Chase Larson and his wife, Celine Anne Larson, owners of the referenced irrigation appropriation have filed an application for approval to change the place of use. The application for change was received in this office on March 19, 2018, with a new application assigned File No. 50,025A. The new appropriation proposes to appropriate 50 acre-feet at 1,500 gallons per minute. Both of the referenced files are surface water appropriations from the Republican River and located in the Republican River Compact Area.

The referenced right is considered to be in good standing and not abandoned as per K.A.R. 82a-718. The new application under File No. 50,025 A, appears to comply with K.A.R. 5-3-1b and K.A.R. 5-3-3a, and has been processed by Douglas Schemm, Environmental Scientist.

The referenced file completed in 2013, authorizes 106 acre-feet at a rate of 800 gallons per minute from one pumpsite for the irrigation of 82 acres all in the Southwest Quarter of Section 10, Township 5, Range 4 West, Cloud County. A compliance inspection in April 2018, determined the place of use and point of diversion are located in official survey river lots. The GPS location was determined to be within approximately twenty-five feet of the currently authorized point of diversion. The approval documents will update the location of the pumpsite from 600 feet North and 5,050 feet West to 662 feet North and 4,904 feet West. This complies with the feet distance as allowed by part (a) of K.A.R. 5-5-6, *Failure to construct diversion works at authorized location*. The approval will more accurately describe the feet distances additionally corrected the river lot of Lot 10 as shown on the Official State of Kansas Survey for 10-2-5W Republic County, with the database to include the qualifiers of the NW SW.

The proposed permit under File No. 50,025 A, requests 50 acre-feet at a rate of 1,500 gallons per minute from the Republican River. The new permit and the change in place of use propose to irrigate a complete overlap of 120 acres with a combined quantity of 156 acre-feet. The rights will provide 1.3 acre-foot per acre, which is the amount allowed in Cloud County by K.A.R. 5-3-24, *Reasonable quantity for irrigation use*. The place of use will be updated to include the river lots. The new appropriation assures compliance with Part(b)(6) of the regulation K.A.R. 5-5-11: *Applications for change in place of use for irrigation purposes*, and there will be no increase in the historic net consumptive use as detailed in K.A.R. 5-5-3, *Change in consumptive use*

Nearby landowners, within one-half (½) mile upstream and downstream of the point of diversion were notified by letter dated July 12, 2018, by Doug Schemm. He received several letters of comment. Noel Hanson of Concordia commented with regards to the flows of the river and requested a moratorium on new permits. Alan Maish also of Concordia also commented. He was concerned about what he considered to be high rate requested and a senior permit across the river. It appears the comments do not consider the development of rate as compared to requested rate, or the requirement of junior rights to obtain permission to divert. It appears the comments should not preclude the approval of the new appropriation or the requested change in place of use for File No. 47,477. Doug Schemm reviewed and addressed the concerns and determined them not be indications of impairment. He acknowledged the comments with his August 1, 2018, letter.

The original permit issued for File No. 47,477 contained the same conditions as those for the new permit, File No. 50,025 A. Both being conditioned that in order to implement the provisions of K.A.R. 5-3-11(d)(6), no water shall be diverted unless the written permission of the Chief Engineer, or an authorized representative of the Chief Engineer, is obtained each time the applicant desires to divert water.

Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner recommended the new permit, File No. 50,025A, for approval on July 31, 2018. He was contacted for a recommendation on the requested change in place of use. In his e-Mail dated August 22, 2018, he recommended approval of the application for change.

In accordance with K.S.A. 82a-706c, the Chief Engineer will retain full authority to require any water user to install meters, gages, or other measuring devices, which devices he or she or his or her agents may read at any time. A water flowmeter per K.A.R. 5-1-4 through K.A.R 5-1-12, will be required. If any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water pumped under the referenced file, a check valve will be required.

Based on the above discussion, that the proposed change should not increase consumptive use due to the permitting of a new appropriation, impairment to existing water rights is unlikely and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended that the application for change be approved.

