water flow meter and place of use as reasonably necessary to the carry out this service agreement and the customer agrees not to restrict such ingress and egress.

The Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2 reviewed the referenced change in place of use applications on January 30, 2018, using the District's Revised Management Program (effective May 1, 1995) and Rules and Regulations K.A.R. 5-22-1 through 5-22-17.

The change applications propose to modify the place of use and create an identical place of use overlap totaling 483 acres between the referenced water rights pursuant to K.A.R. 5-5-11(b)(3), subject to five year allocation(s). The proposed place of use results in a combined water to land ratio of 0.89 acre-feet per acre.

Additionally, pursuant to K.A.R. 5-5-11(b)(3)(A), the groundwater management district in which the points of diversion are located, must agree to assume monitoring responsibility to ensure compliance with the change approvals conditions.

Subject to the condition specified below, the change applications will comply with the District's Revised Management Program and Rules and Regulations K.A.R. 5-22-1 through 5-22-17.

Based on the review, the change applications are recommended for approval, subject to the Division of Water Resources determining the 5 year allocation(s) quantity(s). Additionally, the District agrees to assume monitoring responsibilities to ensure compliance with the change approval conditions through either a formal Memorandum of Understanding with the Division of Water Resources and/or the applicant obtaining a service contract with the Equus Beds Groundwater Management to conduct an annual inspection(s) of the place of use being irrigated and review the annual water use.

A District decision may be appealed to the District Board of Directors by submitting a written petition to the District office within 30 days from date of this notification, pursuant to K.A.R. 5-22-12. From 2014 on, the water user reported part of the meter readings on the Industrial water use report and the remainder of the meter readings on the irrigation report. Prior to that, the full metered quantity was reported on the Irrigation and the Industrial report with a value subtracted out for the other use with no indication of where the other use quantity came from

The meter readings on the 2016 Industrial report do not match up properly with the irrigation reports. The IND readings were reported as beginning at 95,894,100 gal and ending at 7,005,600 gallons for a metered Q of 11,111,500 gallons. The quantity reported above 'corrected' and is based on the gap between the 2015 and 2016 irrigation report meter readings.

Brent – I am finishing up our review of the referenced change in place of applications and had some questions concerning the 5 year allocation.

The overall 5 year allocation for all the water rights would be 1964.1 AF based on a combined base acres total of 371 acres. The change applications also specify individual 5 year allocations for each file as follows:

4894: 529.5 AF

4537D1: 525 AF

4537D2: 260 AF 29958: 825 AF

The 5 year allocation for 4894 appears to be based on 100 base acres  $\times 0.9' / 0.85 \times 5 = 529.5 \text{ AF}$ 

The other 5 year allocation are all based on the authorized quantity X 5.

Why is there a difference in the way the 5 year allocation is determined? Also, perhaps it does not matter and the rights will only be subject to overall 5 year allocation of 1964.1AF?

#### Okay,

With the help of Jeff, Matt, and Lexi I think I have been able to understand more on this. I have included a new WCA summary report, the original letter from the Flickners, as well as a map that the Stafford office generated to hopefully explain clearly.

The letter was a bit confusing because they stated they wanted NIR, then stated they wanted 560 AF/YR (with a 5-year allocation), then specified specific quantities per water rights (which flexibilities they wanted to include overpumping and dual use). I attempted to capture all this in a summary report so please look at each section individually rather than a whole picture.

With the help of the Stafford office, we were able to get confirmation on the term-permits filed in the past. So Lexi was able to update our historical use spreadsheet to reflect those changes and give credit for year pumping above authority. Then she determined the NIR, BASED ON THE PENDING CHANGE APPS, with the exception of WR #29958 IND. As well, we went ahead and used the historical period of 2001-2016 for all water rights regardless of when SDI was installed but the first SDI's were installed in 2001.

To highlight some things:

Flickner's letter proposed a total of 560 AF/Year for all WR's; with a 5-year allocation of 2,800 AF.

Average Historical Use (2001-2016)= 433.941 AF/Year.....more than used in 2014, 2015, or 2016.

NIR for all IRR WR's + #29958 IND Auth Qty (35 AF) 744.200 AF/ Year.

NIR for all IRR WR's + #29958 IND Ave Use (27.997 AF)= 737.197 AF/Year.

Specified WR's Qty's listed/requested + ave use of WR's not listed= 631.982 AF/Year.

This is all on the report sheet as well but wanted to point those things out.

I'd be happy to explain over a conference call if need. Lane, Mike, or Jeff can you please set this up? If there are any specific questions, please let me know.




