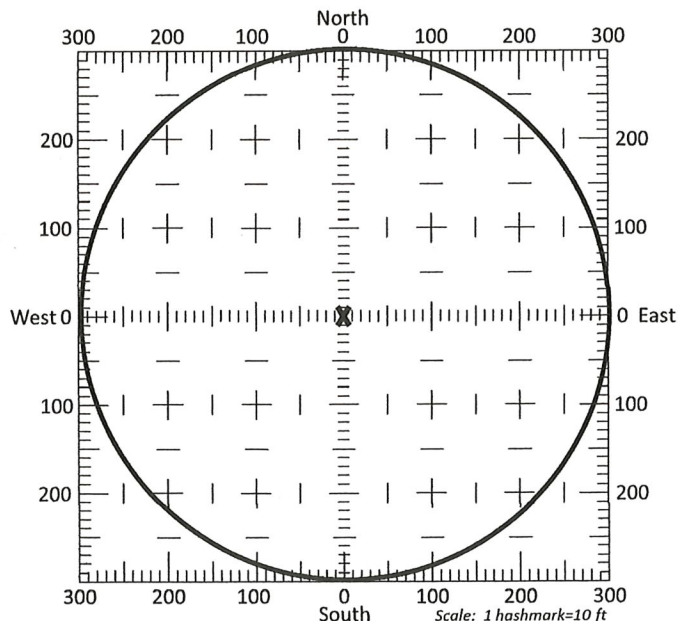



SUMMARY ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION FOR CHANGE AND IMPOSING CONDITIONS

This Summary Order is issued under authority of K.S.A. 82a-708b, as amended, and K.A.R. 5-5-1, *et seq.* and other applicable provisions of the *Kansas Water Appropriation Law, K.S.A. 82a-701 et seq.*, and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, With the exception of those conditions expressly contained herein, this Summary Order does not change the terms, conditions and limitations of File No. 49961.

