Debra Istas has filed the referenced change and new applications to appropriate groundwater for irrigation use, located in the Republican River Basin. Both applications will overlap in point of diversion and place of use with Water Right, File No. 34,758 also overlapping the place of use. The applicant owns the entire place of use, and has signed the applications stating that they have access to the points of diversion.

File No. 41,313 – Change in Point of Diversion

The referenced file number do not appear to be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

The currently authorized point of diversion is located as follows:

one (1) well located in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW¼ NW¼ SW¼) of Section 12, more particularly described as being near a point 2,600 feet North and 4,850 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 6 South, Range 2 West, Cloud County, Kansas and is currently authorized 33 acre-feet at a diversion rate of 195 gpm.

The proposed point of diversion is located as follows:

one (1) well located in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW¼ NW¼ SW¼) of Section 12, more particularly described as being near a point 1,324 feet North and 4,824 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 6 South, Range 2 West, Cloud County, Kansas.

There is no proposed change in quantity or rate of diversion. The move is approximately 1,220 feet South, and because it is less than a half a mile as well as information obtained from well logs, it has been determined to be the same source of supply. Based on area well logs, it appears the local source of supply is to be unconfined Dakota Aquifer. Per K.A.R. 5-1-1(iii) "unconfined Dakota aquifer system" means that a portion of the Dakota aquifer system not overlain by a confining layer in which the aquifer is in equilibrium with atmospheric pressure. The static water level is estimated to be at 70 feet below ground surface where the primary sandstone layer is. This would indicate that the aquifer is not overlain by a confining layer and the aquifer is not under confining pressure. Other nearby wells within the area have similar depths to top of the sandstone aquifer as well, ranging from 70 to 90 feet. This would be consistent with senior File Nos. 44,321; 34,758 and 43,695.

The abandoned well must be plugged in accordance with the requirements of Article 30 of the Rules and Regulations as adopted by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment.

File No. 49,760 - New Application

The proposed point of diversion will overlap with Water Right, File No. 41,313. The applicant has requested 118.2 acre-feet at 800 gpm for irrigation use on 144 acres and limited to 800 gpm when combined with File No. 41,313. Combined with Water Right, File Nos. 34,758 and 41,313 this will provide a total of 187.2 acre-feet on 144 acres for a 1.3 acre-foot/acre (maximum allowed in Cloud County). It appears the quantity is reasonable.

The proposed point of diversion is approximately 2,143 feet from water right, File No. 34,758. This does not meet spacing requirements for unconfined Dakota wells of half mile. However, because both wells are operated by the applicant and the distance is just inside the half mile circle, the distance should be enough to prevent impairment. DWR staff located a possible domestic well within a half mile from the proposed point of diversion located approximately 1,400 feet away. Required well spacing to domestics in this aquifer is 1,320 feet. Nearby letter was sent out on June 9, 2017 notifying of the change in point of diversion and new appropriation. No response of any kind was received.

K.A.R. 5-3-11 applies to safe yield evaluations for all unconfined aquifers. One of the specific criteria is to determine the extent of the unconfined aquifer, which discussed above, it was determined that 6,736 acres should be considered from previous SY calculations and bearing in mind the Lower Republican restricted area. Using the 6,736 acres, 2.49 inches of recharge, and 75% available, safe yield was determined to be 1,048.29 acre-feet. Existing appropriations have appropriated 117 acre-feet (including File No. 41,313), leaving 931.29 acre-feet available for appropriation. Thus, both the applications meet safe yield.

In accordance with K.S.A. 82a-706c, the Chief Engineer retains full authority to require any water user to install meters, gages, or other measuring devices, which devices he or she or his or her agents may read at any time. Water flowmeter requirements are further described in K.A.R. 5-1-4 and K.A.R. 5-1-12. If any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water pumped under this permit, a check valve will also need to be installed. A rate greater than 100 gallons per minute has been proposed, so a water level measurement tube will be required.

In an e-mail message, dated June 27, 2017, Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner of the Stockton Field Office, indicated he had no objection to the approval of the referenced application.

Based on the above discussion, the area is open to new appropriations, safe yield requirements are met where applicable and well spacing is enough to prevent impairment to their own well, and approval of the applications will not impair senior water rights nor prejudicially or unreasonably affect the public interest, it is recommended that both of the referenced applications be approved.

APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION WATER RIGHT FILE NO. 41.313

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application by Debra Istas, 1986 Key Road, Aurora, Kansas 67417, received in this office on January 1, 2017, for approval of a change in the location of the point of diversion under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, that the change relates to the same local source of supply and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which the authorized location of the point of diversion shall be:

one (1) well located in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW¼ NW¼ SW¼) of Section 12, more particularly described as being near a point 1,324 feet North and 4,824 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, at a diversion rate not in excess of 195 gallons per minute (0.43 c.f.s) and a quantity not to exceed 33 acre-feet of water per calendar year, in Township 6 South, Range 2 West, Cloud County, Kansas.

located substantially as shown on the topographic map accompanying the application to change the point of diversion.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2018, or within any authorized extension of time. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

All wells with a diversion rate of 100 gallons per minute or more drilled under the authority of this order shall have a tube or other device installed in a manner acceptable to, and in accordance with specifications adopted by, the Chief Engineer. This tube or device shall be suitable for making water level measurements and shall be maintained in a condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall submit to the Chief Engineer a copy of the well log required by the Kansas Department of health and Environment under the authority of K.S.A. 82a-1212, currently form WWC-5, within 30 days following the drilling of the well at the location authorized herein.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 41,313, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated August 29, 2000.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.


If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.



You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.




