Ronald and Jeanie Beeson, on behalf of Ronald and Jeanie Beeson Trust, and Hazel R. Estes, Mayor, on behalf of the City of Kanorado, filed an application for approval to change the authorized place of use for Water Right, File No. 10,380, authorized groundwater in the Beaver Creek drainage basin.

The referenced file does not appear abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

The referenced file is authorized both irrigation and municipal uses: 225 acre-feet from one well for irrigation of 140 acres all in Section 20, Township 8 South, Range 42 West, Sherman County, Kansas, and 13.034 million gallons per calendar year from one well for municipal use in within the City of Kanorado and immediate vicinity, and at rest areas along U.S. Interstate 70, in Sections 28 and 29, Township 8 South, Range 41 West, Sherman County, Kansas. The irrigation portion has no overlaps and the municipal portion overlaps in point of diversion and place of use of Vested Right, File No. SH 002 and Water Right, File No. 33,683.

The applicants propose to remove land owned by the City of Kanorado from the irrigation place of use and add additional land for a total of 136 acres all in the Southeast Quarter (SE¼) of the aforementioned Section 20. Base acres are 140 acres as indicated in an August 11, 1998 memo by Duane Harris, Stockton Field Office, so the proposal appears to comply with K.A.R. 5-5-11. The 225 acre-feet authorized for irrigation use can irrigate the proposed 136 acres with 1.65 acre-feet per acre, which still appears reasonable in Sherman County. No changes are proposed for the municipal portion of File No. 10,380.

WRIS and the application map indicate the only non-domestic or domestic wells within one-half mile of the authorized irrigation well are two Kanorado municipal wells, so no notification letters were sent.

The authorized irrigation well for the referenced file will be better described with g.p.s. feet distances as per WRIS.


The same local source of supply will not change, previously determined to be Ogallala Formation (211).

In a letter dated May 28, 2019 Ray Luhman, Manager of Northwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 5, recommended approval of the application.

In an e-mail dated June 3, 2019 Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner of the Stockton Field Office, recommended approval of the referenced change application.

Water flow meters are required. Check valves are required if any chemical or foreign substance is injected into the water through the diversion works.

Based on the above discussion, that the changes are reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely, and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it has been recommended the change application be approved.

Box 68, Kanorado, Kansas 67741, received in this office on December 3, 2018, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated January 17, 2001, approving the application to change the place of use, point of diversion and use made of water, the Findings and Order of the Chief Engineer dated March 8, 2001, correcting an error in the description of the point of diversion authorized for municipal use, the Correctional Order of the Chief Engineer dated November 13, 2001, correcting an error in the legal description of the authorized point of diversion for irrigation use, and by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated February 13, 2008, approving the application to change the point of diversion, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

All diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 10,380, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated March 16, 1971, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

#### **RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW**

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.

Any request for hearing or petition for administrative review shall be in writing and shall be submitted to the attention of: Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, Fax: (785) 564 - 6777.

