Troy Nelson and Aurelia Denise Nelson, on behalf of Nelson Circles, Inc., owner of the above referenced water rights, filed an application for approval to change the place of use, point of diversion and use made of water for Water Right, File No. 14,672, authorized irrigation use and applications for change in place of use for Water Right, File Nos. 28,265.01 and 36.628.01, authorized stockwatering use.

The referenced file numbers do not appear abandoned pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-718.

File No. 14,672 has no overlaps and is authorized 224 acre-feet at a diversion rate of 825 gallons per minute (all additional no limitations) for irrigation use on 160 acres located in the Northwest Quarter (NW¼) of Section 28, Township 26 South, Range 17 West, Edwards County, Kansas. The water right owner proposes to convert 24.186 acre-feet (7.881 million gallons) of water from irrigation use to stockwatering use pursuant to K.A.R. 5-5-10 Partial changes in the use made of water from irrigation to another type of beneficial use. After application of the K.A.R. 5-5-10 regulation a total of 195 acre-feet of water will remain authorized by File No. 14,672 on the presently authorized well. Irrigation acres will be reduced to 139.3 acres. Edwards Co. 50% NIR with 85% efficiency is 1.27 acre-feet per acre, so the 195 acre-feet to be authorized for irrigation by File No. 14,672 will irrigate the proposed 139.3 acres with 1.40 acre-feet per acre which appears reasonable.

The water right owner also proposes to unstack the 24.186 acre-feet (7.881 million gallons) and 50 gallons per minute to be authorized for stockwatering use under File No. 14,672 pursuant to K.A.R. 5-5-16 *Additional wells*, moving the authorized quantity and rate to an existing stockwatering well authorized by Water Right, File Nos. 28,265.01 and 36,628.01. The proposed existing well, located 1,327 feet North and 3,957 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 21 in the same township and range, involves a distance move of approximately 1,560 feet. A May 3, 2018 pump test conducted by Big Bend Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 5 staff indicated that the aquifer can pump a maximum of 832.74 gallons per minute (no rate reduction), so the requested 50 gallons per minute for the stockwatering well and the 775 gallons per minute to remain authorized for irrigation use appears reasonable.

The only wells within one-half mile of the proposed existing stockwatering well is the irrigation well to remain authorized by File No. 14,672, an irrigation well authorized by Water Right, File No. 22,806 and three domestic wells (under common ownership). The nearby irrigation well owner within one-half mile of the proposed existing stockwatering well was notified of the above referenced point of diversion and use made of water change and the proposed place of use changes by a letter dated May 15, 2018; no responses have been received as of today's date.

The stockwatering place of use proposed for File No. 14,672 and for Water Right, File Nos. 28,265.01 and 36.628.01 will be the West Half of the Southwest Quarter (W½ SW¼) of Section 21 and the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼ NW¼) of Section 28. The total quantity to be authorized for stockwatering use, 16.027 m.g.y. (49.186 acre-feet), compiles with K.A.R. 5-3-22 based on the 2,500 to 5,000 head of cattle described in Paragraph No. 13 of the application.

The local source of supply will not change, previously determined to be Meade/Grand Island Formation (144)/undifferentiated Kansan/Nebraskan(180).

Approval of the application for File No. 14,672 will be subject to the condition that for the sole purpose of administering wells concerning direct impairment, the additional well shall be considered to have the priority of the date the application was filed (January 8, 2018) to add the additional well.

In letters dated June 22, 2018 Orrin Feril, Manager of Big Bend Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 5, indicated that the Board of Directors of GMD No. 5 recommended approval of the applications.

In an e-mail dated July 10, 2018, Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office, indicated no objection to approval of the applications if the meter for the irrigation well has anti-reversing gears and is sealed to the pipe.

Water flow meters are required. Check valves are required if chemigating.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the same local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended that the referenced applications be approved.

