An application to change the point of diversion was received in the office of the Chief Engineer on October 2, 2017 under the above referenced water right, authorized groundwater for irrigation use in the Republican River Basin in Cloud County. The referenced file number has no overlap in the point of diversion but the place of use overlaps Water Right, File No. 24,116. The water right owners proposed to add the well now authorized by Water Right, File No. 24,116 as an authorized point of diversion under Water Right, File No. 10,555. The wells appear located in the confined Dakota aquifer system, and the proposed existing well would not meet 2,640 feet spacing requirements to at least one domestic well.

That in a letter dated January 3, 2018, the water right owners were advised that the Application to Change the Authorized Point of Diversion for File No. 10,555 would be recommended for denial due to the failure of the application to meet K.A.R 5-4-4 Well spacing since the proposed point of diversion does not meet well spacing requirements to at least one domestic well.

That further action on the application was delayed until January 18, 2018 to allow the water right owner time to submit additional information to be considered by the Chief Engineer.

Since no additional information was received by that date, the application should be dismissed for failure to meet the requirements of K.A.R. 5-4-4.

# FINDINGS AND ORDER IN THE MATTER OF THE DISMISSAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL TO CHANGE THE AUTHORIZED POINT OF DIVERSION WATER RIGHT FILE NO. 10,555

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following findings and order:

#### **FINDINGS**

- 1. That on October 2, 2017, An Application for Approval to Change the Authorized Point of Diversion, was received in the office of the Chief Engineer for Water Right, File No. 10,555.
- 2. That in a letter dated January 3, 2018, the water right owners were advised that the Application to Change the Authorized Point of Diversion for File No. 10,555 would be recommended for denial due to the failure of the application to meet K.A.R 5-4-4 *Well spacing* since the proposed point of diversion does not meet well spacing requirements to at least one domestic well.
- 3. That further action on the application was delayed until January 18, 2018 to allow the water right owner time to submit additional information to be considered by the Chief Engineer
- 4. Since no additional information was received by that date, and no request for a further extension of time has been received, the application for File No. 10,555 should be dismissed and its priority forfeited for failure to meet the requirements of K.A.R 5-4-4.

#### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, that effective the date of this order, the Application for Approval to Change the Point of Diversion, received on October 2, 2017, under Water Right, File No. 10,555, shall be dismissed.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation for Beneficial Use of Water, issued pursuant to File No. 10,555, dated September 16, 1968, remains as authorized and amended by the Orders of the Chief Engineer dated March 31, 1980 and February 3, 1981.

#### RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn. Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture. 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564-6777.



Reference is made to the application for approval of the Chief Engineer to change the point of diversion under the referenced file number which was received in the office of the Chief Engineer on October 2, 2017. Upon review of the application, it is found that the application cannot be approved as proposed.

K.A.R. 5-4-4 is the well spacing regulation that pertains to your application. Based on available information, it appears your wells are withdrawing groundwater from the confined Dakota aquifer system which requires 2,640 feet well spacing to nearby domestic wells. It appears there is at least one domestic well located less than the required spacing to your proposed existing well. Therefore, it will be recommended to the Chief Engineer that the Application for Approval to Change the Authorized Point of Diversion under Water Right, File No. 10,555, be denied and dismissed due to the failure to meet K.A.R. 5-4-4.

We are advising you of this recommendation in order to allow you an opportunity to submit additional information (such as hydrologic analysis) to show why our evaluation should be reconsidered. You have a period of 15 days (until January 18, 2018) to either (1) submit additional information to our office or (2) to request additional time beyond the 15 days to submit additional information. If you wish to request additional time, you must do so in writing, before the 15 day period expires. Such a request should state what steps are being taken to obtain the information and the amount of time you will need to supply the information to our office.

If you do not request more time within the 15-day period, or if your request is not granted, the above-referenced application will be submitted to the Chief Engineer with a recommendation to deny the point of diversion change for File No. 10,555, based on the recommendation stated above. If you do submit additional information within the 15 day period (or any authorized extension), that information will be given due consideration prior to final action on the application.

Brent/Richelle,

After looking at this closer, I feel like we should have tech services review this proposal for potential impairment of the domestic well. I don't think we can say that spacing is adequate to prevent impairment with the domestic well only 670' away. There isn't a lot of available information on this area, but it is likely confined Dakota. The nearest well log we could find is to the North of this site and it appears to be confined Dakota.

Using Theis, I calculated the drawdown under the presently authorized allowable pumping and came up with a total of 59' of drawdown at the domestic well. Under the proposed pumping scenario, I came up with 61' of drawdown. Given that there is only approximately 45' of sandstone in the area, it appears the situation may already be bad and this change would only make it worse. I would note that I feel my calculations on T & S were conservative, but again there isn't much information to work with.

I definitely don't think we can take the stance that spacing is adequate to prevent impairment. Given the proposed well spacing, it would appear to me that a waiver should be required and the applicant would need to demonstrate that impairment won't occur. If tech services agrees with my analysis, I would recommend the applicant be notified the proposed change will be denied unless they can demonstrate impairment won't occur.

Just an FYI, you may receive a call from Mark Zenger regarding the referenced pd change. He was inquiring about the proposed change and what effect it may have on his domestic well which is located about 50 feet to the west of his house. He has not had problems with his well but information on his well depth or static water level. Based on WIMAS it would appear the proposed irrigation well is about 603 feet from his domestic well. I explained it should not cause impairment but if he thinks he is being impaired to call the field office. Do you have logs in the file for the well under File No. 24116? WRIS shows Cretaceous System (300) for File Nos. 10555 and 24116 but not whether confined or unconfined Dakota so I don't know if spacing is sufficient to prevent direct impairment.....

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

I am reviewing the referenced additional well pd change which proposes to add an existing well authorized by File No. 24116 as an authorized pd for File No. 10555 (common place of use). The source of supply for File Nos. 10555 and 24116 is shown as Cretaceous System (300). I am assuming this is unconfined Dakota but I am not sure, if so would require 2640 feet spacing to non-domestics and 1320 feet spacing to domestics. What spacing should be used in this area and do you think spacing is sufficient to nearby wells and so meets K.A.R. 5-4-4(a)?

I did not see a rate test for the currently authorized well submitted with the change app or in scanned documents, do you think one is needed to show the current capacity of the aquifer to yield water at the currently authorized pd?

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.


