RE: Multi-Year Flex Account Application, File No, 20177133-MF and Water Right, File No. 29,283

Louis E. Martens filed the above referenced Multi-Year Flex Account application to appropriate 635 acre-feet of groundwater to be diverted at a rate of 775 gallons per minute for irrigation use. File No. 20177133-MF overlaps in point of diversion and place of use with base right, Water Right, File Nos. 29,283. The flex account has a commencing date of January 1, 2017 and an ending date of December 31, 2021.

The quantity of water requested was based on the calculation criteria given in K.S.A. 82a-736. In this case, the calculation was based on the Five Times Authorized Quantity:

Authorized Quantity 127 AF X 5 years = 635 AF

The point of diversion is located within the boundary of Groundwater Management District No. 3. In a letter dated July 25, 2018, Groundwater Management District No. 2 Manager, Tim Boese, recommended approval of the MYFA application referenced above.

In an email dated August 16 2018, Cameron Conant, Assistant Water Commissioner of the Stafford Field Office recommended approval of the referenced MYFA application.

In accordance with K.S.A. 82a-706c, an approved flow meter shall be installed on the proposed diversion works.

Based on the above discussion, it appears that the proposed use of water is reasonable and meets the requirements of K.S.A. 82a-736 for Multi-Year Flex Accounts. It is recommended that the referenced application for term permit be approved for a term to expire on December 31, 2021.

Enclosed is the order/permit executed by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, suspending the base right referenced above, and approving your Application for Term Permit to Establish a Multi-Year Flex Account, for File No. 20177133-MF. Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, limitations, and requirements specified in the Application and its "Attachment A", which are incorporated in this enclosed order/permit. The approval of this multi-year flex account term permit affords you the ability to divert water without annual limits, during the set period of January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2021, inclusive. However, the use of water in excess of 635 acre-feet within the five-year set period listed above, shall result in the immediate revocation of this multi-year flex account term permit, and imposition of penalties as provided in K.A.R. 5-14-10.

Prior to any further diversion of water, a water flowmeter which meets or exceeds specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer must be installed on each point of diversion authorized by the base right, and otherwise in accordance with Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. A seal will be placed on the water flowmeter by the Division of Water Resources in such a manner as to render the meter non-removable from the measuring chamber without breaking the seal. If the seal is broken without the written permission of the Chief Engineer, it shall constitute a violation of the order of the Chief Engineer. If the water flowmeter is repaired or replaced during the duration of the multi-year flex account, then such flowmeter must be equipped with an anti-reverse flow mechanism.

The applicant shall file an annual water use report with the Chief Engineer by March 1, following the end of each calendar year. Please note that the enclosed multi-year flex account term permit expires on <u>December 31, 2021</u>.

The approval of your application constitutes a term permit to appropriate water for beneficial use as set forth in the application. It does not constitute authority under K.S.A. 82a-301 through 305a, to construct any dam or other obstruction. It does not give authority to access any right-of-way, or authorize injury to, or trespass upon, public or private property, nor does it obviate the necessity of obtaining assent from federal or local governmental authorities, when necessary. Please be advised that K.S.A. 82a-728 sets forth, in essence, that it is unlawful to divert or threaten to divert water for the use you propose without first acquiring approval of the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources.

ORDER AUTHORIZING MULTI-YEAR FLEX ACCOUNT FOR BASE WATER RIGHT, FILE NO. 29,283 UNDER TERM PERMIT, FILE NO. 20177133-MF

After due consideration, the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as the "Chief Engineer"), makes the following ORDER:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, It is the decision and order of the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, that effective the date of this Order, base Water Right, File No. 29,283 is suspended, and Term Permit, File No. 20177133-MF is approved. The total quantity of water that may be diverted during the period of January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2021, under the authority of this Multi-Year Flex Account, Term Permit File No. 20177133-MF, shall not exceed 635 acre-feet.

