Rubennil 15, c/o David Lennebur, has filed the above referenced application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, proposing the appropriation of 97 acre-feet of groundwater from two (2) existing wells, for industrial use in Sedgwick County. The application was originally filed indicating one well but after talking to the applicant, two existing wells were confirmed to be operating.

The quantity of water was justified as follows using 2 gallons per minute per tons of pumps for heating and cooling purposes:

2 GPM x 60 Minutes x 24 Hours per day x 365 Days per year x 30 tons per minute = 31.54 million gallons (97 acre-feet).

The source of water for the pending application was determined to be Lower Arkansas River Alluvial Aquifer, based on area wells logs and Kansas Geological Survey.

The area of the proposed point of diversion is open to new appropriations, subject to safe yield. The specific method for calculating safe yield for unconfined groundwater aquifers is described in K.A.R. 5-3-11. The safe yield area of consideration is the entire two-mile circle, 8,042 acres using 5.4 inches of potential annual recharge and 75% recharge available for appropriation. The safe yield was calculated to be 2,714.18 acre-feet with total prior appropriation of 1,270.71 acre-feet leaving 1,443.63 acre-feet available for appropriation. Therefore, the application meets safe yield.

The application is subject to well spacing, as required by K.A.R. 5-4-4 and does not meet well spacing to domestic wells according to K.A.R. 5-4-4. The applicant supplied a map the application is to cover existing wells that have been operating with no issues and no comments were received from nearby well owners. David Engelhaupt, Engineering Associate in Water Management ran a Theis analysis showing a maximum drawdown of 3.01 feet after 50 years of pumping, therefore no significant impact to nearby wells. Because these wells have been in operation for so long with no known issues, no comments were received from nearby well owners, and the Theis analysis showing no significant drawdown, well spacing is not an issue for this application.

All well owners within one-half (½) mile of the proposed point of diversion were notified of the application, by Public Notice in the Wichita Eagle on February 10th, 17th, and 24th, 2018, and provided 15 days to submit any comments or concerns related to the proposed appropriation. No comments have been received. Well owners within 1,000 feet were also notified by letter dated March 30, 2018. No comments have been received.

In an email message June 20, 2018, Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office recommended approval of the application.

Based on the above discussion and the available information, and that K.A.R. 5-25-2 is waived, it is recommended that the referenced application be approved.

for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, together with the maps, plans and other submitted data, and that the application is hereby approved and the applicant is hereby authorized, subject to vested rights and prior appropriations, to proceed with the construction of the proposed diversion works (except those dams and stream obstructions regulated by K.S.A. 82a-301 through 305a, as amended), and to proceed with all steps necessary for the application of the water to the approved and proposed beneficial use and otherwise perfect the proposed appropriation subject to the following terms, conditions and limitations:

- 1. That the priority date assigned to such application is **April 17, 2017**.
- 2. That the water sought to be appropriated shall be used for industrial use in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 27 South, Range 1 West, Sedgwick County, Kansas.
- 3. That the authorized source from which the appropriation shall be made is groundwater to be withdrawn by means of a battery of two (2) wells with a geographic center located in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼ SW¼ NW¼) of Section 22, more particularly described as being near a point 3,340 feet North and 5,080 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 27 South, Range 1 West, Sedgwick County, Kansas located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application.
- 4. That the appropriation sought shall be limited to a maximum diversion rate not in excess of 75 gallons per minute (0.167 c.f.s.) and to a quantity not to exceed 31.608 million gallons (97 acrefeet) of water for any calendar year.
- 5. That installation of works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before **December 31**, **2019** or within any authorized extension thereof. The applicant shall notify the Chief Engineer and pay the statutorily required field inspection fee of \$400.00 when construction of the works has been completed. Failure to timely submit the notice and the fee will result in revocation of the permit. Any request for an extension of time shall be submitted prior to the expiration of the deadline and shall be accompanied by the required statutory fee of \$100.00.
- 6. That the proposed appropriation shall be perfected by the actual application of water to the proposed beneficial use on or before <u>December 31, 2023</u> or any authorized extension thereof. Any request for an extension of time shall be submitted prior to the expiration of the deadline and shall be accompanied by the required statutory fee of \$100.00.

7. That the applicant shall not be deemed to have acquired a water appropriation for a quantity in excess of the amount approved herein nor in excess of the amount found by the Chief Engineer to have been actually used for the approved purpose during one calendar year subsequent to approval of the application and within the time specified for perfection or any authorized extension thereof.