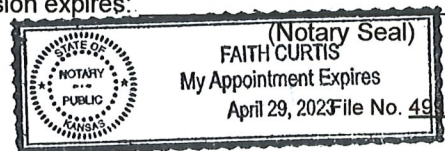

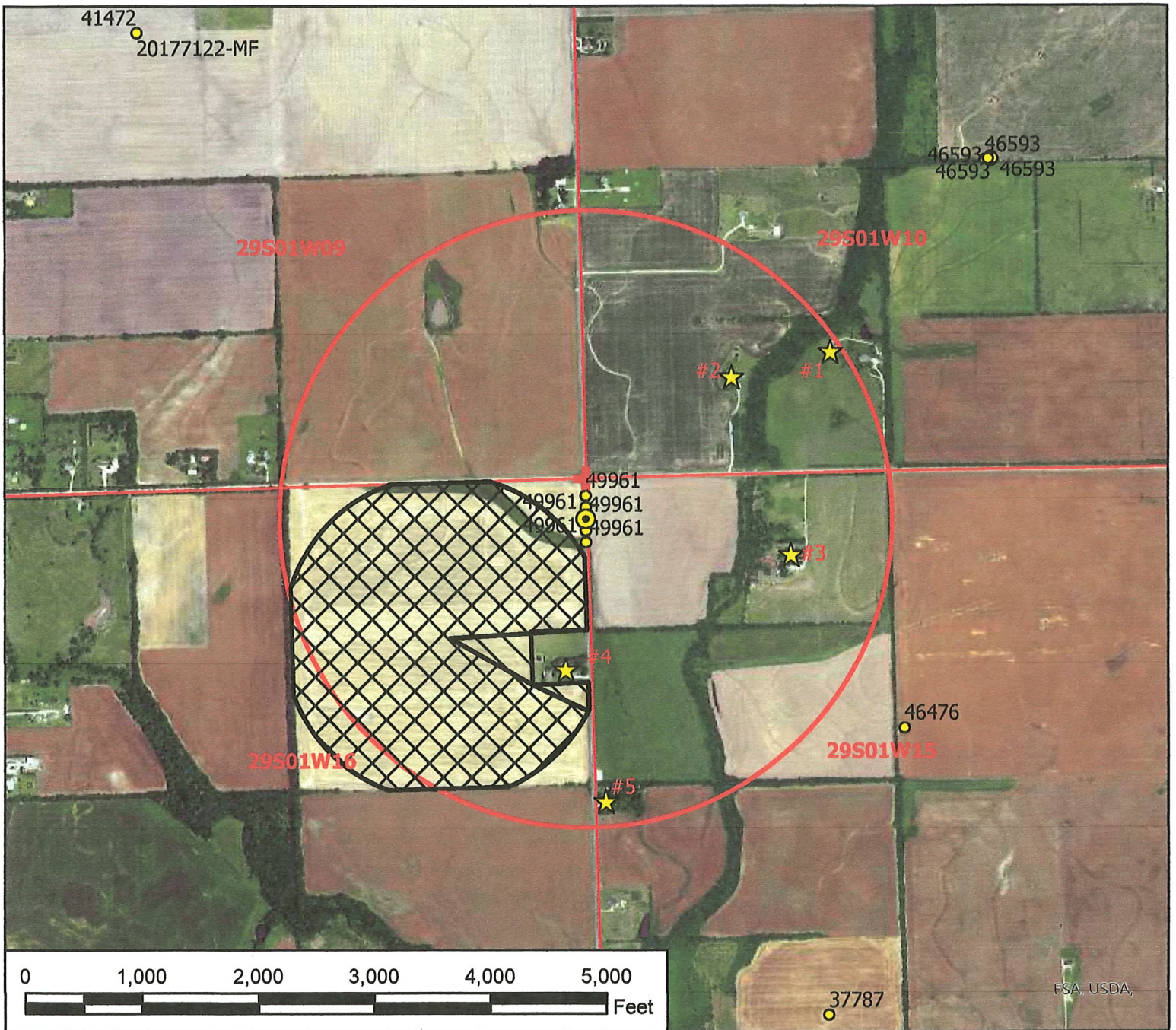

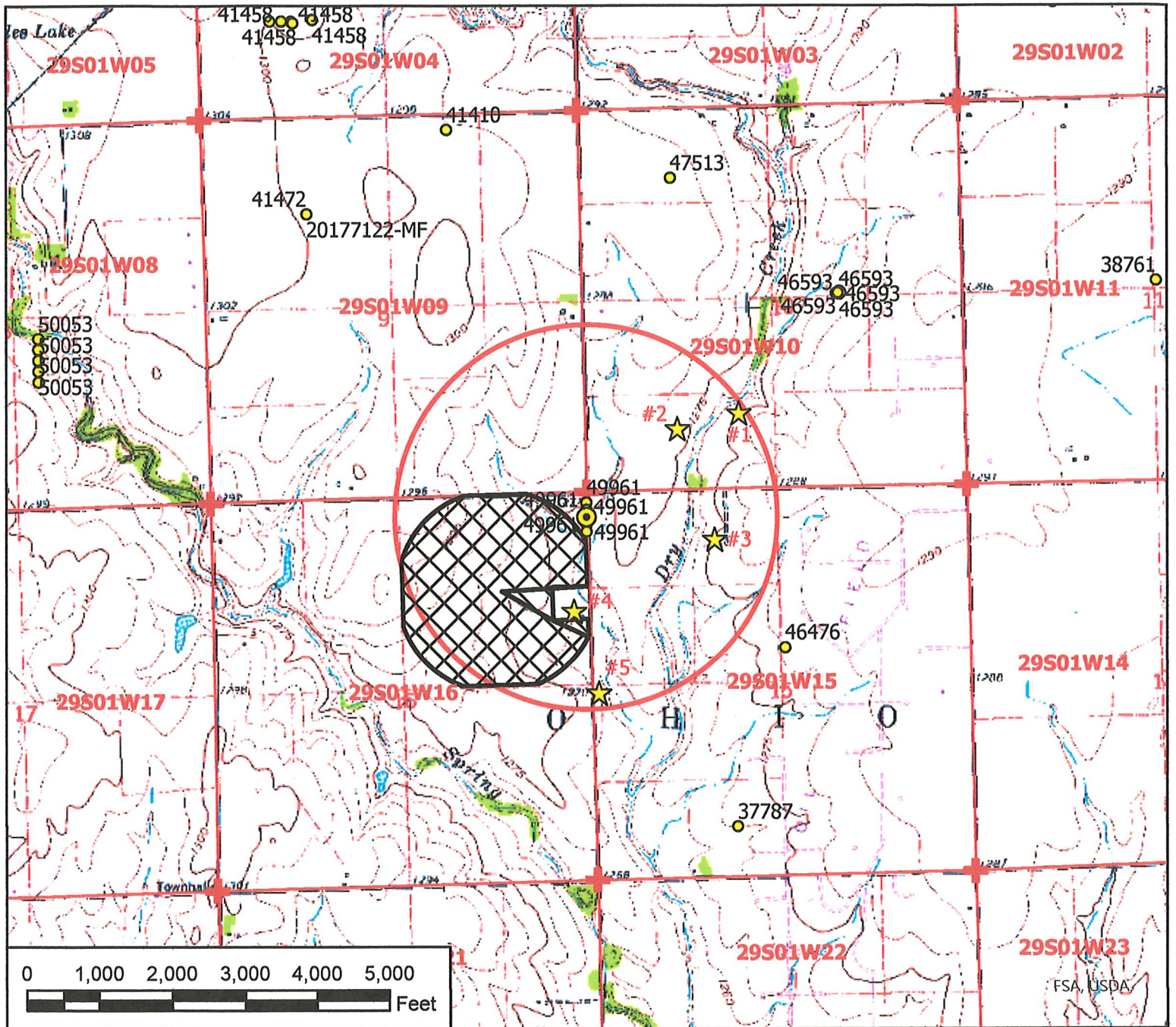

In November of 2022, I was contacted by Tom and Florence Bergkamp regarding getting the N&P forms submitted for the referenced file number. They had completed the N&Ps and just needed to know if there was a fee. I told them for new application completions there is a fee of \$400. They then told me that they intend on installing an 80-acre pivot system and doing the full circle, rather than the windshield wiper pivot that was going to be authorized on the original application. This was okay except for a few acres that would not be covered, so I told them we would need to do a change application.

The referenced files are in compliance with 82a-732. A review of the application finds that it complies with K.A.R. 5-5-1, Filing an application for change. The referenced file does not appear abandoned as per K.S.A 82a-718.

These changes are ultimately desired so that the file will remain in compliance with regards to the place of use being irrigated is completely covered for the full circle. This place of use change will utilize a K.A.R. 5-5-11 base acre change of up to 10 acres (4 in this case). We will increase the authorized place of use by 4 acres to 128 acres and cover the possible areas of the pivot system as it is currently installed at the legal description of 16-29S-1W in Sedgwick County.

These approvals will comply with K.A.R. 5-5-3, Change in consumptive use. The authorized quantity remains reasonable for this water right. The quantity per acre was 161 AF / 124 Acres = 1.298 AF/acre and will now be 161 AF / 128 Acres = 1.258 AF/acre.

The change applications were received at the Stafford Field office on January 31, 2023 along with the proper fee and signatures from all landowners. The landowners are Mark and Kristin Bergkamp, who have recently purchased the ground and a deed has been provided to the office as verification. The websites do not show this ownership at this time but we will still be updating ownership with this change accordingly.

Because this is a field office place of use change, nearby well owners, as stated in a previous memo, were not notified of this change. A GMD recommendation request was not sent out because the file is not located in a GMD.

A water flow meter is required. A check valve is required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion that the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended that the applications be approved.

I have attached an application that proposes to change the place of use to cover the acres of the intended new 80 acre pivot system authorized under the referenced water right. It will add another 4 acres to the place of use for now, so we will have 128 acres. The change is allowable per K.A.R. 5-5-11 because it is <10 acres increased from base acres as they are currently defined for the file. The place of use is located all within the legal NE ¼ of 16-29S-1W in Sedgwick County, KS. All acres under the system as it is currently being operated will become authorized with this change.

