ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, that effective the date of this order, the Application for Approval to Change the Point of Diversion Under an Existing Water Right, received in the Office of the Chief Engineer on October 20, 2017, under Water Right, File No. 32,154, shall be dismissed and its priority forfeited.

Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). 

The Request to Reduce removes the Wempen property that is mostly in the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Section. The request has been signed by Ron Dietzel, one of the trustees. The two other trustees will sign and submit duplicates.

I am also attaching a check in the amount of \$400.00, a Notice, two Quit Claim Deeds, and a Journal Entry of Dismissal of the lawsuit mentioned in the Notice. I am also enclosing an illustration outlining the property that includes the portion of the place of use for File 13,560 that is to be removed.

The Trustees have no plans to irrigate this property and are in the process of selling its interest in the NW/4 of Section 34.

You and Jeff Lanterman have said that DWR's policy and practice permits splitting single point of diversion into multiple points of diversion after wells from two or more water rights have been consolidated so long as the number of total wells never exceeds the number of original wells. A future owner may want to take advantage of this approach.

We have previously explained the issues in the lawsuit mentioned in the Notice. *See* my letter to Lane Letourneau dated August 20, 2015. If you need additional information about the claims made, the resolution, or any other information, please let me know.

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor... A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.