Dear Sir or Madam:

Enclosed are the orders executed by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, approving the applications for change under the above referenced file numbers.

Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, and limitations specified in these approvals for change. A condition of these approvals is that acceptable water flow meters must be installed on the diversion works authorized under the referenced file numbers. Please return the required notification of completion of the diversion works and/or installation of the required meters as soon as these actions are completed.

Please note the change approval for File No. 14,672 requires the installation of an anti-reverse totalizing water flowmeter which meets or exceeds specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer. Seals will be placed on the water flowmeters by the Division of Water Resources in such a manner as to render the meters non-removable from the measuring chambers without breaking the seals. If the seals are broken without the written permission of the Chief Engineer, it shall constitute a violation of the orders of the Chief Engineer. Please contact Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office, at (620) 234-5311 prior to construction of the diversion works to discuss how the wells should be metered.

Please note that the application to change the point of diversion for File No. 14,672 is approved subject to the condition that for the sole purpose of administering wells concerning direct impairment, the additional well shall be considered to have the priority of the date the application was filed (January 8, 2018) to add the additional well. In addition, the Chief Engineer specifically retains jurisdiction in this matter with authority to review the approval of the additional well at intervals of no fewer than five years, and no more than ten years to determine if the total annual quantity of water actually being withdrawn by all wells authorized by the approval of application for change is exceeding the total annual quantity of water that could have been physically withdrawn if the additional well had not been approved, and based on the review, the Chief Engineer retains authority to make a reasonable reduction in the authorized quantity of water as may be deemed to be in the public interest.

Since these orders modify the original documents referred to above, they should be recorded with the Register of Deeds as other instruments affecting real estate.

APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND ORDER BETTER DESCRIBING THE LOCATION OF THE AUTHORIZED POINT OF DIVERSION WATER RIGHT FILE NO. 36,628.01

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Troy Nelson and Aurelia Denise Nelson, on behalf of Nelson Circles, Incorporated, 1566 210th Avenue, Lewis, Kansas, 67552, received in this office on January 8, 2018, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated August 2, 2000, approving the application to change the use made of water, and by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated October 20, 2004, approving the application to change the point of diversion and place of use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the place of use shall be:

the West Half of the Southwest Quarter (W½ SW¼) of Section 21 and the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼ NW¼) of Section 28, all in Township 26 South, Range 17 West, Edwards County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the place of use, and the location of the authorized point of diversion is more accurately described as:

one(1) well located near the center of the Southwest Quarter of (SW $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 21, more particularly described as being near a point 1,327 feet North and 3,957 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 26 South, Range 17 West, Edwards County, Kansas.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 36,628.01, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated January 18, 2000, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 - 6777.

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Any use of water that is not as authorized by the water right or permit to authorize water <u>before</u> the chief engineer approves this application is a violation of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act for which criminal or civil penalties may be assessed. Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). Civil penalties shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 per violation. In the case of a continuing violation, each day such violation continues may be deemed a separate violation. In addition to these penalties the water right may be modified or suspended. K.S.A. 82a-737, as amended.

The application must be signed by all owners of the place of use authorized under the water right and his or her spouse, if married. Please indicate if there is no spouse. If land is being purchased under contract, the seller must sign as landowner until such time as the contract is completed.

Upon review of the applications, we find that additional information is needed.

The application for File No. 14,672 proposes to convert a portion of the water right from irrigation use to stockwatering use, unstack 24.186 acre-feet and 50 gallons per minute from the authorized irrigation well and transfer it northward to the stockwatering well authorized by Water Right, File Nos. 28,265.01 and 36,628.01. K.A.R. 5-5-16 Additional Well regulation applies and requires in part a reasonable value for the maximum rate of diversion based on either an acceptable current water flow rate test conducted on the presently authorized point of diversion or a value based on a valid hydraulic analysis submitted by the applicant showing the current capacity of the aquifer to yield water at the currently authorized point of diversion.

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.
