#### MEMORANDUM

Water Right, File Nos. 3825; 23,433-D1 31,210-D1; 35,108; 40,200; 40,201 & 40,202

Dennis Mersch, for the City of Hill City as owner of the referenced municipal rights filed applications on May 8, 2017, for approval to change the place of use to add the City of Bogue and a pipeline between the two cities. The application for File No. 31,210-D1 also proposes to change the point of diversion. The project is designed and constructed by EBH & Associates, P.A. from their Great Bend, Kansas office.

The referenced rights appear not be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718, and in compliance with K.S.A. 82a-732. Several of the points of diversion have meter issues, but the City has indicated they are working to correct the problems. The owner has indicated there are no nearby wells with the immediate vicinity needed notification per SB No. 337.

The applications for change are to add the City of Bogue and a one-half mile each side of an eight-mile transmission pipeline from Hill City to Bogue City. The project which includes a new water tower in Bogue will update their pre1930s water infrastructure. It appears the referenced files are authorized a combined limited quantity of 156 million gallons per year for municipal use under File Nos. GH-002; 3825; 35,108; 40,200; & 40,201. An additional 44.3 million gallons is provided by the municipal portion of File No. 23,433-D1 and 42.03 million gallons per year is provided by File No. 31,210-D1 for a combined total of **242.3 million gallons per year** (**743.69 AF**) under the referenced files. The City of Bogue is served by its own rights, File Nos. GH 001, 17,373 & 31,517 which appear to remain authorized their 30.1 million gallons a year (93.37 AF) from wells on the Solomon River. These wells will be maintained as a backup for the City of Bogue remaining independent of the City of Hill City's water system.

The referenced files currently have a complete overlap in the place of use which has historically been described as:

within the City of Hill City Kansas and immediate vicinity.

The applications for change propose to list the pipeline and one-half mile of each side and the added city resulting in a place of use description of:

the City of Hill City and immediate vicinity; the City of Bogue and immediate vicinity, and within the immediate vicinity of the pipeline serving the City of Bogue, all in Graham County, Kansas.

This is with the exception of File No. 23,433-D1, that also authorizes irrigation use. It will include the 132 acres under a pivot irrigation system in the Northeast Quarter of Section 8, Township 7, Range 23 West, Graham County, Kansas.

The referenced files diverted about 126.041 million gallons in 2015, but have historically had a large amount of unaccounted water, approximately 22 percent in 2010 and 22.5 percent in 2015. As the historically reported quantity is about 52 percent of their authorized quantity the change should not result in the municipality exceeding its authorized quantity. Additionally, as the City of Bogue will continue to maintain its own water rights, its quantity would be available. The water line work also appears to include work on the distribution lines within each of the Cities, so their unaccounted water should decline. As the City of Hill City has water available and should reduce its unaccounted water the changes should not significantly increase the his scale.

The historical quantity pumped and the projected use would indicate that a new conservation plan is not needed at this time, but should be considered in the future for each City.

As the use is municipal use the incomplete overlap between the two cities and pipeline is allowed by K.A.R. 5-3-5n, Authorized place of use. The existing limitations on the quantity will not be modified by the approvals.

It appears that the proposed changes that will serve the place of use currently authorized by the City of Bogue, File Nos. GH 001, 17,373 & 31,517, will not violate K.S.A. 82a-735 as the changes are in accordance with the Kansas Water Appropriation Act as required by the statute.

It appears that the location of the well under File Nos. 23,433-D1 & 31,210-D1, was measured by GPS in 2011. The well location was determined to be in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4 NW1/4 SW1/4) of Section 8, approximately 1,735 feet North and 4,921 feet West of the Southeast corner of the section, approximately 15 feet from the authorized well location of 1.750 feet North and 4.899 feet West of the Southeast The update complies with K.A.R. 5-5-6. Failure to construct diversion works at authorized location, File No. 23,433-D1 will be updated. The application under File No. 31,210-D1 proposed a change in point of diversion to move the well approximately 1,884 feet to the North. The new well will be constructed in the NW SW NW of Section 8, approximately 3,625 feet North and 5,084 feet West of the Southeast corner. Information about the area would indicate the local source of supply will remain the same. The unstacking of these two rights is not an additional well as the rights were perfected separately and only recently (2011) authorized for the same well. A well log was not submitted with the application, but the log submitted to KDHE, Bureau of Water was available on-line. It indicates the four-inch cased well was completed to a depth of 170 feet with it screened at 130-170 feet. At the time of drilling, March 2017, the static water level was 102 feet. Information provided by the applicant indicates the only well located within one-half (½) mile of the proposed well is the City's well under File No. 23,433-D1. The proposed new well complies with K.A.R 5-4-4, Well spacing, as it is more than 1,320 feet from the well that will remain under File No. 23,433-D1. A water level measurement tube, meter and a notice of completion for December 3.1 2017 will be included as conditions of the approval for File No. 31,210-D1.

Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner of the Stockton Field Office has recommended approval of the proposed changes as indicated in his email dated August 7, 2017.

Water flowmeters meeting the specifications of the Chief Engineer will continued to be required under each of the referenced files. Check valves will also be required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, will not result in an increase in use beyond what has historically been justified, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the referenced applications be approved.

APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE WATER RIGHT FILE NO. 3,825

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of Dennis Mersch, Mayor of the City of Hill City, 205 N. Pomeroy Avenue, Hill City, Kansas 67642-1815, received in this office on May 8, 2017, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized place of use shall be:

the City of Hill City and immediate vicinity; the City of Bogue and immediate vicinity, and within the immediate vicinity of the pipeline serving the City of Bogue, all in Graham County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the plat and topographic maps accompanying the application to change the place of use.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 3,825, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated September 21,1981.

#### RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any use of water that is not as authorized by the water right or permit to authorize water <u>before</u> the chief engineer approves this application is a violation of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act for which criminal or civil penalties may be assessed. Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). Civil penalties shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 per violation. In the case of a continuing violation, each day such violation continues may be deemed a separate violation. In addition to these penalties the water right may be modified or suspended. K.S.A. 82a-737, as amended.

The application must be signed by all owners of the place of use authorized under the water right and his or her spouse, if married. Please indicate if there is no spouse. If land is being purchased under contract, the seller must sign as landowner until such time as the contract is completed.

In the event that all applicants cannot appear before one notary public, they may as necessary sign separate copies of the application before any notary public conveniently available to them. All copies signed in this manner shall be considered to be valid parts of the application.





Additionally, it is required for you to **sign the map** to acknowledge that you have shown any and all wells within the area if interest. If none exist, pleases add your signature where indicated.

The applications to change the place also need a map to show the proposed **place of use and the location of the pipeline** that will convey the water from the City of Hill City to the City of Bogue. On the enclosed map for the proposed change in place of use under File Nos. Dear Sir or Madam:

An application for approval of the Chief Engineer to change the following condition or conditions of the file number referred to above has been received:

> place of use PU point of diversion use made of water

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor... A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.