- 8. That the use of water herein authorized shall not be made so as to impair any use under existing water rights nor prejudicially and unreasonably affect the public interest.
- 9. That the right of the appropriator shall relate to a specific quantity of water and such right must allow for a reasonable raising or lowering of the static water level and for the reasonable increase or decrease of the streamflow at the appropriator's point of diversion.
- 10. That this permit does not constitute authority under K.S.A. 82a-301 through 305a to construct any dam or other obstruction; nor does it grant any right-of-way, or authorize entry upon or injury to, public or private property.
- 11. That all diversion works constructed under the authority of this permit into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic quick-closing, check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.
- 12. That an acceptable water flow meter shall be installed and maintained on the diversion works authorized by this permit in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. This water flow meter shall be used to provide an accurate quantity of water diverted as required for the annual water use report (including the meter reading at the beginning and end of the report year).
- 13. That the applicant shall maintain accurate and complete records from which the quantity of water diverted during each calendar year may be readily determined and the applicant shall file an annual water use report with the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year. Failure to file the annual water use report by the due date shall cause the applicant to be subject to a civil penalty.
- 14. That no water user shall engage in nor allow the waste of any water diverted under the authority of this permit.
- 15. That failure without cause to comply with provisions of the permit and its terms, conditions and limitations will result in the forfeiture of the priority date, revocation of the permit and dismissal of the application.
- 16. That the right to appropriate water under authority of this permit is subject to any minimum desirable streamflow requirements identified and established pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-703c for the source of supply to which this water right applies.

Additional Information to Industrial Use Supplemental Sheet

This business was purchased on 10 April, 2015. An application for a storm water discharge permit was made and approved on 22 March 2017, effective 1 April 2017. City of Wichita issued approved discharge into the storm water system on 24 March in accordance with the permit. A permit to appropriate water is required to proceed.

The yellow cells indicate best estimate for water requirements: 31.54 Mgal/per year or 96.78 acre-feet. HVAC experts estimate 1-3 gal/min per ton of AC for cooling requirements. Spring Clean at 416 N Ridge Road operates with a total of 30 tons of heat pumps for heating/cooling. Yearly requirements for different gal/min per ton are shown in the table. In each scenario, 30 tons are in operation continuously for the estimate. Though 30 tons in operation continuously is not expected, water requirements will vary and normally increase for such things as different manufacturers heat pump model requirements, increased water temperature of the water (for cooling), or decreased water temperature (for heating), etc. Therefore, 30 tons in operation continuously serves to account for other factors to provide a yearly estimate.

Jeff, this is an existing thermal exchange, pump and dump into the City of Wichita storm water system (the business applied for a permit from Wichita to pump to the storm drainage and apparently were informed would also need a water right).

This is in the city so there are a bunch of potential domestic wells around. There was a public notice (no comments received) and we also notified wells within 1000' (no comments received).

The wells were drilled in 2009 and have apparently been in operation since that time for this use. The applicant has provided good justification that they could need 97AF for this use on the high end.

Please note the their analysis from David E that has been included. His analysis states, "The maximum drawdown after 50 years of pumping cycles is 3.01 feet or 6.69% of the estimated saturated depth of the domestic well (Table 2)."

I understand that we have a "battery of wells". Two to be exact.

I'm not sure I can check the feet accurately, but I'll take a look. But, on the picture you have the correct corners of the building where the two wells are located. To be more accurate though, both wells are located on the outside of the building in those piece-of-pie shaped green spots you can see if you zoom in.

Send us the public hearing requirements and one of us will get that working with as little delay as possible. From our conversation I understand that the public notice must run about three weeks followed by 15 days to respond. If everything is OK with that then we schedule an inspection (cost =\$400). If everything goes well then we could have a permit to appropriate water in about two months.

As we discussed on the phone, here is a map with the added point of diversion at your facility. I've plotted the wells in the NE and the SW corners of the building. Our office operates by using a geographic center for a battery of wells which is the case for this application.

A battery of wells is defined as two or more wells connected to a common pump by a manifold; or not more than four wells in the same local source of supply within a 300 foot radius circle which are being operated by pumps not to exceed a total maximum diversion rate of 800 gallons per minute and which supply water to a common distribution system.

Please reply to this email confirming that those well locations are accurate.

The NE well is located at 3365 N and 5010 W The SW well is located at 3320 N and 5155 W The Geo-Center is located 3340 N and 5080 W

All feet differences are from the SE corner of section 22-27S-1W.

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. Once review of your application has begun, we will contact you, if additional information is required.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water as proposed prior to approval of the application is unlawful. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, ... it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor . . .

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.
