File Nos. 11,424; 17,871; 19,478; 20,824; 29,620; 33,786; 35,016; 36.663; 36.740; and 37,170

Nelson Farms, Inc., Craig and Genine Ingram, etal, filed applications for approval to change the authorized place of use for all of the above referenced file numbers. Use made of water applications were also filed for Water Right, File Nos. 20,824; 35,016 and 36,740, and changes in point of diversion for additional wells have also been filed for File Nos. 35,016 and 36,740. The referenced file numbers are in the RRC Prairie Dog Creek Special Use Area.

The referenced file numbers do not appear to be abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

The referenced applications were discussed in a March 8, 2018 meeting with Lane Letourneau, Water Appropriations Program Manager, and Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner of the Stockton Field Office, and further reviewed in a water commissioner's meeting on April 19, 2018. It was determined the applications and reductions should be processed as follows:

<u>Change in PU UMW File No. 20,824; 35,016 and 36,740; /Change in Pd File Nos. 35,016 and 36,740</u>

The applications for File Nos. 20,824 and 36,740 request a dual use of water that will allow for both stockwatering use and irrigation use in any calendar year, and request temporary reductions/limitations in quantity based on K.A.R. 5-5-9 calculations. The application for File No. 35,016 proposes to convert from irrigation to stockwatering use (no dual use) based on K.A.R. 5-5-9. Changes in points of diversion pursuant to K.A.R. 5-5-16 have also been filed for File Nos. 35,016 and 36,740 and it was determined in an April 19, 2018 water commissioner's meeting that any reductions in quantity for File Nos. 35,016 and 36,740 would be permanent to comply with K.A.R. 5-5-16 consumptive use requirements. No changes to any Almena limitations.

<u>File No. 20,824</u> – File No. 20,824 is presently authorized a blanket rate and quantity of 85.5 acrefeet and 460 gallons per minute of groundwater for irrigation use on 182 acres from two wells. No overlaps in the points of diversion but the place of use overlaps Water Right, File Nos. 36,740 and 37,170. Paragraph No. 13 of the application indicates that 73.45 acre-feet of water can be authorized for dual irrigation/stockwatering use.

<u>File No. 35,016</u>-File No. 35,016 is presently authorized 42 acre-feet and 200 gallons per minute of groundwater from one irrigation well located 4,154 feet North and 2,845 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 8, Township 1 South, Range 19 West, Phillips County. The point of diversion overlaps Water Right, File No. 36,663 and the place of use overlaps Water Right, File Nos. 11,424 and 36,663. The K.A.R. 5-5-9 calculation indicates a reduction in quantity from 42 acre-feet to 36 acre-feet for stockwatering use. The proposed point of diversion change will authorize three wells with assigned rates and quantities (3,852'N, 3935'W -12AF @66 g.p.m.; 3,852'N, 4,188'W-12AF@66 g.p.m.; 3,852'N, 4,440'W – 12AF @68 g.p.m.) all in Section 8 and a permanent reduction in quantity to 36 acre-feet to comply with the additional well regulation. The currently authorized well will remain authorized by File No. 36,663.

<u>File No. 36,740</u>-File No. 36,740 is presently authorized 114.5 acre-feet and 590 gallons per minute of groundwater from one irrigation well located 3,630 feet North and 700 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 8, Township 1 South, Range 19 West, Phillips County. The point of diversion has no current overlap but the place of use overlaps File Nos. 20,824 and 37,170. The applicant proposes to convert the total currently authorized irrigation quantity to dual use irrigation/stockwatering. Paragraph No. 13 calculation indicates 98.36 acre-feet will be authorized dual use. The point of diversion change proposes to better describe the currently authorized well (3,728'N,609'W) and add a well 49 feet to the west (3,728'N,649'W). The wells will each be able to pump 98.36 AF, limited to 98.36 AF, with the currently authorized well assigned 390 g.p.m., the additional well assigned 200 g.p.m. Also, a permanent reduction in quantity to 98.36 acre-feet due to the additional well.

File Nos. 20,824; 35,016 and 36,740 will all be authorized stockwatering use a hog facility located in the North Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (N½ SW¼ NW¼) and in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼ NW¾) of Section 8, Township 1 South, Range 19 West, Phillips County, Kansas. In a phone conversation on February 21, 2018, Kelly indicated that the quantity requested for stockwatering use is justified.

