It is proposed that the use be changed to Irrigation & Stockwater _____ purposes.
13. If changing the place of use and/or use made of water, describe how the consumptive use will not be increased.
This request proposes to convert the water right to both stockwater and irrigation use for a dual use permit. The proposed stockwater authorized quantity is based on a consumptive use conversion of 87.3% in Pawnee County per K.A.R. 5-5-9. This change will assist with the nutrient management plan that utilizes the return water of the feedlot back to irrigation and will retain the current irrigation place of use while adding the existing feed yard permitted under File No. 16977 et al. Based on all proposed changes, the total quantity for the 26,000 head yard will be 122.860 mgd (12.95 gal/head/day)

14. It is requested that the maximum annual quantity of water be reduced to see item 17 (acre-feet or million gallons).
15. It is requested that the maximum rate of diversion of water be reduced to N/A gallons per minute (--- c.f.s.).

The applicant requests that they retain the original 195 AF for irrigation use, but will limit the total annual water use to 170.235 AF in any calendar year when water is used for stockwater use during the duration of the dual use permit. Should the stockwater use ever cease, the applicant will request to revert back to irrigation for the full original quantity of 189 AF.

Any use of water that is not as authorized by the water right or permit to authorize water before the chief engineer approves this application is a violation of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act for which criminal or civil penalties may be assessed. Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). Civil penalties shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 per violation. In the case of a continuing violation, each day such violation continues may be deemed a separate violation. In addition to these penalties the water right may be modified or suspended. K.S.A. 82a-737, as amended.

The application must be signed by all owners of the place of use authorized under the water right and his or her spouse, if married. Please indicate if there is no spouse. If land is being purchased under contract, the seller must sign as landowner until such time as the contract is completed.

In the event that all applicants cannot appear before one notary public, they may as necessary sign separate copies of the application before any notary public conveniently available to them. All copies signed in this manner shall be considered to be valid parts of the application.

If the request is signed on behalf of any Owner by someone with legal authority to do so (for example, an agent, one who has power of attorney, or an executor, executrix, conservator), it will be necessary to attach proper documents showing such authority.

I declare that I am an owner of the currently authorized place of use as identified herein, or that I represent all such owners and am authorized to make this application on their behalf, and declare further that the statements contained herein are true, correct, and complete. By filing this application I authorize the chief engineer to permanently reduce the quantity of water and/or rate of diversion as specified in sections 14 and 15 of this application.

