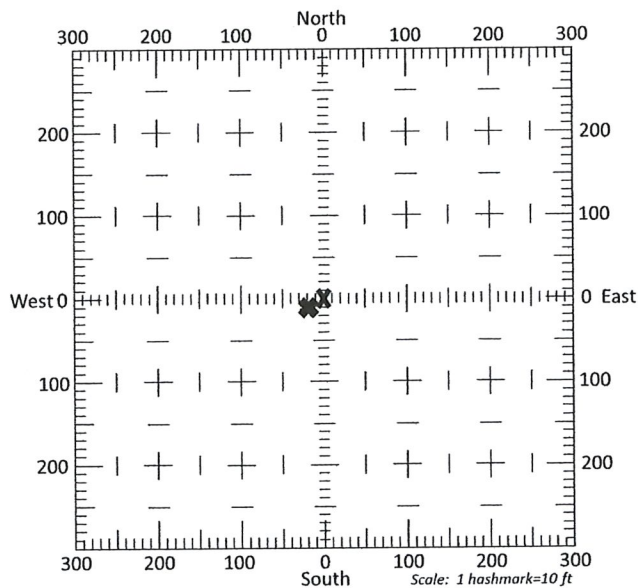

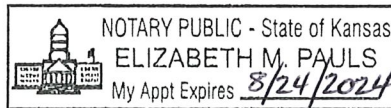

Cary, I've attached the change application we talked about. This change is only proposing to move the well south of the pivot, 20' straight west of the current well (this well is authorized by File No. 5933). Once we receive the change back from you, it will be processed and approved in our office. Once approved, this gives Clarke Well, the "permission" they need to complete an irrigation well.

If everything looks good, please print the change application, sign page 3 in the presence of a notary public, include a check for \$100, and mail the application back to my office at the following address.

Depending on how the new well turns out you have some options with the second well authorized by File No. 26699. You can re-drill it just like file no. 5933 or you can move it on paper to allow the new well to pump the additional rate and quantity authorized by 26699. If that doesn't make sense please tell me, I can explain more if needed. And, one last idea that might help you and the tenant out if the new well produces adequate water. You could enter a Multi-Year Flex Account (MYFA) which gives you a 5 year pool of water to use. You can "overpump" in any given year during the 5 year period but under no circumstances can you go over the total quantity at the end of the 5 year period. Might work pretty well for the milo/wheat rotation and allow you to dump extra water in some years knowing at the end of the 5 year period you might crop differently or pump less the final year to stay under the 5 year total.
