<u>MEMORANDUM</u>

Appropriation of Water, File Nos. 35,809 & 35,810;

Lou Leone, City Administrator, for the City of Kiowa as owner of the referenced municipal rights filed applications on November 9, 2017, for approval to change the place of use to add the Barber County Rural Water District No. 2, (Barber RWD 02). The project is to update the existing practice of an emergency connection to the District and the place of use authorized under the vested right.

The referenced rights appear not be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718, and in compliance with K.S.A. 82a-732. The appropriations will not perfect until the 2022. The nearby wells were several and the area within the City has monitoring wells so a notice was published in the *Kiowa News* the week of March 7, 2018. Letters were also sent to KGS identified well owners within one-half mile of the authorized points of diversion. Several calls were received from the letters and one from the public notice, but no objections to the proposed change in place of use was received.

The referenced files currently served the City of Kiowa, the City of Hazelton and the transmission pipeline between these cities and the two wells under the appropriations located in Section 28, Township 32, Range 10 West, Barber County. Due to historical carbon-tetrachloride contamination the Vested Right only has the City of Kiowa listed as a place of use, but the definition of a municipal right is its common distribution system and the two wells under the vested right appear to be part of the common distribution system.

The approvals will not impact the need or permitted total quantity of 140.0 **million gallons per year (429.8 AF)** under the referenced files as the supply is for emergency use, and the other places of use have been previously authorized. The City of Hazelton is served by its own right, File No. 17,507 and Barber RWD 02 is authorized under File Nos. 24,844 & 32,612. All of the place of use that will be authorized by the referenced files is located within the boundaries of the rural water district.

As the City of Kiowa has water available for perfection, the changes should not significantly increase the historical consumptive use and comply with K.A.R. 5-5-3, *Change in consumptive use*. Additionally, the historical quantity pumped and the projected use would indicate that the 2017 submitted conservation plan is current.

As the use is municipal use the incomplete overlap between the two cities and pipeline is allowed by K.A.R. 5-3-5n, Authorized place of use. It appears that the proposed changes that will serve the place of use currently authorized by the City of Hazelton, who has their own right, under File No. 17,507. The WRIS database currently shows File Nos. 35,809 & 35,810, under the authorized place of use for the City of Hazelton, but the rights are the City of Kiowa, so this will be updated, to show only the City of Hazelton as owner of File No. 17,507.

Will not violate K.S.A. 82a-735 as the changes are in accordance with the Kansas Water Appropriation Act as required by the statute.

A review of File No. BA 004 found the standby designation for the authorized wells. It appears to have been done to maintain the points of diversion from abandonment due to the contamination. The order will remove the standby designation. This order also placed the feet distances of the remaining wells in WRIS, but not on the 2001 order.

The location of the wells under the referenced files have been determined by GPS. One of the two wells authorized by the vest right will move from Section 36 to 35, but the feet distances indicate this well may have always been in Section 35. All of the updated locations are less than 300 feet from the authorized locations with the exception of the old vested right showing the well in Section 11 to be 306 feet from authorized. The updates all appear to comply with K.A.R.5-5-6, Failure to construct diversion works at authorized location. No physical movement of the wells will occur.

Jeff Lanterman, Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office has recommended approval of the proposed changes as indicated in his email dated April 25, 2018.

Water flowmeters meeting the specifications of the Chief Engineer will continued to be required under each of the referenced files. Check valves will also be required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, will not result in an increase in use beyond what has historically been justified, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the referenced applications be approved.

APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE AUTHORIZED POINTS OF DIVERSION VESTED RIGHT FILE NO. BA 004

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Lou Leone, City Administrator for the City of Kiowa, PO Box 228, Kiowa, Kansas 67070-0228, received in this office on November 9, 2017, for approval of a change in the location of the authorized place of use under the vested right order, determining and establishing a vested right to continue the beneficial use of water, then identified in the office of the Chief Engineer as Vested Right, Code 624, Barber County, now identified as Vested Right, File No. BA 004, as modified and amended by the Correction Order of the Chief Engineer dated January 29, 1962, correcting the authorized points of diversion, and by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated, June 3, 1977, approving the application to change the location of the points of diversion, and by the Findings and Order of the Chief Engineer dated June 13, 2001, in the matter of the authorized points of diversion and by the Correction Order of the Chief Engineer dated August 13, 2001, correcting the authorized points of diversion, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized place of use shall be:

the City of Kiowa & immediate vicinity; the City of Hazelton & immediate vicinity; within the boundaries of the area served by Barber County Rural Water District Number 2, and the immediate vicinity of the transmission pipeline located in Sections 27, 28, 33 & 34 of Township 32 South, Range 10 West, and in Sections 3, 4, 9, 10, 15, 16, 21, 22, 27, 28, 33 & 34, of Township 33 South, Range 10 West, and in Sections 3, 4, 9, 10, 17, 20, 21, 29, 30 & 31, of Township 34 South, Range 10 West, and in Sections 36, of Township 34 South, Range 11 West, and in Sections 1 & 2, of Township 35 South, Range 11 West, all in Barber County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the place of use.

That information in the office of the Chief Engineer finds that the points of diversion should no longer be designated with a standby condition and would be more accurately defined as being:

one(1) primary well located in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW¼ NW¼ SW¼) of Section 11, more particularly described as being near a point 1,393 feet North and 4,916 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 35 South, and

one(1) primary well located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE¼ NE¼ SE¼) of Section 35, more particularly described as being near a point 1,427 feet North and 22 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 34 South,

both in Range 11 West, Barber County, Kansas.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

In all other respects, the vested right order, determining and establishing a vested right to continue the beneficial use of water, identified in the office of the Chief Engineer as Vested Right, File No. BA 004, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the vested right order executed by the Chief Engineer on January 10, 1955, remains as authorized, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.





I went ahead an found the information I believe to be the Fenton well. It appears the 2002 well was drilled to 45 feet with a static water level encountered at 16.8 feet. The well was constructed to capture water in the 35-45 foot range. It isn't a deep well, but does have approximately 28 feet of water in the hole.

KSA 82a-711a which limits the source of supply, quantity and rate which does allow for a reasonable raising or lowering of the static water level.

While the applications for change in place of use would indicate the Fentons would not have a problem with their well, if they experience problems with their well and believe it is due to nearby wells, they should notify our field office located in Stafford. Jeff Lanterman is your area water commissioner.

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



An application for approval of the Chief Engineer to change the following condition or conditions of the file number referred to above has been received:

> PU place of use point of diversion use made of water

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor... A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.