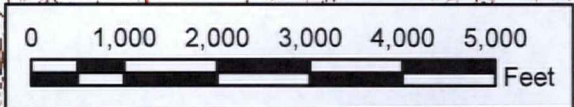
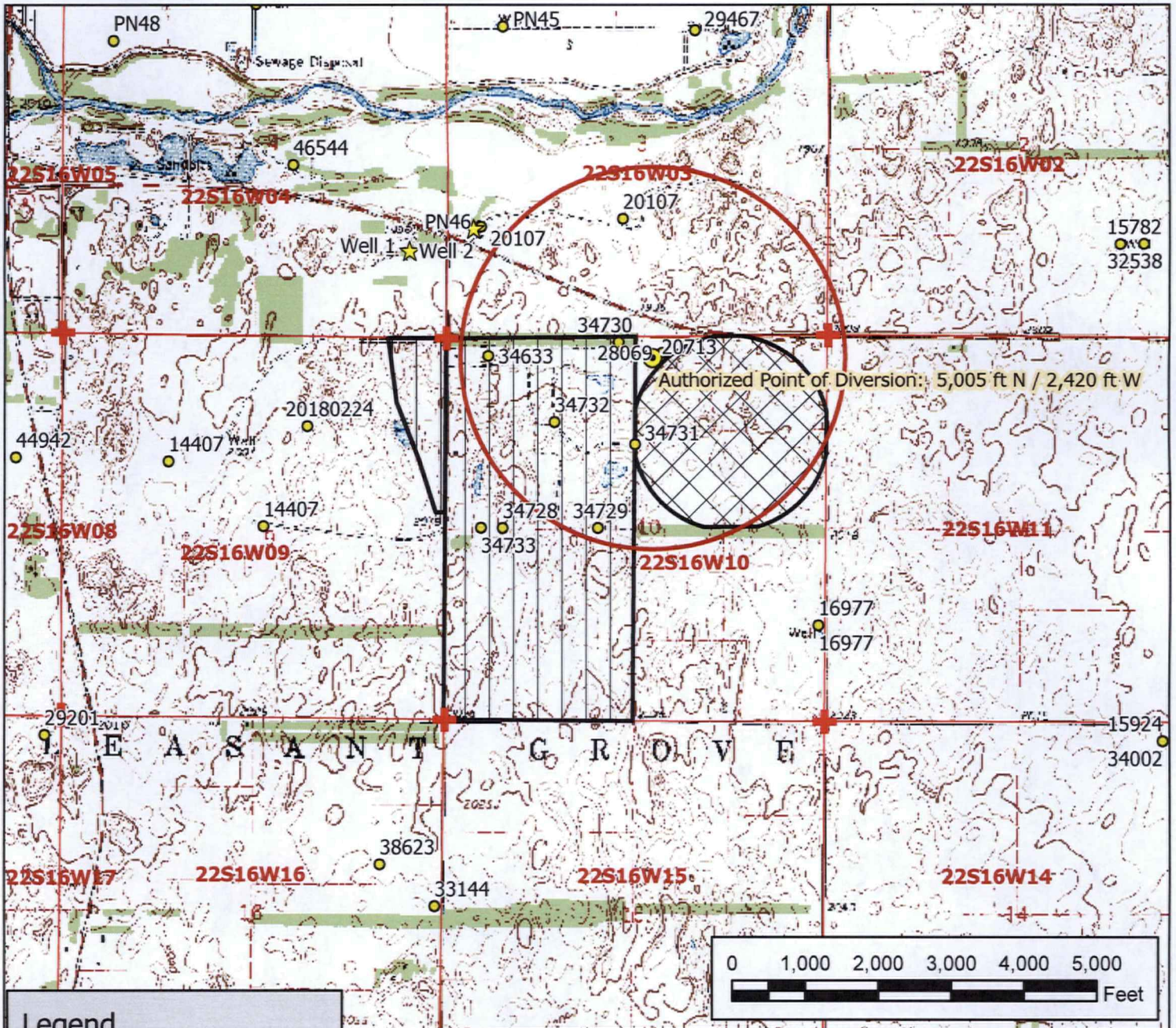

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Bronson,

Following this initial 'cover letter' email, you will receive three separate emails with attachments for the change applications we have been discussing for the water rights associated with Ward Feed Yard North. Below is a list of the file numbers and what the proposed change applications seek to accomplish.

- File No. 14407: The application for this file is a reduction request to remove the stock pens in the Northeast Quarter from the authorized place of use. There will not be an impact to the authorized rate or quantity for this file. The intent is to remove any partial overlap with the stockwater permits that are proposed to cover the stock pens. There is no fee for this application.
- 77 • File No. 20713: This change application proposes to convert this water right into a dual use permit, allowing water use for irrigation or stockwater use at the feed yard. This involves a change in place of use and use made of water with a fee of \$500.
- File Nos. 16977, 34633, 34728, 34729, 34730, 34731, 34732 & 34733: The change applications for these files propose to modify the authorized place of use to include the stock pens located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 9-22-16W. Currently, only the feed yard in Section 10 is authorized by these permits. The fee is \$200 per application for a total of \$1,600.
- File No. 24211: This change application proposes to convert most of the stockwater quantity authorized under this water right back to irrigation use. A small amount of water is being left as stockwater use at the feed yard. The change also proposes to modify the irrigation place of use to add a center pivot system in the Northeast Quarter of Section 11-22-16W. This application involves a change in place of use and use made of water with a fee of \$500.
- File Nos. 23867, 24210, 24212 & 26686: The change applications for these files propose to modify the irrigation place of use to add a center pivot system in the Northeast Quarter of Section 11-22-16W in conjunction with the changes proposed under File No. 24211. The fee is \$200 per application for a total of \$800.

Each of these application should be carefully reviewed and any necessary corrections made. A notarized signature from an authorized representative of the landowner(s) is needed on each application. In addition, the maps will need reviewed to ensure that all known wells within one-half mile of the authorized point(s) of diversion have been shown. If any wells need added to a map, the landowner and mailing address should also be provided. The map showing the nearby well locations will need to be signed.

The total fee for the noted applications is \$3,400. Please include a check made payable to the Kansas Department of Agriculture with the signed applications when they are submitted to Manhattan for processing. If I can be of any further assistance, or if you have any questions regarding the applications, please let me know.