<u>Change in PU File Nos. 11,424; 17,871; 19,478; 20,824; 29,620; 33,786; 36,663; 36,740; and 37,170</u>

The referenced change in place of use applications will create a complete overlap in the irrigation place of use, with a total of 620.5 acres to be authorized in Sections 5, 7, 8 and 18, Township 1 South, Range 19 West, Phillips County. As Paragraph No. 3 of the applications indicate, the proposal will remove the area to be authorized for the hog facility and completely overlap the place of use for the referenced files so that freshwater can be pumped into the effluent lagoons for subsequent re-diversion over the place of use. No changes to any Almena limitations.

Nearby water right owners identified on the map or in WRIS within one half-mile of the authorized/proposed points of diversion of all of the above referenced change applications were notified of the proposed changes by letters dated April 3, 2018 in order to comply with K.S.A. 82a 1906. The nearby well owners within one-half mile of the proposed wells for File Nos. 35,016 and 36,740 were given 15 days for comments; no written responses were received however two phone calls were received.

In an e-mail dated April 26, 2018, Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner of the Stockton Field Office, recommended approval of the applications.

Water flow meters are required and separate meters are required for the dual use. Check valves are required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Enclosed are the orders executed by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, approving the applications for change under the above referenced file numbers.

Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, and limitations specified in these approvals for change. A condition of the approvals is that acceptable water flow meters must be installed so that both irrigation and stockwatering uses can be metered independent of each other. Please return the required notification of completion of the diversion works and/or installation of the required meters as soon as these actions are completed

Please note that the applications to change the point of diversion for File Nos. 35,016 and 36,740 are approved subject to the condition that for the sole purpose of administering wells concerning direct impairment, the additional wells shall be considered to have the priority of the date the applications were filed (November 27, 2017) to add the additional wells. In addition, the Chief Engineer specifically retains jurisdiction in this matter with authority to review the approval of the additional wells at intervals of no fewer than five years, and no more than ten years to determine if the total annual quantity of water actually being withdrawn by all wells authorized by the approval of application for change is exceeding the total annual quantity of water that could have been physically withdrawn if the additional wells had not been approved, and based on the review, the Chief Engineer retains authority to make a reasonable reduction in the authorized quantity of water as may be deemed to be in the public interest.

Since these orders modify the original documents referred to above, they should be recorded with the Register of Deeds as other instruments affecting real estate.

The Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, after due consideration of the written application of N. Terry Nelson, on behalf of Nelson Farms, Incorporated, P.O. Box 38 Long Island, Kansas, 67647, Craig and Genine Ingram Living Trusts, 220 West 1100 Road, Long Island, Kansas, 67647-4001, Watkins Family Trust, Attn Bill Watkins, 8100 East Camelback Road, Suite 42, Scottsdale, Arizona, 85251, Lisa Quinn etal, 225 State Street, Phillipsburg, Kansas 67661, Bernard A. Van Kooten Trust #2 c/o Geraldine Van Kooten, 217 West 35th Street, Hays, Kansas 67601, and Old Stone Pork L.L.C., 1304 West Fox Road, Long Island, Kansas 67647, received in this office on November 27, 2017 for approval of a change in the place of use, point of diversion and use made of water under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, finds that the changes are reasonable and will not impair existing rights and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

This order effectively reduces the total authorized quantity of water to 98.36 acre-feet (32.05 million gallons) per calendar year in accordance with the Application for Approval to Change the Place of Use, Point of Diversion and Use Made of Water received in this office on November 27, 2017.

