#### MEMORANDUM

States Ag LP has filed the referenced applications to appropriate groundwater from the Ogallala Formation for two different irrigation projects approximately 1.5 miles apart, both located within the South Fork Solomon River Basin (Rooks and Graham Counties). Application, File No. 49,464 is requesting a new well that will be associated with an existing battery of wells and center pivot – no new water is being requested. The remaining Applications are associated with a new project consisting of a center pivot that will be served by three separate wells. The points of diversion for the new project easily meet safe yield. However, due to the order in which the applications were filed, File No. 49,464 would not meet safe yield if Application File Nos. 49,439 and 49,463 were approved. The applicant was informed that File No. 49,464 did not meet safe yield as proposed. He then requested that File Nos. 49,439 and 49,463 be voluntarily dismissed, and he subsequently refiled those applications so that they would have junior priority to File No. 49,464.

These points of diversion are located outside the area designated in the Guidance Document regarding applications impacting Kansas compliance with the Republican River Compact (RRC). Thus, they can be further processed subject to safe yield as described in K.A.R. 5-3-11, which states in part, that the South Fork Solomon River, its tributaries and their alluviums, and any other aquifer that has a substantial hydraulic connection to an alluvium, have been determined to be fully appropriated based on safe yield criteria, and shall be closed to further new groundwater appropriations. The closest mapped alluvium to these points of diversion is in a different drainage basin and is approximately 2.5 to 3.5 miles away, so there would be no substantial hydraulic connection.

#### Application, File No. 49,464

File No. 49,464 is requesting 267 acre-feet of groundwater at a diversion rate of 1,000 gallons per minute. The proposed point of diversion is a single (1) well located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 6 South, Range 21 West, Graham County, Kansas. The 209 acre place of use and point of diversion are both owned by the applicant. This application will completely overlap in place of use with Appropriation of Water, File No. 48,879. It will be limited to 267 acre-feet for irrigation use when combined with the senior file, resulting in no new water being appropriated. This 267 acre-foot quantity provides 1.3 acre-feet per acre, which is less than the maximum reasonable quantity of 1.5 acre-feet per acre for irrigation use in Graham County, per K.A.R. 5-3-24, but would still be considered reasonable.

Using an 8,042 acre area of consideration (the entire 2-mile circle) and a potential recharge of 1.27 inches with 75% available for appropriation, safe yield was determined to be 638.33 acre-feet. A total of 633 acre-feet of water is currently appropriated within the area of consideration, however, this total includes Appropriation of Water, File No. 48,879 (the overlapping place of use file). Since this application will be limited when combined with the senior file on the overlapping place of use and isn't requesting any new water, it meets safe yield once Application File Nos 49,439 and 49,463 are dismissed because the total quantity of water for the place of use has been accounted for within the 2-mile circle.

According to the applicant, no other wells are located within one-half mile of the proposed point of diversion, so no notification letters were sent. The closest domestic wells appear to be at least a mile away. The closest non-domestic point of diversion is approximately 3,200 feet to the northwest, and is the applicant's battery of wells overlapping in place of use with the referenced application. Thus, the proposed point of diversion meets minimum well spacing criteria per the requirements in K.A.R. 5-4-4.

Well spacing and safe yield criteria are met, and approval of the application will not impair senior water rights nor prejudicially or unreasonably affect the public interest. Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner for the Stockton Field Office concurs with the recommendation that Application, File Nos. 49,439 and 49,463 be dismissed and Application File No 49,464 be approved.

#### Application, File Nos. 49,465; 49,738 and 49,740

File Nos. 49,465; 49,738 and 49,740 are requesting 170.8 acre-feet of groundwater at diversion rates from 800-1,000 gallons per minute. The proposed points of diversion are each single (1) wells all located in the Southeast Quarter of Section 30, Township 6 South, Range 20 West, Rooks County, Kansas. The 122 acre place of use and points of diversion are all owned by the applicant. The applications will completely overlap in place of use. Since each application has requested 170.8 acre-feet, the junior files will require limitations of 170.8 acre-feet total when combined with the senior files on the authorized place of use. The requested quantity of 170.8 acre-feet applied to 122 acres will provide 1.4 acre-feet per acre, which is the maximum reasonable quantity for irrigation use in Rooks County, Kansas, per K.A.R. 5-3-24. Therefore, the quantity appears to be reasonable.

Using an 8,042 acre area of consideration (the entire 2-mile circle) and a potential recharge of 1.28 inches with 75% available for appropriation, safe yield was determined to be 643.36 acre-feet. One other pending application filed by the same applicant (File No. 49,464) would have 267 acre-feet appropriated within the area of consideration, providing a 376.36 acre-feet available for appropriation. Thus there is a sufficient quantity of water available for appropriation, and the applications meet all safe yield criteria.


According to the applicant, no other wells are located within one-half mile of the proposed points of diversion, so no notification letters were sent. The closest domestic well appears to be located just over one-half mile to the south. The proposed wells will be just over 1,320 feet apart, and would be considered the closest non-domestic wells. Thus, the proposed points of diversion should meet minimum well spacing criteria per the requirements in K.A.R. 5-24-3. Additionally, all three wells are designed to operate together to provide water to the same place of use, and are under common ownership, so the proposed well spacing should be sufficient to prevent direct impairment and to protect the public interest.

