The proposed increase in acres is within 10% of the base acres for each water right as shown here: File 24210 base: 120 + 10 = 130 acres; File 24211 base: 240 + 10 = 250 acres; File 24212 base: 190 + 10 = 200 acres; File 23867 base: 131 + 10 = 141 acres; File 26686 base: 130 + 10 = 140 acres. Total proposed acres = 861 acres

Any use of water that is not as authorized by the water right or permit to authorize water before the chief engineer approves this application is a violation of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act for which criminal or civil penalties may be assessed. Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). Civil penalties shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 per violation. In the case of a continuing violation, each day such violation continues may be deemed a separate violation. In addition to these penalties the water right may be modified or suspended. K.S.A. 82a-737, as amended.

The application must be signed by all owners of the place of use authorized under the water right and his or her spouse, if married. Please indicate if there is no spouse. If land is being purchased under contract, the seller must sign as landowner until such time as the contract is completed.

In the event that all applicants cannot appear before one notary public, they may as necessary sign separate copies of the application before any notary public conveniently available to them. All copies signed in this manner shall be considered to be valid parts of the application.

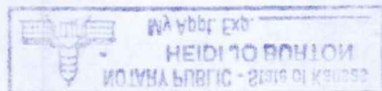

**Supplement to Application for Approval to Change the Place of Use and Use Made of Water under Water Right, File No. 24211.**

Question 13. The following process is justification to show the five-year place of use allocation/limitation is no longer needed and should be removed.

A change in use made of water was processed in 1996 under File No. 24211 to take some of the irrigation water over to stockwater purposes. The file was still in the perfection period at this time. In order to avoid a reduction in quantity to keep the consumptive use from increasing, a five-year allocation/ place of use limitation was put in place on the irrigation portion of the permit when combined with File No. 24210.

Here are some numbers for consideration:

Original Permitted Quantities

File No. 24210: 203 AF (IRR)

File No. 24211: 480 AF (IRR)

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Permitted Quantities--1996 change approval under File No. 24211

File No. 24210: 203 AF (IRR)

File No. 24211: 217 AF (IRR—Limited to 1,875 AF per 5 years with File No. 24210)

File No. 24211: 235.99 AF (STK)

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Under File No. 24211, the conversion to stockwater took the total permitted quantity from 480 AF to 449.99 AF. However, the place of use limitation added in an additional consumptive use restriction that must be considered. When broken out per year, the limitation only allowed an average of 375 AF of irrigation per year. Before the 1996 change, there were 683 AF permitted. After the change, considering the limitation as just noted, there were only 610.99 AF allowed.

This current change application proposes to convert 232.5 AF from Stock use back to Irrigation use, which would bring the irrigation quantity up to 449.5 AF (217 AF IRR + 232.5 AF = 449.5 AF). There will be 3.49 AF (1.1372 million gallons) left for Stock use at this time.

Proposed Quantities with this change application

File No. 24210: 203 AF (IRR)—no change

File No. 24211: 449.5 AF (IRR—remove limitation/allocation)

File No. 24211: 3.49 AF (STK)

Total Consumptive Use as Authorized between File No. 24210 & 24211:

$375 \text{ AF IRR} \times 0.873 = 327.375 \text{ AF}$  (using the average annual allowance under the allocation/limitation)

$235.998 \text{ AF STK} \times 1.0 = 235.998 \text{ AF}$

**Total CU: 563.373 AF**

Total Consumptive Use as Proposed between File No. 24210 & 24211:

$652.5 \text{ AF IRR} \times 0.873 = 569.633 \text{ AF}$  (File 24210 = 203 AF plus proposed File 24211 IRR = 449.5 AF)

$3.49 \text{ AF STK} \times 1.0 = 3.49 \text{ AF}$

**Total CU: 573.123 AF**

Based on this analysis, the current consumptive use under File No. 24210 and 24211 is 563.373 AF. Based on the proposed change, the consumptive use under File No. 24210 and 24211 is 573.123 AF.

