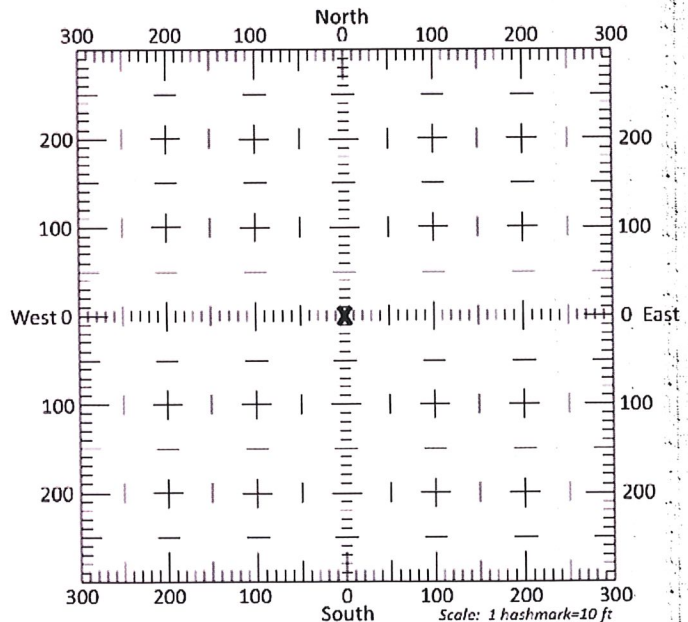

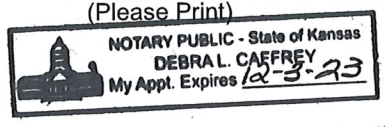

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SUMMARY ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION FOR CHANGE AND IMPOSING CONDITIONS

This Summary Order is issued under authority of K.S.A. 82a-708b, as amended, and K.A.R. 5-5-1, *et seq.* and other applicable provisions of the *Kansas Water Appropriation Law, K.S.A. 82a-701 et seq.*, and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. With the exception of those conditions expressly contained herein, this Summary Order does not change the terms, conditions and limitations of File No. 3750

1. A change application was received on February 11, 2021 requesting that the place of use and / or point of diversion authorized under the above-referenced file number be changed as described in the application.
2. On and after the effective date of this summary order, the authorized place(s) of use shall be located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the place of use. Applicable Not Applicable

Gayla S Moeckel and Howard Peacock, on behalf of themselves and the Gayla S Moeckel Trust, as owners of the referenced files authorized for irrigation use, have submitted two (2) applications for approval to change the authorized place of use. All the owners of record signed both applications.

The referenced files appear to be in compliance with 82a-732 (Annual water use report required). A review of the applications found that they comply with K.A.R. 5-5-1, *Filing an application for change*. The referenced files do not appear abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

The referenced files currently have an overlapped place of use on 132 acres authorized in the Northwest Quarter (NW¼) of Section 23, Township 24 South, Range 10 West, Reno County.

File Nos. 3750 and 34405 currently authorize the same groundwater well in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼ SE¼ NW¼) of Section 23, more specially described as 3,795 feet North and 3,594 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, Township 24 South, Range 10 West, Reno County. A compliance inspection on June 1, 2017, found the water rights to be in compliance. The authorized point of diversion will be better described based on GPS coordinates.

- **File No. 3750** authorizes 58 acre-feet (AF) at 650 gallons per minute (gpm).
- **File No. 34405** authorizes 140 AF at 840 gpm, limited to 165 AF per year at 840 gpm when combined with File No. 3750. Both files are certified.

The referenced change applications, received on February 11, 2021, propose to maintain the existing overlap under the associated water rights while modifying the acreage to allow the center pivot system to run a full 360 degrees. A portion of the proposed place of use is owned by Todd Smiley. Accompanying the change applications was an Amended Judgment on Mandate from Kansas Court of Appeals dated November 19, 2020. In this judgment, it was ordered that Gayla S Moeckel and Howard L Peacock were given a lifetime lease for the property in question "to which no water right or permits shall attach or become appurtenant to in Reno County, Kansas".

When combined, these files have a shared 120 "Base Acres," as defined by K.A.R. 5-5-11. The proposed 125 acres complies with part (b) of K.A.R. 5-5-11 and the 10 acre increase above the Base Acres is allowed by the regulation.

The proposed changes will result in a maximum quantity of 165 AF irrigating 125 acres, resulting in an irrigation ratio of 1.32 AF per acre. It would appear this irrigation ratio is reasonable as the ratio is less than the 1.5 AF per acre maximum for Reno County found in K.A.R. 5-3-24, *Reasonable quantity for irrigation use*, thus complying with K.A.R. 5-3-23, *Maximum reasonable annual quantity approvable for irrigation use for an application for change in place of use and a request to reduce a water right*. The generally accepted minimum quantity per acre for Reno County is 1.12 AF per acre, so the proposed quantity meets this threshold as well.