Well spacing and safe yield criteria are met, and approval of the application will not impair senior water rights nor prejudicially or unreasonably affect the public interest. Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner for the Stockton Field Office concurs with the **recommendation that Application**, File Nos. 49,465; 49,738 and 49,740 be approved.

#### Dear Sir or Madam:

There are enclosed permits to appropriate water authorizing you to proceed with construction of the proposed diversion works (except those dams and stream obstructions regulated by K.S.A. 82a-301 through 305a), to divert such unappropriated water as may be available from the sources and at the locations specified in these permits, and to use it for the purpose and at the location described in these permits.

Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, and limitations specified in these permits. Water meters are required and you must install them prior to water being put to beneficial use in order for you to maintain accurate records of water use. The meters should be used to provide the information required on the annual water use reports.

Failure to notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources of the completion of the diversion works within the time allowed, or within any authorized extension of time thereof, will result in the dismissal of these permits. Enclosed are forms which may be used to notify the Chief Engineer that the proposed diversion works have been completed for each file.

All requests for extensions of time to complete diversion works, or to perfect appropriations, must be submitted to the Chief Engineer before the expiration of time originally set forth in these permits to complete diversion works or to perfect an appropriation. If for any reason, you require an extension of time, you must request it before the expiration of time set forth in these permits. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in the dismissal of your permits or your water rights. Any request for an extension of time shall be accompanied by the required statutory fee, which is currently \$100.00 per file number.

Also enclosed are the Findings and Orders by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, dismissing Application, File Nos. 49,439 and 49,463, as you requested in the "Voluntary Waiver of Hearing & Dismissal of Water Right" forms received in our office on December 6, 2016.



After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

#### **FINDINGS**

- 1. That on August 13, 2015, the Chief Engineer received an application from States Ag LP for permit to appropriate groundwater for beneficial use, assigned File No. 49,439, proposing the appropriation of 170.8 acre-feet of water, at a maximum requested diversion rate of 800 gallons per minute, for irrigation use. The specific location for the proposed point of diversion would be the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE¼ SE¼ SE¼) of Section 30, more particularly described as being near a point 60 feet North and 60 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 6 South, Range 20 West, Rooks County, Kansas.
- 2. That on September 21, 2015, the applicant filed three additional new applications for permits to appropriate groundwater for irrigation use, assigned File Nos. 49,463; 49,464 and 49,465; all located in the same general vicinity as the above referenced application.
- 3. That on November 2, 2016, a letter was mailed to the applicant informing him that if the above referenced application were approved, there would be no water left available for appropriation to Application, File No. 49,464. The applicant was provided 30 days, until December 1, 2016, to either submit additional information to our office or request additional time prior to final action on the application.
- 4. That the applicant contacted the Stockton Field Office prior to the deadline and ultimately decided to have the above referenced application voluntarily dismissed so that water would be available for appropriation to File No. 49,464.
- 5. That a signed "Voluntary Waiver of Hearing & Dismissal of Water Right" form for Application, File No. 49,439 was received in the office of the Chief Engineer on December 12, 2016.
- 6. That the application should be dismissed and its priority forfeited as requested by the applicant.

Dear Sir or Madam:

After a preliminary review of your above referenced application for permit to appropriate water received in this office on August 13, 2015, it is being returned to you for additional information. In your original application, you requested a 60-day period of time in which to determine the precise location for your point of diversion within a specified quarter section tract of land described as the Southeast Quarter (SE1/4) of Section 30, in Township 6 South, Range 20 West, Rooks County, Kansas. Your 60-day period will start as of the date of this letter.

Once you've determined the precise location for your point of diversion, complete the rest of Paragraph No. 5 of your application by providing the description for the 10-acre tract location of the point of diversion as well as the feet distances North and West of the Southeast corner of the Section. The location of the point of diversion must also be plotted on the topographical map included. In the case of a battery of wells, please provide the description of the location of the proposed geographic center of the well battery, as well as the location for each of the individual wells comprising the battery of wells.

The locations of all other water wells of every kind within one-half mile ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the point of diversion must be plotted on the topographical map as well. Each well should be identified as to its use (e.g. domestic, irrigation, industrial, etc.) and must include the name and mailing address of the well owner. A signed statement should be included on the map declaring that all wells within one-half mile ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the point of diversion have been plotted, or it should declare that none exist. Please provide this information once you have established your point of diversion.

Paragraph No. 13 of the application requests well information so the source of supply of the proposed well may be determined. Pursuant to K.A.R. 5-3-4d, this office requires a stratigraphic log of a well or test hole within 300 feet of the proposed point of diversion. Please supply the indicated information and a test hole log or a driller's log with the returned application.

In order to retain its priority of filing, the original application and attachments must be returned to this office. with the requested information on or before **November 4, 2015**, or within any authorized extension of time thereof. According to law, default in refiling of the completed application and attachments within the time allowed shall constitute forfeiture of priority date and dismissal of the application.

Dear Sir or Madam:

Your application for permit to appropriate water in 30-6S-20W in Rooks County, was received and has been assigned the file number noted above.

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. Once review of your application has begun, we will contact you, if additional information is required.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water as proposed prior to approval of the application is unlawful. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, ... it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor . . .

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.