The application, therefore, is approved subject to the condition that for the sole purpose of administering wells concerning direct impairment, the additional well shall be considered to have the priority of the date the application was filed (November 27, 2017) to add the additional well.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which that portion to be authorized for both irrigation and stockwatering uses shall be authorized from the following dual use points of diversion:

one(1) well located near the center of the North Half of the Southeast Quarter pf the Northeast Quarter (N½ SE½ NE½) of Section 8, more particularly described as being near a point located 3,728 feet North and 649 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in a quantity not to exceed 98.36 acre-feet (32.05 million gallons) of groundwater per calendar year at a rate of diversion not in excess of 200 gallons per minute (0.44 c.f.s.) (additional well), and

one(1) well located near the center of the North Half of the Southeast Quarter pf the Northeast Quarter (N½ SE½ NE½) of Section 8, more particularly described as being near a point located 3,728 feet North and 609 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in a quantity not to exceed 98.36 acre-feet (32.05 million gallons) of groundwater per calendar year at a rate of diversion not in excess of 390 gallons per minute (0.87 c.f.s.),

both in Township 1 South, Range 20 West, Phillips County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the maps accompanying the application to change the place of use, point of diversion and use made of water.

That the above described dual use points of diversion are further limited to a total of 98.36 acrefeet (32.05 million gallons) of groundwater per calendar year for the dual stockwatering and irrigation uses combined.

a total of 620.50 acres in Township 1 South, Range 19 West, Phillips County, Kansas, and the authorized location of the stockwatering place of use shall be:

The North Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (N½ SW¼ NW¼) and in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼ NW¼) of Section 8, Township 1 South, Range 19 West, Phillips County, Kansas,

located substantially as shown on the maps accompanying the application to change the place of use, point of diversion and use made of water.

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2018, or within any authorized extension of time. The applicant shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install a separate acceptable water meter for each use made of water for the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meters has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meters in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted for irrigation and stockwatering use may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meters and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

The Chief Engineer specifically retains jurisdiction in this matter with authority to review the approval of the additional well at intervals of no fewer than five years, and no more than ten years to determine if the total annual quantity of water actually being withdrawn by all wells authorized by the approval of application for change is exceeding the total annual quantity of water that could have been physically withdrawn if the additional well had not been approved, and based on the review, the Chief Engineer retains authority to make a reasonable reduction in the authorized quantity of water as may be deemed to be in the public interest.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 36,740, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 23, 1997.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 - 6777.

Enclosed are the orders executed by the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, approving the applications for change under the above referenced file numbers.

Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, conditions, and limitations specified in these approvals for change. A condition of the approvals is that acceptable water flow meters must be installed so that both irrigation and stockwatering uses can be metered independent of each other. Please return the required notification of completion of the diversion works and/or installation of the required meters as soon as these actions are completed

Please note that the applications to change the point of diversion for File Nos. 35,016 and 36,740 are approved subject to the condition that for the sole purpose of administering wells concerning direct impairment, the additional wells shall be considered to have the priority of the date the applications were filed (November 27, 2017) to add the additional wells. In addition, the Chief Engineer specifically retains jurisdiction in this matter with authority to review the approval of the additional wells at intervals of no fewer than five years, and no more than ten years to determine if the total annual quantity of water actually being withdrawn by all wells authorized by the approval of application for change is exceeding the total annual quantity of water that could have been physically withdrawn if the additional wells had not been approved, and based on the review, the Chief Engineer retains authority to make a reasonable reduction in the authorized quantity of water as may be deemed to be in the public interest.

Since these orders modify the original documents referred to above, they should be recorded with the Register of Deeds as other instruments affecting real estate.

Box 38 Long Island, Kansas, 67647, Craig and Genine Ingram Living Trusts, 220 West 1100 Road, Long Island, Kansas, 67647-4001, Watkins Family Trust, Attn Bill Watkins, 8100 East Camelback Road, Suite 42, Scottsdale, Arizona, 85251, Lisa Quinn etal, 225 State Street, Phillipsburg, Kansas 67661, Bernard A. Van Kooten Trust #2 c/o Geraldine Van Kooten, 217 West 35th Street, Hays, Kansas 67601, and Old Stone Pork L.L.C., 1304 West Fox Road, Long Island, Kansas 67647, received in this office on November 27, 2017 for approval of a change in the place of use, point of diversion and use made of water under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the application for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, finds that the changes are reasonable and will not impair existing rights and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

This order effectively reduces the total authorized quantity of water to 98.36 acre-feet (32.05 million gallons) per calendar year in accordance with the Application for Approval to Change the Place of Use, Point of Diversion and Use Made of Water received in this office on November 27, 2017.

The application, therefore, is approved subject to the condition that for the sole purpose of administering wells concerning direct impairment, the additional well shall be considered to have the priority of the date the application was filed (November 27, 2017) to add the additional well.