At the time of this Order approving Multi-Year Flex Account, Term Permit File No. 20177133-MF, the point of diversion authorized by base Water Right, File No. 29,283, is as follows:

one (1) well located near the center of the Southwest Quarter (SW½) of Section 7, more particularly described as being near a point 1,250 feet North and 3,750 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 22 South, Range 3 West, Harvey County, Kansas.

By law, this is the authorized point of diversion for the multi-year flex account term permit. The point of diversion authorized under this multi-year flex account term permit may change automatically upon the Chief Engineer's issuance of any approval of an application to change this authorized point of diversion under the base water right. Any such change shall amend the above recital of the authorized point of diversion of this multi-year flex account term permit to reflect the change, and shall be incorporated by reference herein should any such change occur during the multi-year flex account period.

By this Order, base Water Right, File No. 29,283 and Term Permit, File No. 20177133-MF shall be subject to the terms, conditions, limitations, and requirements contained in the Application for Term Permit to Establish a Multi-Year Flex Account (including its "Attachment A"), which was received in the office of the Chief Engineer on <u>September 27, 2017</u> and which terms, conditions, limitations, and requirements are incorporated herein, in addition to the terms, conditions, limitations, and requirements provided below:

Use of water in excess of <u>635 acre-feet</u> within the five year set period of <u>January 1, 2017</u> through <u>December 31, 2021</u>, shall result in the immediate revocation of the multi-year flex (over)

account term permit described in this Order, and imposition of penalties as provided in K.A.R. 5-14-10.

An acceptable water flowmeter shall be installed and maintained on the diversion works authorized by this Order, along with each point of diversion authorized by the base water right. and otherwise in accordance with Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer.

A seal shall be placed on the water flowmeter by the Division of Water Resources in such a manner as to render the meter non-removable from the measuring chamber without breaking the seal. If the seal is broken without the written permission of the Chief Engineer. this shall create a rebuttable presumption that the point of diversion was unlawfully operated.

If the multi-year flex account term permit can no longer be exercised because of an order issued by the Chief Engineer, including an intensive groundwater use control area order, a minimum desirable streamflow order, or an order to administer water rights to prevent impairment, then any base water right may be exercised to the extent that the following conditions are met: (a) The base water right is in priority, including priority with respect to any established minimum desirable streamflow. (b) The annual quantity of water authorized by the base water right has not been diverted during that calendar year. (c) The five-year quantity authorized by the term permit has not been completely used. (d) The use of water under the base water right does not impair water rights senior to the base water right.

JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b)(2). You may pursue judicial review of this order as provided in the Kansas Act for Judicial Review (K.S.A. 77-601 et seg.). A petition for judicial review must be filed in a Kansas court of competent jurisdiction within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-613. Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 864-6777.

Further, the applicant/owner/operator agrees to make such information available upon request by the Chief Engineer or his/her authorized representative. If verifiable records to establish water use are not available for a particular year during the MYFA period, then DWR may make certain assumptions on water use for that year, including assigning 150% of the maximum annual quantity of the base water right(s) to that year, or DWR may assess civil penalties and/or revoke the MYFA term permit and suspend the base water right(s) for the duration of the term permit period, pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-736 and other applicable law. This was a re-enroll MYFA, the 2012 MYFA was operated in compliance and had ~153 AF remaining at the end of the 5 year period. I agree that the NIR calculation provides 5x authorized for the 2017 MYFA, no carryover can be used on this 2017 MYFA.

It is noted the FO has already completed a compliance check on this meter installation. During the 2012 MYFA, it operated under a limited exception due to an accurate flow rate test. That exception was no longer valid. Staff addressed the non-compliant meter install and the meter has been re-installed (with AR gears) in a manner that meets all current installation specifications.

The FO recommends approval of this MYFA for 635 AF, from 2017-2021. Let me know if you have any questions.

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. Once review of your application has begun, we will contact you, if additional information is required.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water as proposed prior to approval of the application is unlawful. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor . . .

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.