Since the referenced applications to change the place of use do not propose to add more than 10 acres or 10% of the base acres to the authorized place of use, water well owners within one-half mile of the authorized point of diversion were not notified of the proposed change in place of use (EKF Memo dated 02/15/2021).

The referenced water rights are not in a special use area.

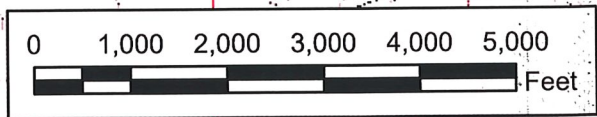
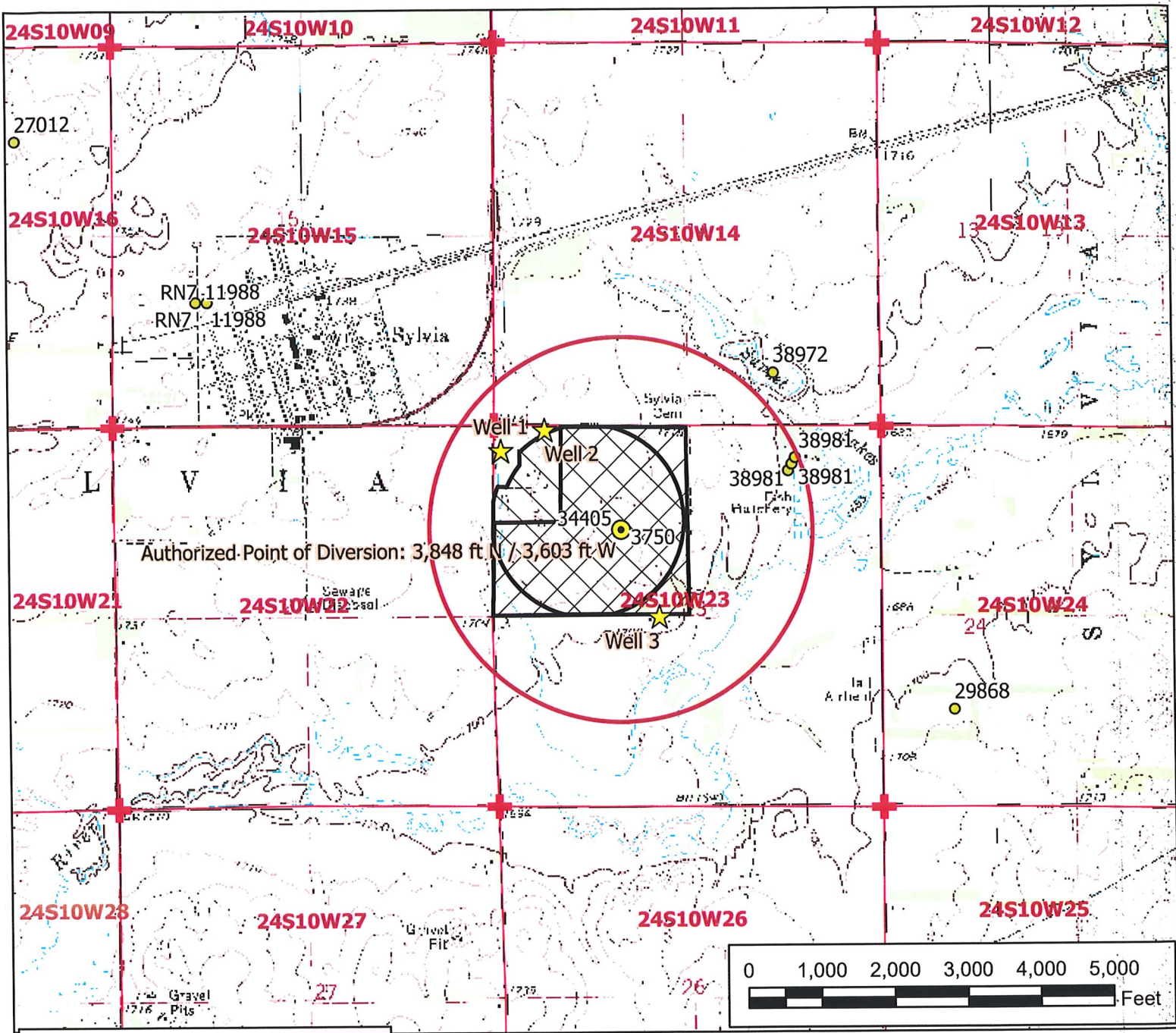
The referenced water rights are in the Big Bend Groundwater Management District No. 5 (GMD5), so a recommendation request was sent to the District on February 17, 2021. A response was received from GMD5 Manager, Orrin Feril on February 18, 2021. In his response, Mr. Feril recommended approval for the change applications filed under each of the referenced water rights.

No structures permit appears to be needed.

A water flow meter is required for each point of diversion. A check valve is required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended that applications are approved.