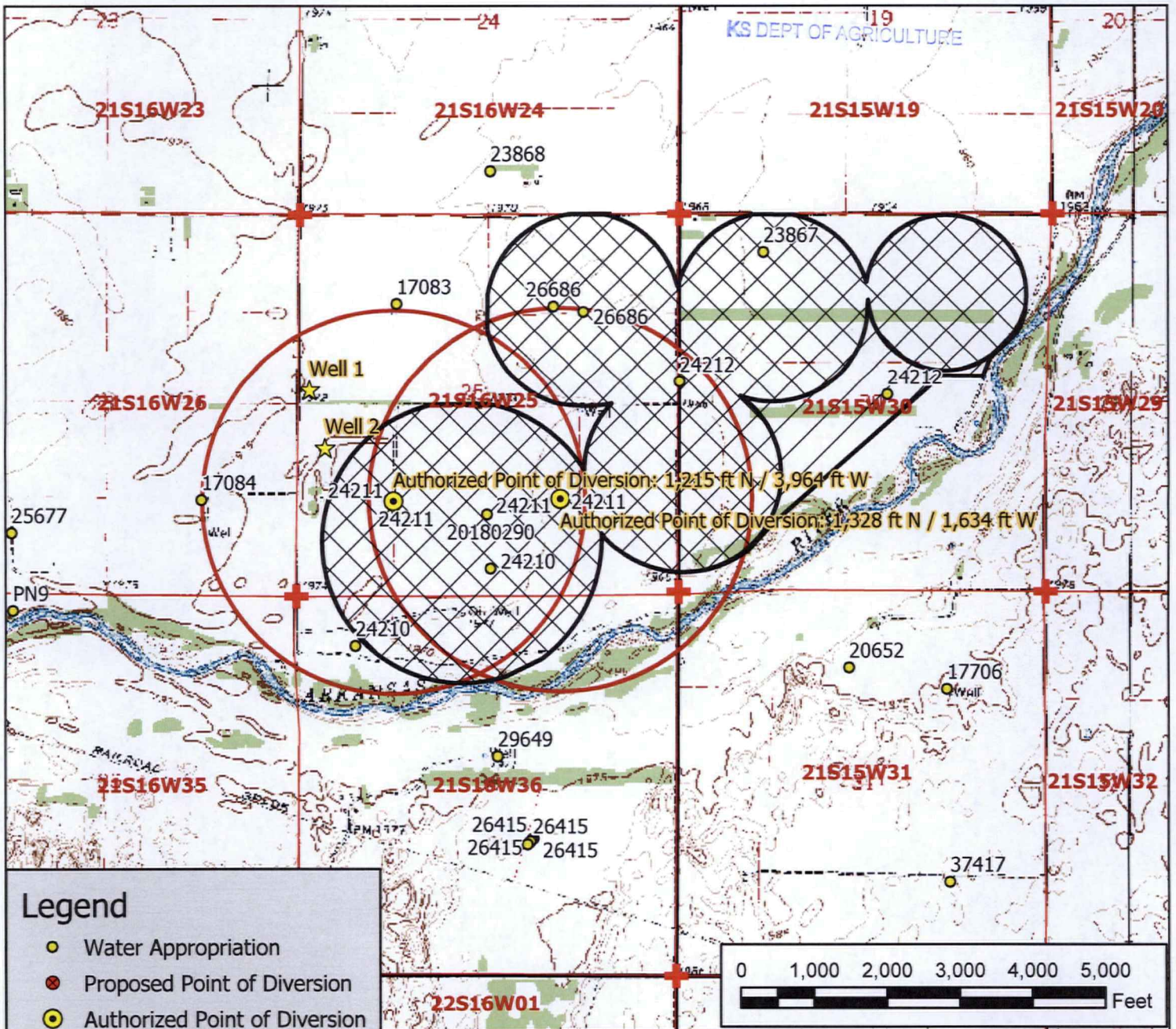

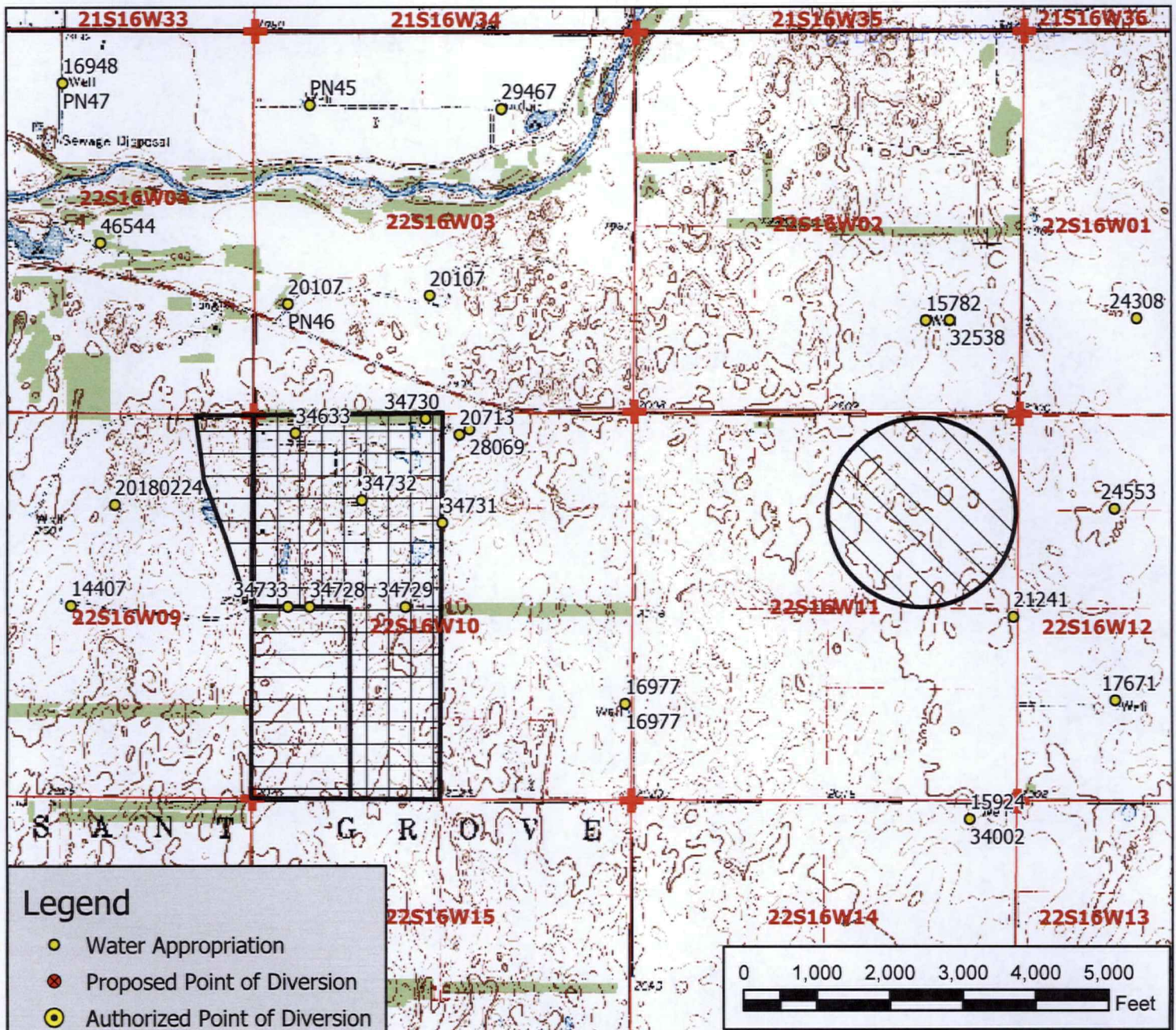

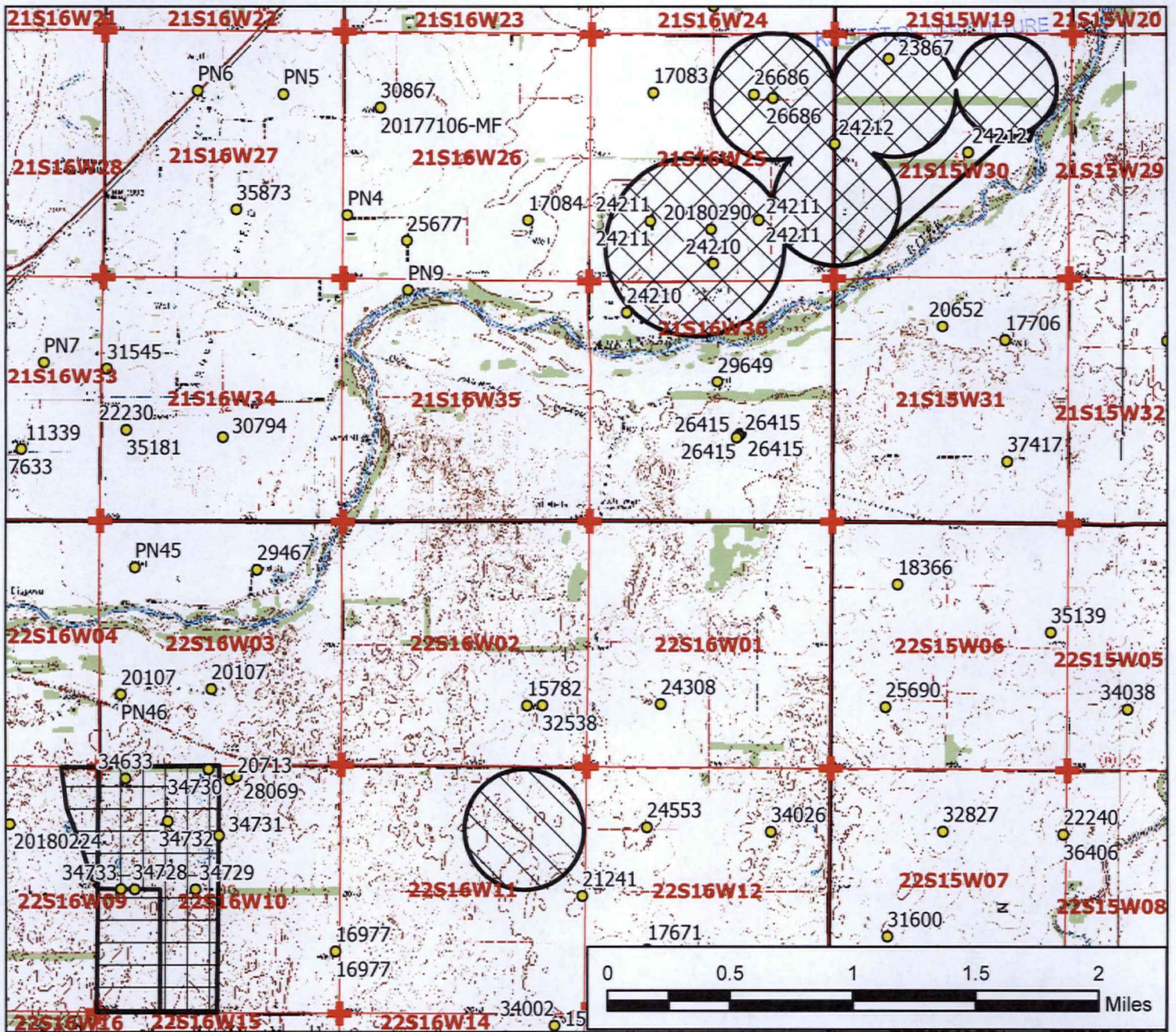

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Bronson,

Following this initial 'cover letter' email, you will receive three separate emails with attachments for the change applications we have been discussing for the water rights associated with Ward Feed Yard North. Below is a list of the file numbers and what the proposed change applications seek to accomplish.

- File No. 14407: The application for this file is a reduction request to remove the stock pens in the Northeast Quarter from the authorized place of use. There will not be an impact to the authorized rate or quantity for this file. The intent is to remove any partial overlap with the stockwater permits that are proposed to cover the stock pens. There is no fee for this application.