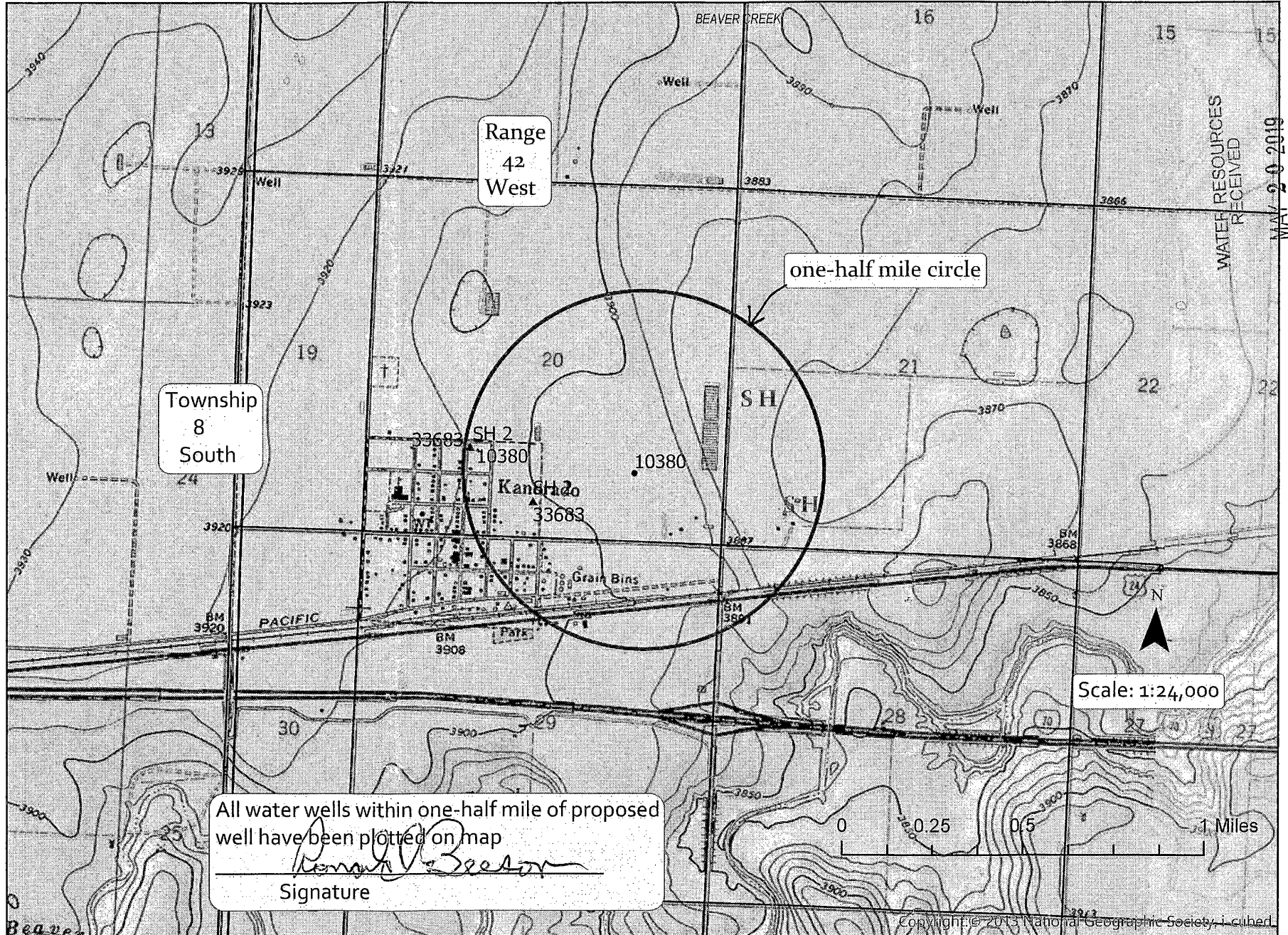

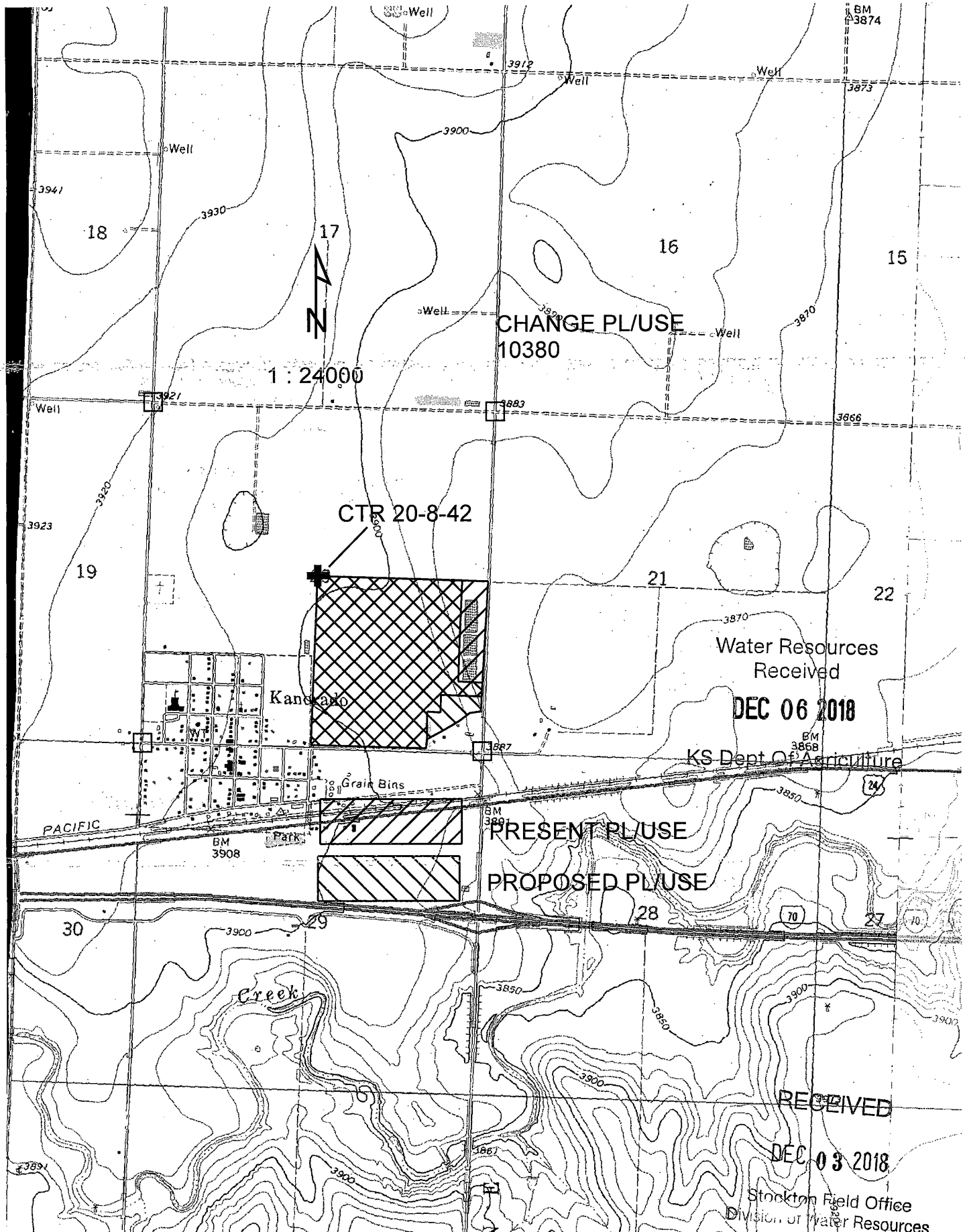

Hi Kelly,

I have begun reviewing the referenced pu change application, I think GMD 4 helped them fill out the application, it is only filed on the irrigation part, I can add the rest of the muni part. Looks like the irrigators want to remove some land owned by the City and add some acreage. I guess my questions are:

- Does the GMD 4 Lema affect the processing of this application somehow? The LEMA allocation is based on the number of acres reported from 2009 to 2015. By changing the place of use now, the allocation will not be affected.
- Do we really consider KDOT an owner of the currently authorized place of use and thus should sign the application? I don't know this answer for sure, but I would consider Beeson and the City to be the owners of this water right. In 2008, when a change in p/d was filed, KDOT did not sign that application.
- I thought they were a customer of Kanorado so wouldn't need to sign but the info I can see in scanned docs looks conflicting..... Again, in my opinion, KDOT does not need to sign. I think they are simply the customer and don't own the infrastructure.
- I would assume the City of Kanorado would need to sign the application, someone signed it "City of Kanorado" but no name of a person. Ronald Beeson did sign the application but I assume for just irrigation portion..... Kanorado's "signature" does not suffice. We need a real person's name and their title.

As a matter of record, the Division of Water Resources has on hand a large number of applications awaiting processing. Therefore, to be fair to all concerned, and so that we can process those applications on hand in the order they were received, we intend to concentrate on the backlog of applications until the issue is resolved. You will be contacted regarding this application as soon as it has been examined.

In accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, a portion of which is included below, the use of water prior to approval of the application is unlawful. You should not proceed and divert water as indicated by your plans in your application for a change for this file until you receive approval for this change from the Chief Engineer. Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.

**Section 82a-728 of the Kansas Water Appropriation Act, provides (a) except for the appropriation of water for the purpose of domestic use, . . . it shall be unlawful for any person to appropriate or threaten to appropriate water from any source without first applying for and obtaining a permit to appropriate water in accordance with the provisions of the Water Appropriation Act or for any person to violate any condition of a vested right, appropriation right or an approved application for a permit to appropriate water for beneficial use.**

**(b) (1) The violation of any provision of this section by any person is a class C misdemeanor...**

**A class C misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 and/or a term of confinement not to exceed one month in the county jail. Each day that the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.**