Dear Mr. Larson:

Enclosed is an order executed by the Chief Engineer Division of Water Resources Kansas Department of Agriculture, approving the application for change under Appropriation of Water, File No. 47,477. There is also enclosed a permit to appropriate water under File No. 47,477, authorizing you to proceed with construction of the proposed diversion works (except those dams and stream obstructions regulated by K.S.A. 82a 301 through 305a), to divert such unappropriated water as may be available from the source and at the location specified in the permit, and to use it for the purpose and at the location described in the referenced files.

Your attention is directed to the enclosures and to the terms, and conditions, specified in the approval and specifically the permit issued for File No. 50,025-A, with specific reference to paragraph No. 18, which describes the requirement for obtaining permission prior to diverting water under this permit. A water meter is required on the proposed diversion works and you must install it prior to water being put to beneficial use in order for you to maintain accurate records of water use. The meter should be used to provide the information required on the annual water use report.

Failure to notify the Chief Engineer of the Division of Water Resources of the completion of the diversion works within the time allowed, or within any authorized extension of time thereof, will result in the dismissal of the permit issued under File No. 50,025-A. Enclosed is a form to notify the Chief Engineer that the proposed diversion works have been completed. As detailed an inspection fee of \$400.00, is required for the completion of File No. 50,025-A.

All requests for extensions of time to complete diversion works, or to perfect appropriations, must be submitted to the Chief Engineer before the expiration of time originally set forth in the permit to complete diversion works or to perfect an appropriation. If for any reason, you require an extension of time, you must request it before the expiration of time set forth in the permit. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in the dismissal of your permit. Any request for an extension of time shall be accompanied by the required statutory fee, which is currently \$100.00 per appropriation. There is also enclosed an information sheet setting forth the procedure to obtain a Certificate of Appropriation which will establish the extent of your water right. If you have any questions, please contact our office. If you wish to discuss this specific file, please have the file number ready so that we may help you more efficiently.

That information in the office of the Chief Engineer finds that the authorized point of diversion would be more accurately defined as being:

one (1) pump site located in the Lot 10 of Section 10, more particularly described as being near a point 662 feet North and 4,904 feet West of the Southeast corner of said section, in Township 5 South, Range 4 West, Cloud County, Kansas.

All diversion works into which any type of chemical or other foreign substance will be injected into the water pumped from the diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

In all other respects, the Approval of Appropriation, File No. 47,477, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the approval dated March 10, 2010.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.


To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with: Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for hearing may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with: Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, KS 66502, FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

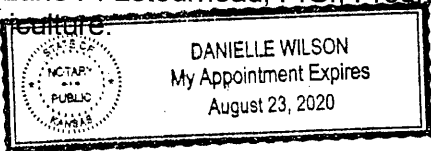

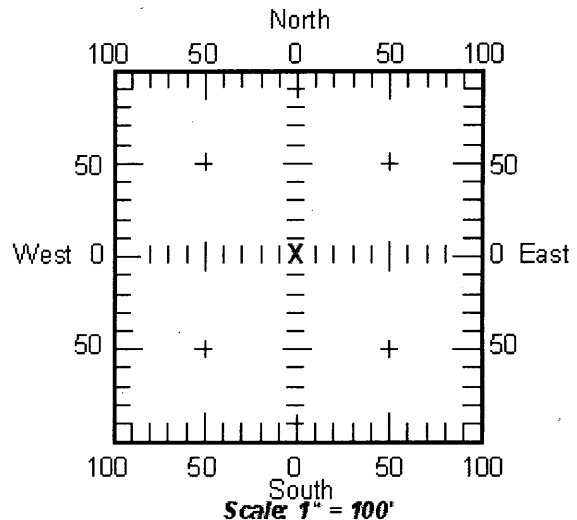

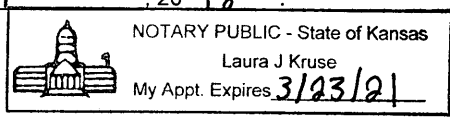

Any use of water that is not as authorized by the water right or permit to authorize water before the chief engineer approves this application is a violation of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act for which criminal or civil penalties may be assessed. Such violation is a class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. K.S.A. 82a-728(b). As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.

