Change in Place of Use

On December 12, 2022, a change application was received that had been assisted by GMD 2 in completing. The applicant on this change is Neal Galle.

The referenced file is in compliance with 82a-732. A review of the application finds that it complies with K.A.R. 5-5-1, *Filing an application for change.* The referenced file does not appear abandoned as per K.S.A 82a-718.

The presently authorized points of diversion and any modifications to the point of diversion are listed below:

A battery of wells with geocenter located at 3,972' N, 4,073' W of the SE corner of 12-21S-2W in McPherson County, authorized 115.7 AF @ 800 GPM on 89 acres in Sections 11 and 12 of the mentioned legal description. We will modify the location of the well using more accurate GPS to the following footages: 3,983' N and 4,107' W of the SE corner of 12-21S-2W.

The place of use will be modified such that the actual irrigated acres changes to 97.5 acres. The change to increase by 8.5 acres is allowable per K.A.R. 5-5-11. The place of use change will accommodate new drip irrigation areas and will remove some of the previous place of use. Additional owners of the previous place of use have signed off on the change to remove their portion of the place of use.

This approval would comply with K.A.R. 5-5-3, *Change in consumptive use*, since there is no proposed change in rate or overall quantity of water. The number of acres being irrigated is changing from 89 to 97.5. The AF/acre will now be 1.19 AF per acre. The minimum reasonable for McPherson County is 1.06 AF/acre. The maximum reasonable at this location is 1.5 AF/acre for pre-1999 irrigation files.

The application was received in the Stafford Field Office on December 12, 2022 with all correct payment and necessary signatures present.

Nearby letters were not sent out on this change because it was a place of use change, as outlined in a previous memo produced during the processing of this change application.

A GMD 2 recommendation request was sent out to Tim Boese on December 20, 2022. The recommendation was received back at the Stafford Field Office on January 10, 2022 with recommendation for approval.

A water flow meter is required. A check valve is required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion that the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended that the application be approved.

The Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2 reviewed the referenced change in place of use application on January 10, 2023, using the District's Revised Management Program (effective May 1, 1995) and Rules and Regulations K.A.R. 5-22-1 through 5-22-17.

The change application proposes to increase the place of use from 89 acres to 97.5 acres. The proposed place of use results in a water to land ratio of approximately 1.19 acre-feet per acre. The change application also removes the approximately 0.7 acre place of use owned by Mark E. & Patricia Rupp.

The District's review found that the change application complies with the Revised Aquifer Management program approved by the Chief Engineer and with the District's Rules and Regulations K.A.R. 5-22-1 through 5-22-17. Based upon the review, the application is recommended for approval by the Equus Beds Groundwater Management District No. 2.

A District decision may be appealed to the District Board of Directors by submitting a written petition to the District office within 30 days from date of this notification, pursuant to K.A.R. 5-22-12. 

The change proposes to add about 8.5 acres to the presently authorized place of use in Sections 11/12 of Township 21 South, Range 2 West in McPherson County. #### **Explanation and Instructions**

DEC 0 2 2020

- A. Permit Condition No. 6 of the permit identifies the specific period of time the owner has to actually use water in order to develop (perfect) the water right. This period of time is called the "perfection period". The water right which is finally developed will depend on the extent of water use within the "perfection period" in accordance with the terms of the permit.
- **B.** The extent of the water right will be based on actual use of water during the perfection period. An evaluation will be made to determine the peak year of use reported. If there are good reasons why you think a peak year of use has not occurred, you may ask for additional time in which to develop the water right. K.A.R. 5-3-7 requires that such a request be in writing and received by the Division of Water Resources **before** the time period expires. Please note the following items must be addressed in your request for an extension:
  - 1. The progress that has been made to date in perfecting the appropriation.
  - 2. The reason why the appropriation has not been perfected.
  - 3. Specify the number of years that will be needed to fully perfect the water right and explain or justify the number of years requested.
  - 4. <u>Irrigation Use Only:</u> Provide the maximum number of acres of land to which water has been applied during any one calendar year.

#### For non-municipal use:

- More than one year can be requested until a total of 10 years past the year the diversion works were completed.
- After 10 years, if extenuating circumstances exist as described by K.A.R. 5-8-7(b), extensions of time can only be requested in one-year increments.

#### For municipal use:

- Can be extended in 5-year increments or less after the original 20-year time period to perfect.
- The total time cannot exceed a total of 40 years past the year the permit was approved.
- **C.** Evaluate your water use carefully. One of the reasons you may wish to extend the perfection period is that a peak year of use has not yet occurred. If this water right is one of several water rights providing water to a common place of use, the total water provided to the place of use will be limited to the maximum applied by all of the water rights during any one year of the perfection period.
- **D.** Pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-714(e) you are required to submit \$100.00 for each file number for which you request an extension of time to perfect. This filing fee shall be payable to the Kansas Department of Agriculture. To pay via credit card, please call 785-564-6638.
- **E.** The individual submitting the extension request is not required to be an owner of the water right. If you wish to request more time to perfect your water right(s), you must complete this form and send it, with a \$100.00 filing fee, **before** your perfection period expires, to this address:
