Tony M. and Anita Horinek, on behalf of Tony M. and Anita M. Horinek Trusts, Randy Topliff, on behalf of Topliff Revocable Trust, and John and Carol Topliff, have filed applications for approval to change the authorized place of use and reduction in place of use requests under the referenced files, authorized groundwater for irrigation use in the Sappa Creek drainage basin.

The referenced water rights do not appear abandoned as per K.S.A. 82a-718.

Water Right, File Nos. 6,236, 9,072 and 11,504 are authorized a limited total of 892 acrefeet per calendar year for irrigation of the same 610 acres located in Sections 33, 34, and 35, Township 8 South, Range 40 West, Sherman County, Kansas. File No. 6,236 is authorized a blanket quantity and diversion rate of 400 acre-feet per calendar year and 1,000 gallons per minute from two wells. The wells are overlapped by File No. 9,072 which is authorized a limited blanket quantity of 630 acre-feet when combined with File No. 6,236 and blanket rate of 1,460 gallons per minute. File No. 11,504 is authorized one well with no overlaps and is authorized 560 acre-feet and 1,235 gallons per minute limited to 892 acre-feet when combined with File Nos. 6,236 and 9,072. The referenced water rights are currently subject to a rotation of acres in accordance with K.A.R. 5-5-11(b)(4); Rotation of the irrigated land within the authorized place of use. The water right owners request to remove the land rotation, and to drop and add new acres in the Northwest Quarter of Section 34, reducing the overall acreage from 610 acres to 460 acres. Individual and combined base acres for the referenced file numbers is 451 acres so the applications comply with K.A.R. 5-5-11. The proposal removes land owned by the Topliffs.

The net irrigation requirement for the 50% chance of rainfall in Sherman County (1.18') with 85% efficiency is 1.39 acre-feet/acre. The total quantity of water authorized by the above referenced file numbers, 892 acre-feet, can irrigate the proposed 460 acres with 1.94 acre-feet/acre, which appears reasonable.

The only wells within one-half mile of the authorized points of diversion are under common ownership based on the map and WRIS, so no nearby well owner notices were sent.

The same local source of supply will not change, previously determined to be Ogallala Formation (211).

In a letter dated March 11, 2019, Ray Luhman, Manager of Northwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 4, recommended approval of the referenced applications.

In an e-mail dated May 6, 2019, Kelly Stewart, Water Commissioner of the Stockton Field Office stated that he has no objection to the approval of the referenced applications.

Water flow meters are required. Check valves are required if chemigating.

Based on the above discussion, that the change is reasonable, that impairment to existing water rights is unlikely and that no change in the local source of supply will occur, it is recommended the referenced applications be approved.

Topliff, on behalf of Topliff Revocable Trust, 607 Kansas, Goodland, Kansas 67735, and John and Carol Topliff, 6250 Road 17, Goodland, Kansas 67735, received in this office on March 8, 2019, for approval of a change in the location of the place of use under the certificate of appropriation issued pursuant to the permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, as modified and amended by the Findings and Order of the Chief Engineer dated March 5, 1980, establishing the ten acre tracts upon which the points of diversion are located, and by the Order of the Chief Engineer dated June 21, 1995, approving the application to change the place of use, finds that the change is reasonable and will not impair existing rights, and that the application should be and is hereby approved.

All diversion works shall be equipped with an in-line, automatic, quick-closing check valve capable of preventing pollution of the source of the water supply. The type of valve installed shall meet specifications adopted by the Chief Engineer and shall be maintained in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer.

The water right owner shall properly install an acceptable water meter on the diversion works authorized under this water right, prior to the use of water, in strict accordance with the Kansas Administrative Regulations 5-1-4 through 5-1-12 adopted by the Chief Engineer. The water right owner shall notify the Chief Engineer when installation of the water meter has been completed. The water right owner shall maintain the water meter in an operating condition satisfactory to the Chief Engineer, at all times during diversion of water and shall maintain records from which the total quantity of water diverted may be determined. The water right owner shall also report the reading of said water meter and the total quantity of water diverted annually to the Chief Engineer. Such records shall be furnished to the Chief Engineer by March 1 following the end of each calendar year.

In all other respects, the Certificate of Appropriation issued pursuant to Approval of Application, File No. 6,236, for permit to appropriate water for beneficial use, is as stated and set forth in the Certificate of Appropriation dated February 28, 1964, as modified and amended by the aforementioned orders.

RIGHT TO A HEARING AND TO ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW

If you are aggrieved by this Order, then pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-1901, you may:

- 1) request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, or
- 2) request administrative review by the Secretary of Agriculture.

Failure to request an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer does not preclude your right to administrative review by the Secretary.

To obtain an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, a written request for hearing must be filed within 15 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 18 days after this Order was mailed to you), with the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Section, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If you do not file a request for an evidentiary hearing before the Chief Engineer, you may petition for administrative review of the Order by the Secretary of Agriculture. A petition for review shall be in writing and state the basis for requesting administrative review. The request for review may be denied if the request fails to clearly establish factual or legal issues for review. See K.S.A. 77-527. The petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this Order as provided in K.S.A. 77-531 (i.e., within a total of 33 days after this Order was mailed to you), and be filed with the Secretary of Agriculture, Attn: Legal Division, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Drive, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, or by FAX (785) 564-6777.

If neither a request for an evidentiary hearing nor a petition for administrative review is filed as set forth above, then this Order shall be effective and become a final agency action as defined in K.S.A. 77-607(b). Failure to timely request either an evidentiary hearing or administrative review may preclude further judicial review under the Kansas Judicial Review Act.





Once approved, compliance with the terms, conditions and limitations of the permit is necessary. Conservation of the water resources of Kansas is required.
