STATUTORY FILING FEE MUST ACCOMPANY THIS APPLICATION

The purpose of this application is to implement Senate Bill No. 148 relating to project permits for sand and gravel operations. This application is for **existing sand and gravel pits only, and only** if the sand and gravel pit is in a township where the average annual potential net evaporation is greater than 18 inches per year, as determined by the chief engineer. This will serve to **convert** your existing industrial use permit authorizing net evaporation to a project permit. This permit shall authorize net evaporation as the primary use, and hydraulic dredging and sand washing as secondary uses of water if such secondary uses are located within the same source of supply and are associated with the operation. Any secondary uses shall use water in a manner in which there is no significant net consumptive use. The permit shall not be subject to the installation of a water flow meter or administration of minimum desirable stream flow. Any application for a project permit shall be accompanied by a filing fee of **\$500.00**.

You must inform the Chief Engineer prior to modifying any current secondary uses, or commence new secondary uses under the authority of this project permit. Any request for modification of this project permit shall be accompanied by a fee of \$250, and must include sufficient information to adequately determine the extent of your modification.

The undersigned states that the information set forth above is true to the best of his/her knowledge, that this application is submitted in good faith, and acknowledges the voluntary dismissal of current secondary use term permits.

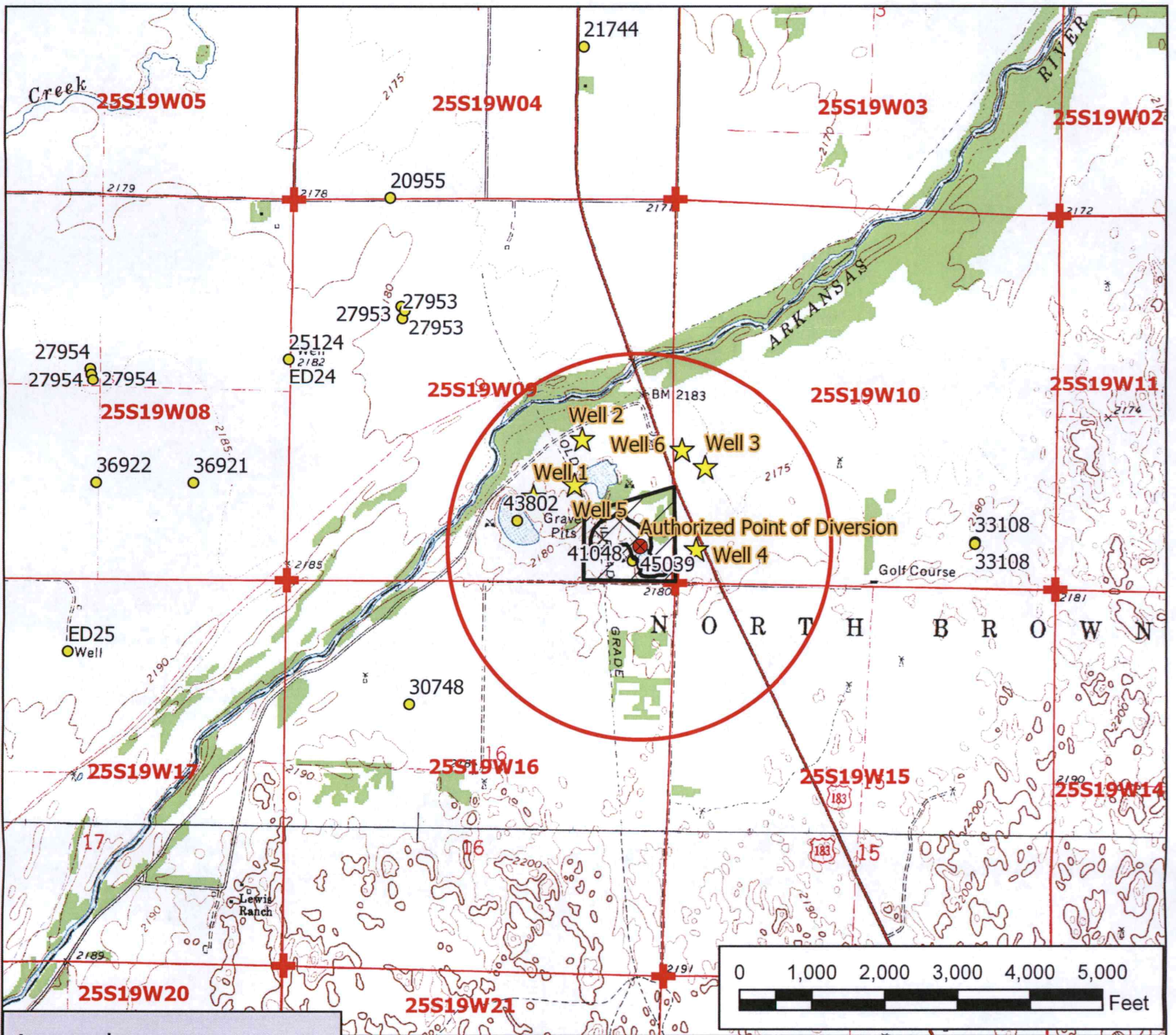

To the best of my knowledge, all wells within one-half mile of the proposed point of diversion have been shown.