(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...

A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.

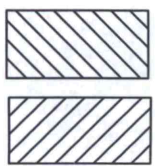
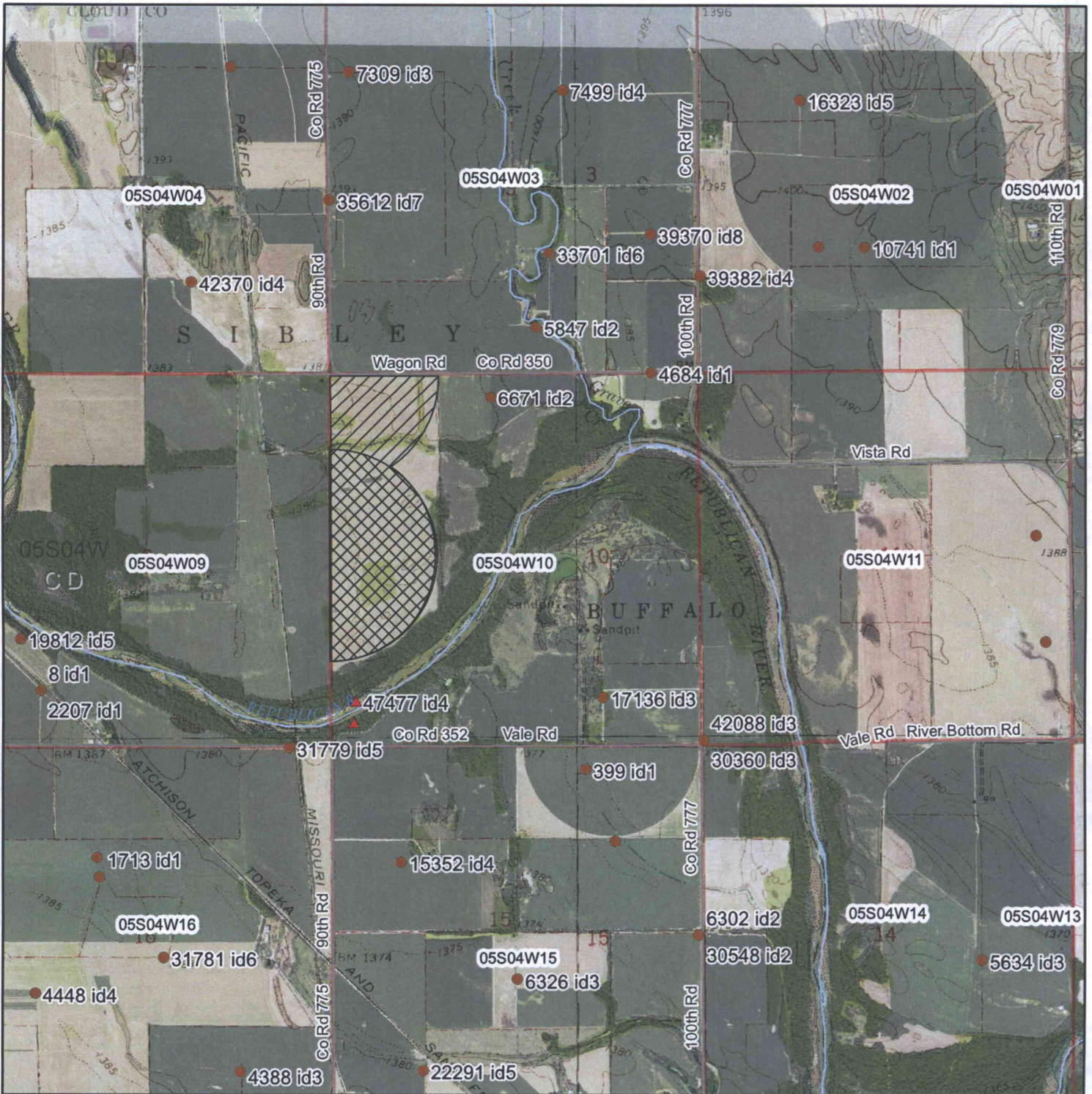