The effective date of the change shall be the date this order is executed by the Chief Engineer, after which that portion to be authorized for both irrigation and stockwatering uses shall be authorized from the following dual use points of diversion:

one(1) well located near the center of the North Half of the Southeast Quarter pf the Northeast Quarter (N½ SE¼ NE¼) of Section 8, more particularly described as being near a point located 3,728 feet North and 649 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in a quantity not to exceed 98.36 acre-feet (32.05 million gallons) of groundwater per calendar year at a rate of diversion not in excess of 200 gallons per minute (0.44 c.f.s.) (additional well), and

one(1) well located near the center of the North Half of the Southeast Quarter pf the Northeast Quarter (N½ SE½ NE½) of Section 8, more particularly described as being near a point located 3,728 feet North and 609 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in a quantity not to exceed 98.36 acre-feet (32.05 million gallons) of groundwater per calendar year at a rate of diversion not in excess of 390 gallons per minute (0.87 c.f.s.),

both in Township 1 South, Range 20 West, Phillips County, Kansas,

Installation of the works for diversion of water shall be completed on or before December 31, 2018, or within any authorized extension of time. The applicant shall notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources, Kansas Department of Agriculture, when construction of the works for diversion has been completed.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install a separate acceptable water meter for each use made of water for the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meters has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meters in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted for irrigation and stockwatering use may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meters and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

The Chief Engineer specifically retains jurisdiction in this matter with authority to review the approval of the additional well at intervals of no fewer than five years, and no more than ten years to determine if the total annual quantity of water actually being withdrawn by all wells authorized by the approval of application for change is exceeding the total annual quantity of water that could have been physically withdrawn if the additional well had not been approved, and based on the review, the Chief Engineer retains authority to make a reasonable reduction in the authorized quantity of water as may be deemed to be in the public interest.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 36,740, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated June 23, 1997.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 - 6777.



Terry,

You will probably want to discuss this further, but wanted to give you a heads up. Manhattan has identified some issues on the recent change applications you filed. In a nutshell, they are:

File No. 3,310 & 4,304: As you will recall, PL016 has 65 acre-feet. File No. 3130 has 85 acre-fee, but is limited to 123 acre-feet when combined with PL016. File No. 4,304 currently has 123 acre-feet for irrigation, but is also limited to 123 acre-feet when combined with PL016 & 3130. By changing the two irrigation wells under File No. 4,304 to dual use, they will be limited to the consumptive use number of 105.7 acre-feet while authorized for dual use. Since all three water rights "share" the same consumptive use number due to being perfected on the same land, it will now be necessary to limit both 3130 and 4304 to a total of 105.7 acre-feet when combined with PL016. If you ever remove the stockwatering option from the two irrigation wells, the irrigation quantity will return to 123 acre-feet and the total limiting clause of 123 acre-feet will be restored.

File No. 18,328: You are proposing to convert 40 acre-feet to stockwatering and place it on a new battery of two wells. The east irrigation well is currently authorized 220 acre-feet. By converting 40 acre-feet to stockwatering, you will be losing 7.6 acre-feet in the consumptive use calculation. Since you are creating an additional battery of wells under this water right, Manhattan considers this a permanent change (due to the creation of the additional battery of wells) and they are not willing to allow for a "path back" to the original 220 acre-feet if you ever converted the 40 acre-feet back to irrigation.

File No. 35,016: This is the 42 acre-foot water right of Craig's. 36 acre-feet will convert to stockwatering. On your application, you were proposing to keep the full 42 acre-feet. If you want to keep the full 42 acre-feet, you will need to request a waiver and provide justification for the waiver. We had originally talked that you might consult with KLA or someone to look into that option. If you cannot provide justification for keeping the full 42 acre-feet, the water right will need to be reduced to 36 acre-feet while authorized for stockwatering. You will be provided the "path back" to 42 acre-feet if the whole water right is ever converted back to irrigation.

Manhattan will need some type of verification that you are in agreement with (or at least will accept) these conditions. A response back to me by e-mail would suffice.

These are the three main issues they have discovered while processing your applications. I'm sure I didn't fully explain this and would be happy to discuss it.