- 77 • File No. 20713: This change application proposes to convert this water right into a dual use permit, allowing water use for irrigation or stockwater use at the feed yard. This involves a change in place of use and use made of water with a fee of \$500.
- File Nos. 16977, 34633, 34728, 34729, 34730, 34731, 34732 & 34733: The change applications for these files propose to modify the authorized place of use to include the stock pens located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 9-22-16W. Currently, only the feed yard in Section 10 is authorized by these permits. The fee is \$200 per application for a total of \$1,600.
- File No. 24211: This change application proposes to convert most of the stockwater quantity authorized under this water right back to irrigation use. A small amount of water is being left as stockwater use at the feed yard. The change also proposes to modify the irrigation place of use to add a center pivot system in the Northeast Quarter of Section 11-22-16W. This application involves a change in place of use and use made of water with a fee of \$500.
- File Nos. 23867, 24210, 24212 & 26686: The change applications for these files propose to modify the irrigation place of use to add a center pivot system in the Northeast Quarter of Section 11-22-16W in conjunction with the changes proposed under File No. 24211. The fee is \$200 per application for a total of \$800.

Each of these application should be carefully reviewed and any necessary corrections made. A notarized signature from an authorized representative of the landowner(s) is needed on each application. In addition, the maps will need reviewed to ensure that all known wells within one-half mile of the authorized point(s) of diversion have been shown. If any wells need added to a map, the landowner and mailing address should also be provided. The map showing the nearby well locations will need to be signed.

The total fee for the noted applications is \$3,400. Please include a check made payable to the Kansas Department of Agriculture with the signed applications when they are submitted to Manhattan for processing.
