Pat Bedwell, Chairman of the Board, on behalf of Rural Water District No. 3, Barber County, Kansas, filed an application for approval to change the authorized points of diversion for the referenced file number located in the Medicine Lodge River Basin. Douglas S. Helmke, P.G., Kansas Rural Water Association, assisted the District in filing the referenced application. Ned Marks, P.G., Terrane Resources Company also submitted information on behalf of the District.

The referenced water right does not appear abandoned.

The referenced file number was certified on May 22th, 2018 for a blanket quantity and diversion rate of 10.25 million gallons (31.45 acre-feet) per calendar year and 50 gallons per minute from two wells located in Section 3, Township 30 South, Range 14 West, Barber County, for municipal use within the boundaries of Rural Water District No. 3, Barber County, Kansas, and the immediate vicinity, and within the boundaries of Rural Water District No. 1, Barber County, Kansas, and the immediate vicinity. Paragraph No. 3 of the application indicates that the well casings are severely deteriorated and the new well locations have better aquifer properties. The District proposes to redrill both wells, moving the westernmost well a distance of approximately 1,595 feet to the northeast to a point 1,641 feet North and 3,285 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 3, and the easternmost well a distance of approximately 1,584 feet to the northwest to a point 1,641 feet North and 3,185 feet West of the Southeast corner of the same section.

The authorized wells are approximately 662 feet apart and it is proposed they will be approximately 100 feet apart at their new locations. The application map and WRIS indicate there are no other nondomestic wells within one-half mile of the proposed wells. The only domestic well shown on the map within one-half mile of the proposed wells is located approximately 250 feet from the proposed location of the well to be located 1,641'N, 3,185'W of the Southeast corner of Section 3. However, the domestic well owner signed a domestic well spacing consent form giving permission to install a municipal use water well at a location approximately 250 feet from the domestic well if allowed by the Chief Engineer.

The same local source of supply will not change, which appears to be (180) undifferentiated Kansan/Nebraskan.

After reviewing additional well logs and information submitted by Ned Marks, Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office, indicated that he has no objection to the approval of the referenced application.

Water flow meters and check valves will be required.

APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION WATER RIGHT FILE NO. 32,612

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Pat Bedwell, Chairman, on behalf of Rural Water District No. 3, Barber County, Kansas, 14873 Northwest River Road, Lake City, Kansas, 67071-9006, received in this office on November 20, 2017, for approval of a change in the location of the point of diversion under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized locations of the points of diversion shall be:

one(1) well located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE½ NE½ SW½) of Section 3, more particularly described as being near a point 1,641 feet North and 3,185 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, and

one(1) well located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE½ NE½ SW½) of Section 3, more particularly described as being near a point 1,641 feet North and 3,285 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section,

both in Township 30 South, Range 14 West, Barber County, Kansas, at a diversion rate not in excess of 50 gallons per minute (0.11 c.f.s.) and a quantity not to exceed 10.25 million gallons (31.45 acre-feet) of water per calendar year,

located substantially as shown on the map accompanying the application to change the point of diversion.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2018, or within any authorized extension of time. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

All wells with a diversion rate of 100 gallons per minute or more drilled under the authority of this order shall have a tube or other device installed in a manner acceptable to, and in accordance with specifications adopted by, the Chief Engineer. This tube or device shall be suitable for making water level measurements and shall be maintained in a condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall submit to the Chief Engineer a copy of the well logs required by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment under the authority of K.S.A. 82a-1212, currently form WWC-5, within 30 days following the drilling of the wells at the locations authorized herein.

The water right owner shall properly install acceptable water meters on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meters has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meters in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meters and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 32,612, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated May 22, 2018.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Jeff, we have reviewed this and discussed this with Brent. Ned supplied some additional information on behalf of the RWD. The nearby domestic well log appears to be an oilfield supply well or stock well and is located about 250' from the nearest proposed well (the domestic owner has supplied a consent agreement to move closer than 660'). My opinion is that oilfield and stock use is likely a temporary or seasonal use. I think it was good this domestic is not a house well.

Based on the observation that this is a temporary/seasonal use domestic well and the fact that the two available logs show ~28.5' to 36' of saturated thickness, it seems unlikely impairment will occur as they wells are only authorized to pump 50 gpm. In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. 