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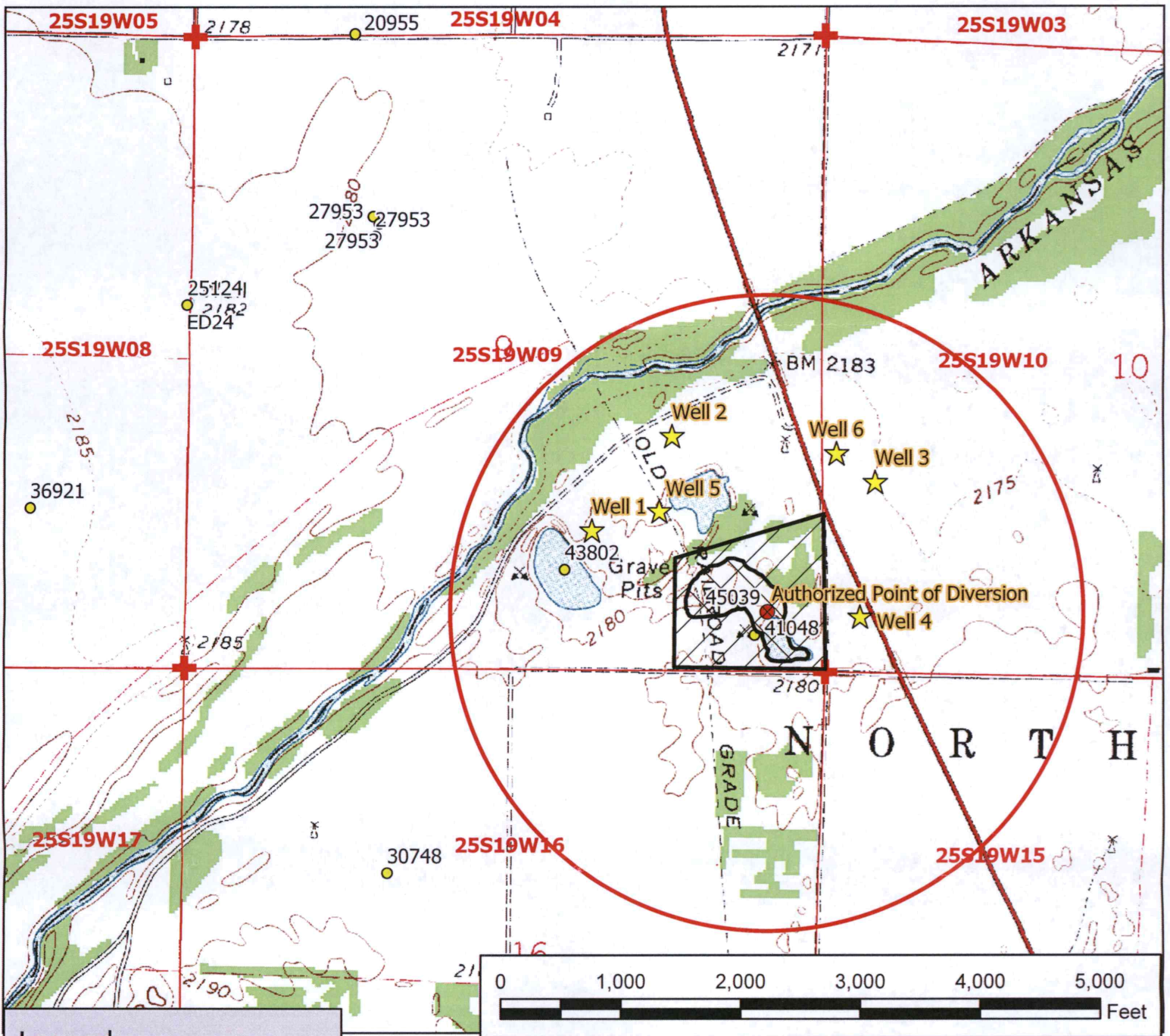