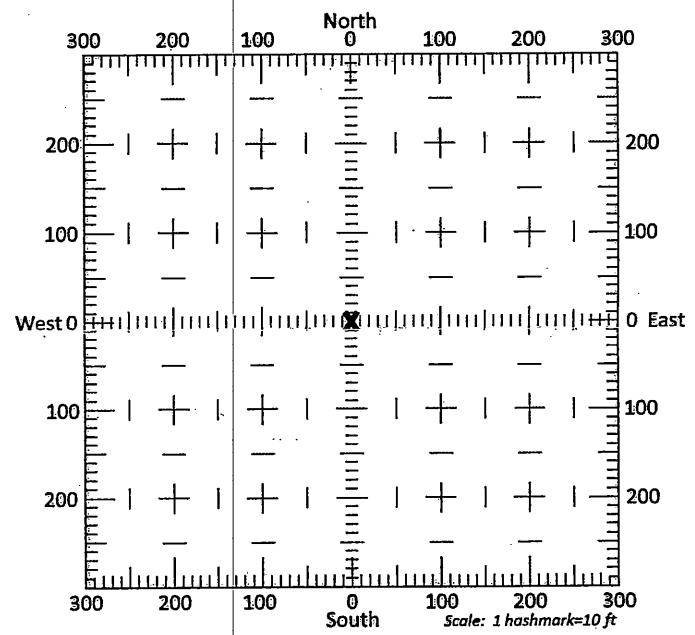

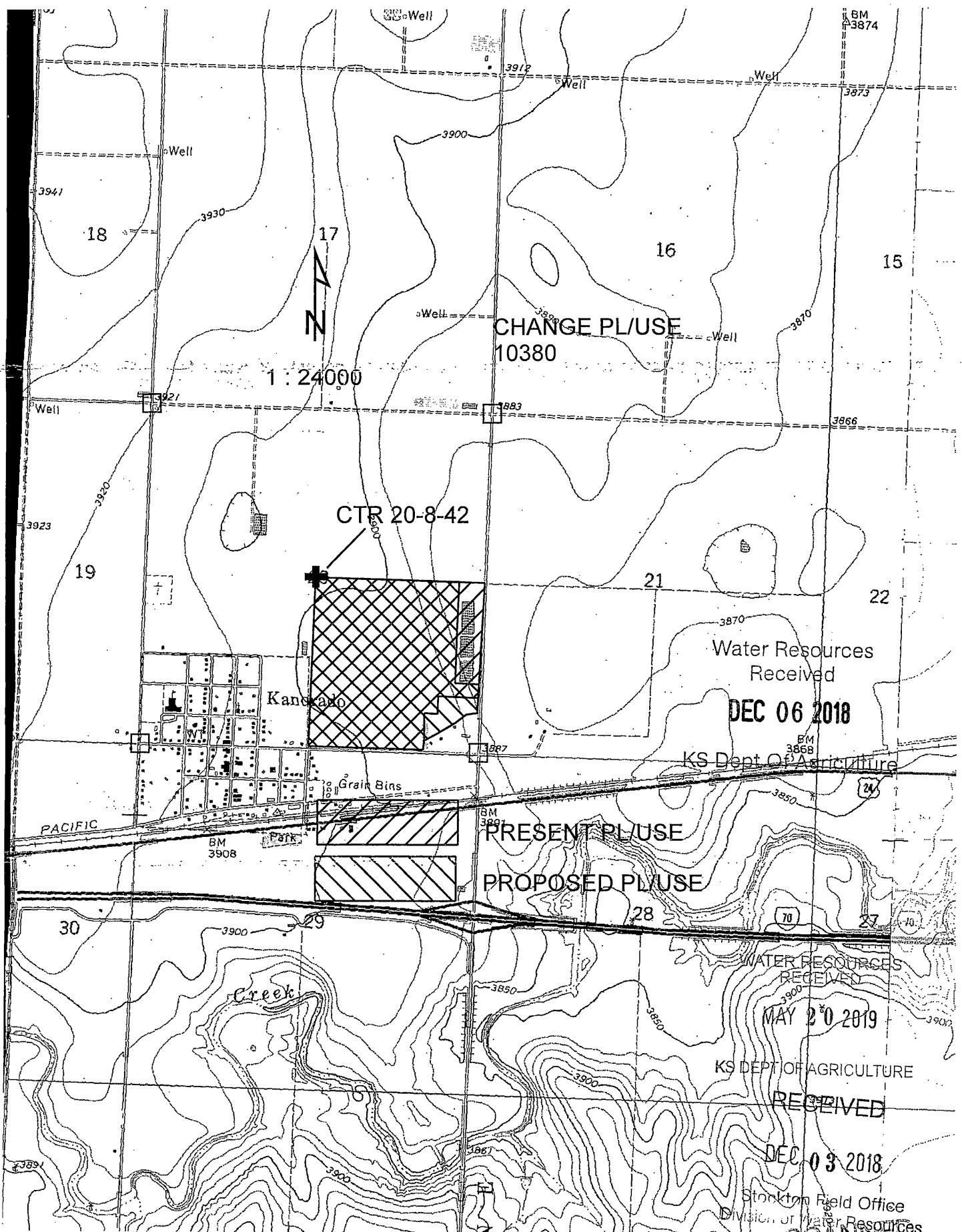


