FINDINGS AND ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION **FILE NO. 50,120**

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

FINDINGS

- 1. That on August 29, 2018, the Chief Engineer received an application from Perry Beachy for a permit to appropriate ground water for beneficial use, assigned File No. 50,120, proposing the appropriation of 42 acre-feet of water, at a maximum requested diversion rate of 800 gallon per minute, for irrigation use. The applicant requested 60 days to locate the specific point of diversion within the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 24 South, Range 6 West, Reno County, Kansas.
- 2. That on September 10, 2018, the original application was returned to the applicant, with a cover letter requesting that additional information be submitted in order to complete the application. The applicant was provided a deadline until November 10, 2018, the time in which to provide the requested information and return the application. The applicant was informed that the application would be dismissed if it was not returned by the November 10, 2018 deadline, or within any authorized extension of time.
- 3. That the applicant requested and was provided an extension of time with the latest being January 10, 2019. A reminder letter was sent to the applicant on December 11, 2018, once again stating the January 10, 2019 date that the original application was required to be returned.
- That the original application was not returned by the January 10, 2019 deadline, nor did the 4. applicant request any extension of time in which to do so.
- 5. That the application should be dismissed and its priority forfeited as provided by K.S.A. 82a-710.