- 6) please send the signed application and maps alongside the \$200 check all back here to Stafford together to be processed, address below:

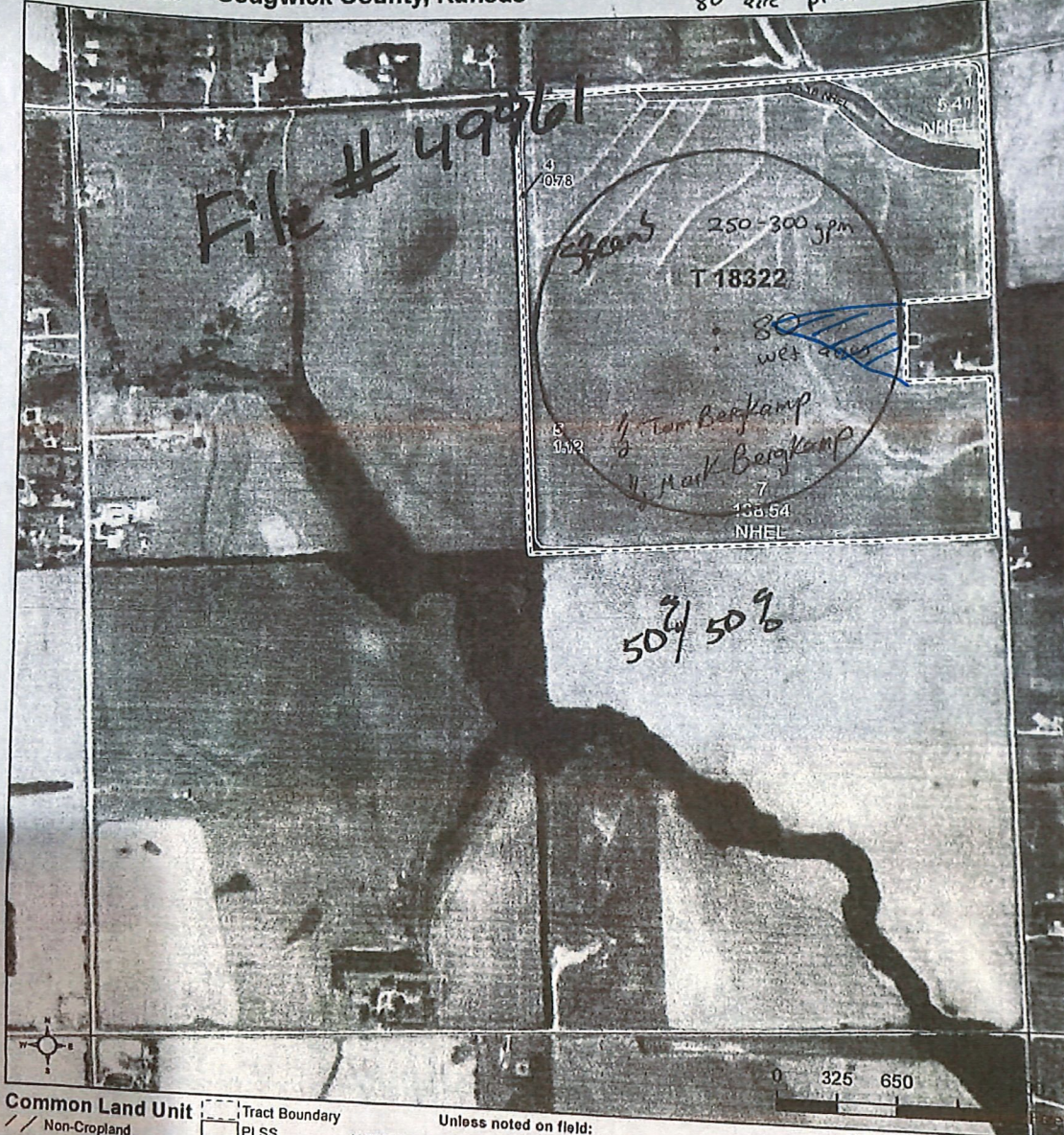
