On August 1, 2017, applications were filed by Shelly Steadman on behalf of the City of Mulvane for existing two wells under File No. 31,869, located in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 36, Township 29 South, Range 1 East, Sedgwick County, Kansas.

The voluntary dismissals were received on August 20, 2018.

It was determined the term permits were not needed for the City due to the filing of new applications under File Nos. 49,877 & 49,883. They were contingent upon the approval of the new permits which will be part of the package of files. If the new applications are approved, the term applications should be dismissed.

Based on the above discussion it is recommended that the applications filed on August 1, 2017, be dismissed. A Findings and Order has been prepared to dismiss the applications and should be processed with the permitting of File Nos. 49,877 & 49,883.

FINDINGS AND ORDER
IN THE MATTER OF THE
DISMISSAL OF TERM PERMIT
FILE NO. 20179050

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

FINDINGS

- 1. That on August 1, 2017, the Chief Engineer received an application for Term Permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, which was assigned File No. 20179050, authorizing the appropriation of 205.430 million gallons (630.44 acre-feet) of groundwater, at a diversion rate of 500 gallons per minute, for municipal use by the City of Mulvane.
2. That in a Voluntary Waiver of Hearing and Dismissal of Water Right form dated August 15, 2018, the water right owner requested to voluntarily dismiss Term Permit, File No. 20179050.
3. That the purpose of the term permit was to provide water from existing wells while change applications were processed, but the diversion will be provided by new appropriations, File Nos. 49,877 and 49,883, that appear to be complete and permits may be issued.
4. That Term Permit, File No. 20179050 should be dismissed, and its priority forfeited.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, that effective the date of this order, in accordance with the law, Term Permit, File No. 20179050, is herewith dismissed and the priority assigned to it is considered to be forfeited.