AMENDED JUDGMENT
on
MANDATE FROM KANSAS COURT OF APPEALS

WHEREUPON:

1. The above captioned action was tried to the Honorable Timothy Chambers, District Judge, without a jury, on January 23 and 24, 2018. Thereafter, Judgment was filed of record on October 2, 2018.
2. Plaintiffs thereafter filed a timely Notice of Appeal with the Kansas Court of Appeals on December 14, 2018. The Defendant did not file a cross appeal. Following briefing, the Kansas Court of Appeals granted oral argument which was heard on November 12, 2019.
3. The Kansas Court of Appeals granted Judgment in the case in an unpublished opinion on February 21, 2020. The opinion, which is filed of record in this court in its entirety, held *inter alia* that:

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- a. The finding of the district court that the parties abandoned the written contract at issue dated November 11, 2011, is not supported by substantial evidence, and therefore is reversed.
- b. The district court's decision to limit Howard and Gayla's right to farm and irrigate the disputed land in Tract II identified in the written contract dated November 11, 2011 through the fall harvest 2020 is unsupported and reversed.
- c. The parties to the written contract dated November 11, 2011 entered a later oral agreement that amended the written contract between the parties "in two ways: (1) to correct the erroneous Tract II land description to reflect the parties' actual intent and (2) to amend the clause requiring Todd and Marcella to convey a life estate in Tract II, so that Todd and Marcella need only grant Howard and Gayla a life lease in Tract II."
- d. "Because of this amendment to the original contract, the district court correctly rejected Howard and Gayla's request that it reform the original contract and order specific performance of the reformed contract."
- e. The action is remanded to the district court with directions to grant Howard and Gayla a life lease to farm and irrigate the disputed land in parcels 1, 4, 5 and 6.
- f. Because Howard and Gayla violated the plain language of the written contract which required them to convey their land to Cash subject to

their own life estates, the district court did not abuse its discretion in denying Howard and Gayla's request for attorney fees.

4. On March 31, 2010, the Court of Appeals issued a Mandate commanding execution of the judgment of the Court of Appeals that the judgment of the district court be affirmed in part, reversed in part, and remanded with directions which such Mandate was filed of record by the Clerk of the District Court on April 13, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE, it is Ordered Adjudged and Decreed that the district court adopts the findings of the Court of Appeals set forth in its opinion and that the written contract between the parties dated November 11, 2011 is amended to grant Gayla S. Moeckel and Howard L. Peacock a lease for the lives of Gayla S. Moeckel and Howard L. Peacock, whomever is last to survive, to farm and irrigate the following described real property, to which

no water right or permits shall attach or become appurtenant to in Reno

County, Kansas:

PARCEL 1:

A portion of the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 24 South, Range 10 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, Reno County, Kansas more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest Corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 24 South, Range 10 West of the 6th Principal Meridian; thence with an assumed bearing South 88°45'10" East along the North line of said Northwest Quarter 342.26 feet for the point of beginning; thence continuing South 88°45'10" East along the North line of said Northwest Quarter 581.82 feet; thence South 02°01'14" West parallel with the West line of said Northwest Quarter 610.55 feet; thence North 88°45'10" West parallel with the North Line of said Northwest Quarter 564.82 feet; thence North 00°25'30" East 610.55 feet to the point of beginning.

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PARCEL 4

A portion of the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 24 South, Range 10 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, Reno County, Kansas more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest Corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 24 South, Range 10 West of the 6th Principal Meridian; thence with an assumed bearing South 02°01'14" West along the West line of said Northwest Quarter 660.05 feet for the point of beginning; thence South 88°45'10" East parallel with the North line of said Northwest Quarter 330.93 feet; thence South 31°37'16" West 129.51 feet; thence North 61°17'54" West 131.42 feet; thence North 87°58'46" West 149.50 feet to the West line of said Northwest Quarter; thence North 02°01'14" East along the West line of said Northwest Quarter 49.12 feet to the point of beginning.

PARCEL 5

A portion of the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 24 South, Range 10 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, Reno County, Kansas more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest Corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 24 South, Range 10 West of the 6th Principal Meridian; thence with an assumed bearing South 02°01'14" West along the West line of said Northwest Quarter 709.12 feet for the point of beginning; thence South 87°58'46" East 149.50 feet; thence South 61°17'54" East 131.42 feet; thence North 31°37'16" East 129.51 feet; thence South 88°45'10" East parallel with the North line of said Northwest Quarter 593.07 feet; thence South 02°00'12" West 181.50 feet; thence North 88°44'58" West 924.00 feet to the West line of said Northwest Quarter; thence North 02°01'14" East along the West line of said Northwest Quarter 132.38 feet to the point of beginning.

PARCEL 6

A tract in the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 24 South, Range 10 West of the 6th P.M., Reno County, Kansas, described as follows: Beginning at a point 51 rods South of the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter and continuing Easterly on a line at right angles for a distance of 56 rods; thence Southerly on a line parallel with Section line, a distance of 29 rods; thence Westerly on a line at right angles to Section line, a distance of 56 rods; thence Northerly on the Section line, a distance of 29 rods to the place of beginning.
